1. Welcome to Jordan Rally WRC 2011

In April 2011, Jordan will host the FIA World Rally Championship (WRC) for the third time in the last four years.

We all enjoyed welcoming the WRC family to Jordan in 2008 and 2010 and look forward to seeing our friends returning from different parts of the world once again.

The heart of the 2011 Jordan Rally will be centralised at the historic Dead Sea with the Service Park, Hotels, Rally HQ and Media Centre located within walking distance of each other.

The stages, most of which are also under sea level, all fall within close distance of the Service Park to create one of the most compact rallies in the world.

This year's event will mark the return of the Mai'n Special Stage which has been re-worked since 2008 to make it safer for emergency vehicle access. The result is a longer and more testing stage than the 2008 version.

To ensure that Jordan's many national treasures are captured, we return to the popular Ceremonial Start location at the ancient City of Jerash, which is one of the largest and best preserved examples of Roman architecture in the world. Other world famous tourist attractions like the Baptism Site, the Jordan River and Mount Nebo will also come into the cameramen's focus over the three days of competition.

The organisation puts great importance into safety and promotional aspects to ensure a Rally route which is a very competitive and safe, while at the same time providing a feast of activities for our visitors in the custom made Service Park.

The Finish Podium and Prize Giving will be held with the Dead Sea as backdrop to celebrate the exclusivity of the third Jordan Rally WRC.

Our friends that visited us in 2008 and 2010 discovered unique sightseeing places and we hope that if you are visiting us in 2011, you will spend extra days experiencing a really exceptional tourism haven.

An affectionate welcome awaits our guests. We promise a unique rally which is now firmly rooted as one of the world's great sporting events.

Those wishing to take part in Jordan Rally WRC 2011 must send the Entry Form duly completed to the organizer before the closing time and date for entries.

The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry Fee.

Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN together with the Entry Form or obtain its stamp on their Entry Form.

4.3 Number of Entrants accepted

The maximum number of entrants will be 70. If more than the maximum number of entries is received, the acceptance of entries among the non-priority drivers will be at the sole discretion of the Organiser.

5. Service Park

5.1 Jordan Rally WRC Dead Sea Service Park

Jordan Rally WRC 2011 Service Park is the same centralized Service Park used in 2008 and 2010 Jordan Rally WRC. It's established in the area of HQ at the Dead Sea and will be used for the whole duration of the Event. It is a multi-purpose area and each team/competitor will be allocated a designated space at the Service Park; further information will be given in the Supplementary Regulations and Rally Guide 2.

5.2 Admission to Dead Sea Service Park

The Service Park will be opened on Sunday, April 11th 2011 at 10:00hrs for all Competitors. All parties are kindly asked to respect the opening hours. Competitors are kindly asked to remind all their team staff to always carry their Service Passes, as the Organiser will be checking on passes and service vehicles plates. During the Rally, only vehicles with affixed Service or Auxiliary plates will be given access to the Service Park. Auxiliary vehicles may only enter the Service Park to bring or collect personnel and/or equipment, except when they can be accommodated within the designated team area or locations shown by the Organiser as Auxiliary parking area.

During the Rally service vehicles are not allowed to move in the Service Park.

Teams or Tyre Manufacturers wishing to bring equipment or sea containers to the Service Park area before the given opening time must inform the organiser thereof. Should the organiser not have received such notification, we cannot guarantee any access to the area. All costs of moving the equipment either within or outside the Service Park to its final position will be borne by the relevant owner of the equipment.

6. Two – Way Radio

GSM, analog and digital telephones are exempted from licensing, provided they fulfill the requirements of relevant equipment standards and specifications. The use of all other kinds of radio transmitters is subject to a license issued by the Jordanian Communications Regulatory Authority. The Authority shall be notified of the frequencies in the equipment in question, upon which it will decide on assigning the customer a suitable frequency and will issue a license for the radio transmitter.

Throughout the Rally, the use of frequencies for amateur radio is prohibited.

At the Pre-Event Scrutineering, the radio transmitters and licenses will be inspected. Radio transmitters in private aircrafts will be inspected, too.

The applications for the use of radio transmitters are due on Thursday, March 3rd 2011.

7. Import of Vehicles and Spare Parts

All foreign Competitors will have to report at the customs on their way in. All vehicles must have a valid carnet and a detailed packing list of all spare parts and tools.

It is preferable if all details are sent to the Organiser 3 - 4 weeks before the Rally. The information must include vehicles' details, date and port of entry. All information can be emailed to: info@jordanrally.com or faxed to the Organiser.

8. Helicopters

Only helicopters registered with the organiser are allowed to operate in this area.

All pilots using the helipads provided by the Organiser must attend the pilots' briefing and must acquire the Organiser's pilots' pack including an information manual containing time tables, maps and information about the Service Park, the Special Stages, GPS coordinates, refuel information, radio frequencies to be used etc. It will include also list of helicopters and pilots and the necessary ID plates for the helicopter.

The pilots' briefing will be at 16:30hrs on Wednesday, April 13th 2011 at Rally HQ.

The Dead Sea's climate

The Dead Sea's climate offers year-round sunny skies and dry air with low pollution. It has less than 50 mm mean annual rainfall and a summer average temperature between 32 and 39 °C. Winter average temperatures range between 20 and 23 °C. The region has weakened ultraviolet radiation, particularly the UVB (erythrogenic rays), and an atmosphere characterized by a high oxygen content due to the high barometric pressure. The shore is the lowest dry place in the world. Proximity to the sea affects the temperature of a place because the sea temperature changes due to the penetration of the sun in the summer. During winter months, sea temperatures tend to be much higher than summer temperature and vice versa during summer months, this is the outcome of slow penetration from the sun into the sea as it is a huge mass and takes a long time to warm up. The region's climate and the unique conditions created by its low elevation have made it a popular centre for several types of therapies.

Goods and Service Tax

A 16% sales Tax and 10% service tax are billed in Jordan.

Travel

Royal Jordanian Airlines links Amman with many of the capitals of Europe, South Asia and the Arab World, and operates wide body jets to New York. Many other international air carriers also operate regularly to Amman. Queen Alia International Airport south of Amman is one of the modern facilities in the Middle East and is currently going a major expansion. Good international roads link Jordan with surrounding countries. Daily bus service and weekly Hejaz Railway trains connect Amman with Damascus. Taxi service is also available.

Travel within Jordan is well-organised and agreeable. A good road system is constantly being expanded and upgraded, and most of the sites a visitor would want to see are at most within a few hours drive from Amman. Jordan's road signs are marked in English and Arabic, and there are petrol stations and rest houses at regular intervals throughout the country.

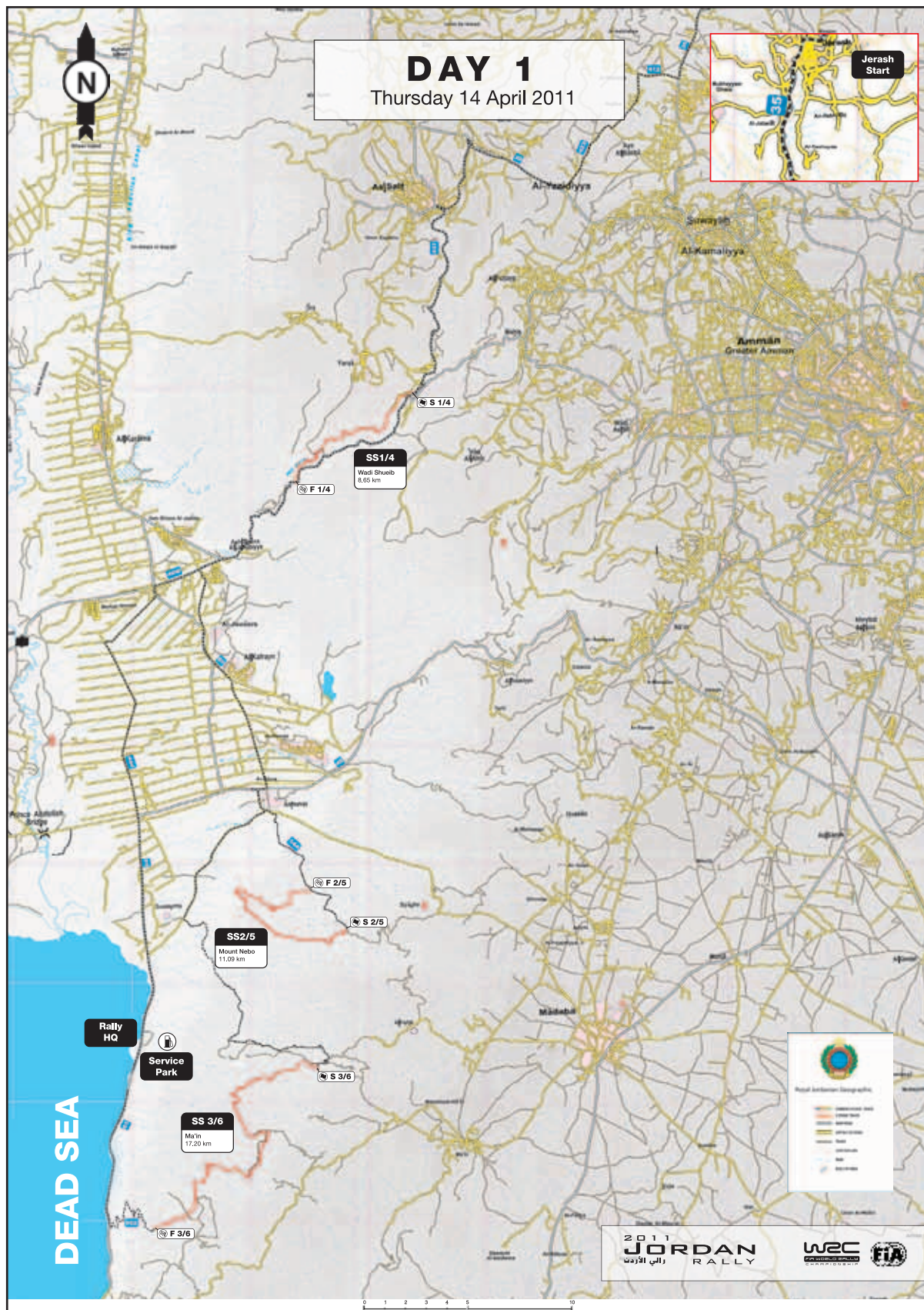

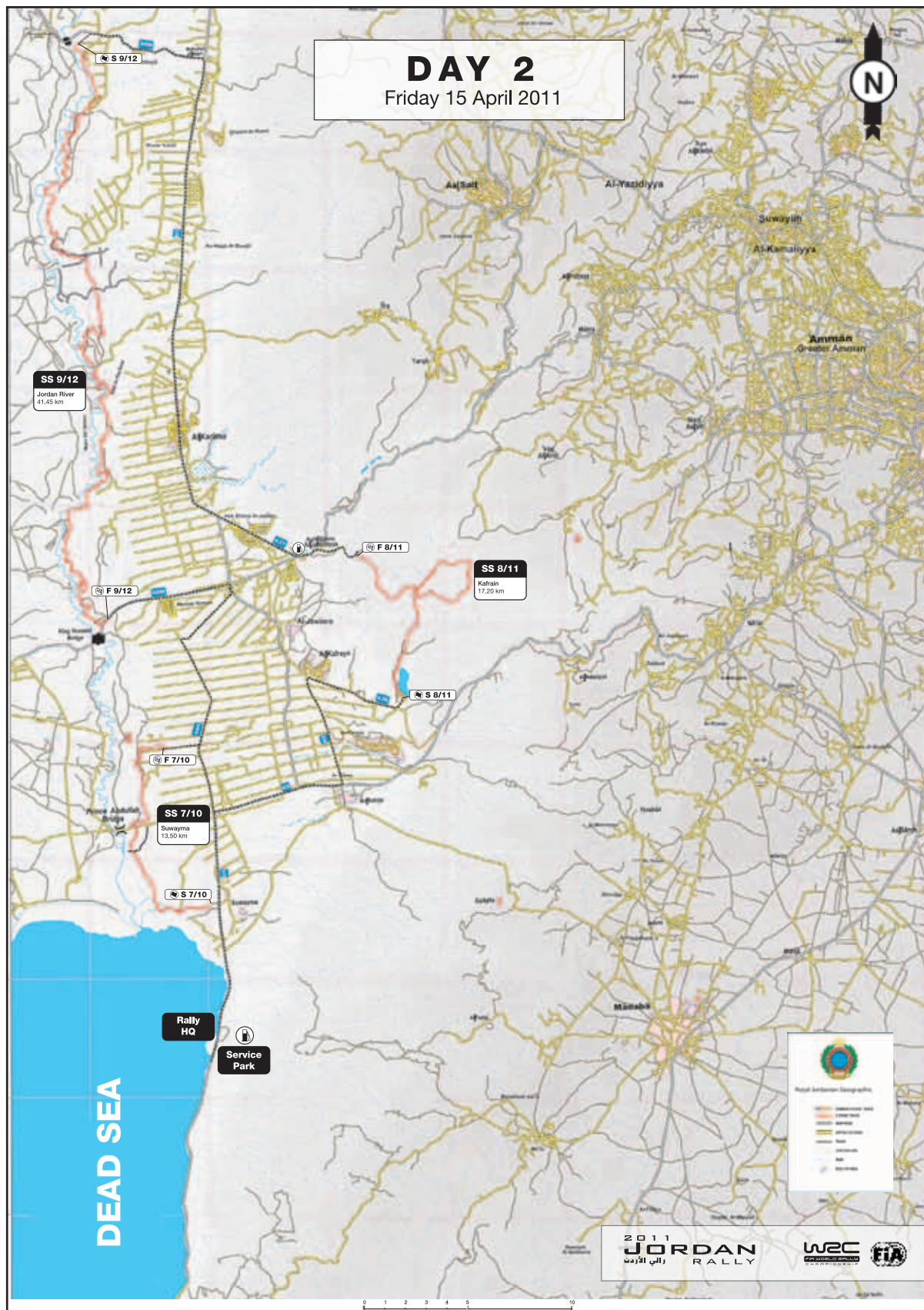

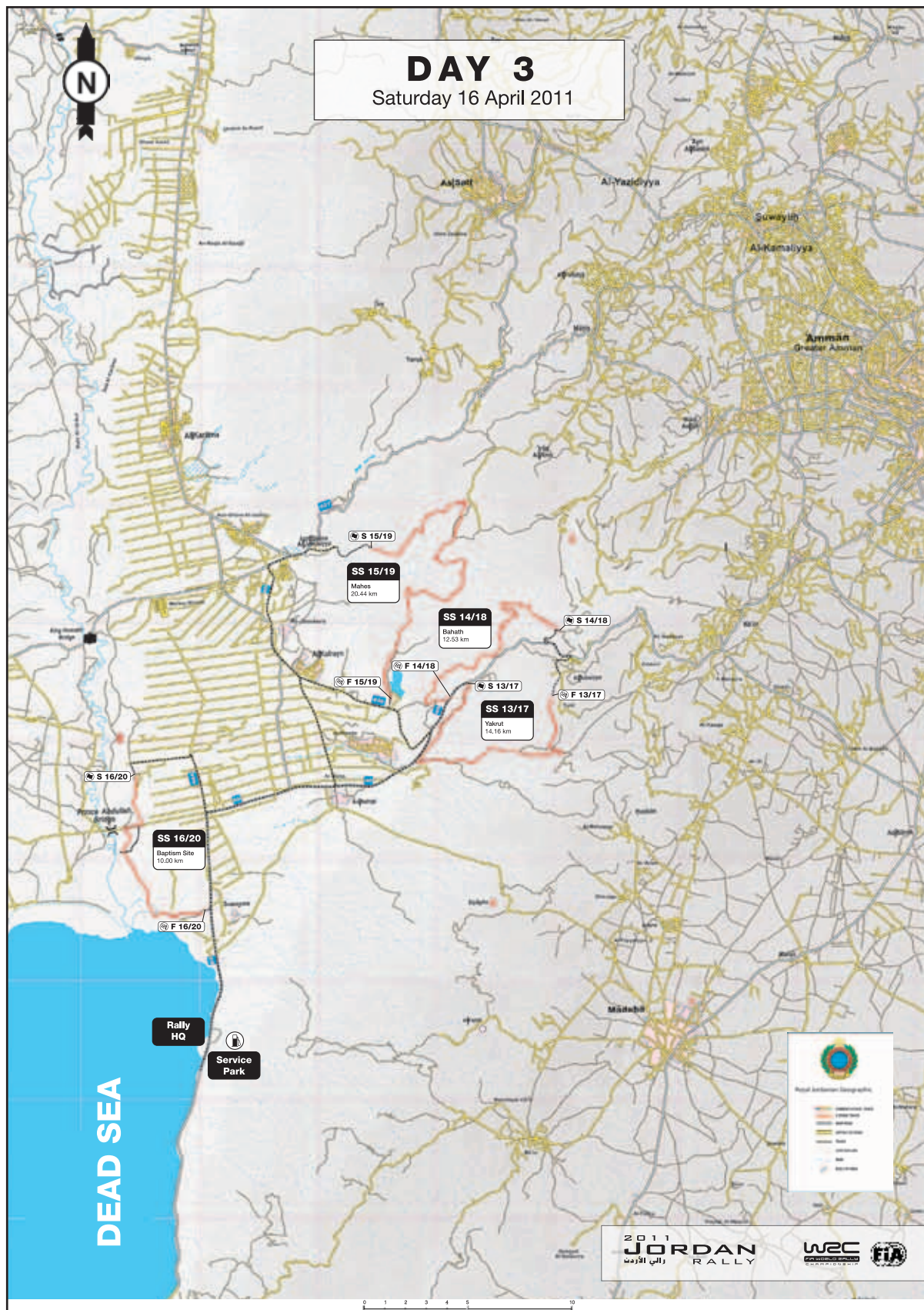
Overview Map Day 1 (Draft)
