1.2. Event Overview

Geko Ypres Rally 2011 will once again be a unique sporting challenge to the European Rally Championship and Intercontinental Rally Challenge with its own character of roads not found elsewhere.

The route is consisting mostly of twisty farming lanes, challenging to both cars and crews.

The event is once again based in the medieval city of Ypres in the Westhoek.

The Service Park is based at the historical Market Place of Ypres with the Rally HQ and the Media Centre in Novotel Ieper Centrum. A Shakedown stage is located in Nieuwkerke.

The event will begin on Friday late afternoon 24th June at the Market Place of Ypres and continue with three special stages driven twice on Friday evening and another twelve special stages driven on Saturday 25th June. The Podium Ceremony will be held on Saturday evening once the competitive section of the rally is finished.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.1. General Information

5.1.1. Location

GPS coordinates: N 50° 51.052 E 2° 53.146 (WGS 84)

As in previous editions, the service park is situated in the town centre of Ypres. The centre of the Service Park is the historical Market Place. The service area surface is tarmac and hard surface. There will be no Remote Service Zones.

Each team/competitor will be allocated a designated space at the Service Park; further information will be given in the Supplementary Regulations and Rally Guide 2.

5.1.2. Access

The Service Park will be opened for the ERC registered and the IRC teams at 08h00 on Wednesday 22/06, for all other teams at 08h00 on Thursday 23/06.

Teams and competitors are asked to respect the opening times.

Only duly accredited vehicles with the plates provided by the Organiser will be allowed to access the service park and corresponding vehicle parking areas.

SERVICE plates: access to the team's service area. (only one of the two service vehicles allowed in Team's service area)
AUXILIARY plates: only one auxiliary vehicle allowed in Team's Service Area
The other service Vehicle and Auxiliary vehicles can be parked in the nearby Auxiliary parking area: Elverdingestraat, Ypres.

Service Park will close on Sunday 26/06 at 20h00.

Any infringement of the law will render the brochers liable for legal procedures and if their frequencies interfere with the Organisation network, immediate sanctions will be requested.

7. FUEL / TYRES

7.1. Fuel

The use of FIA fuel is not obligatory. All competitors have to use a fuel in accordance with Art.9 Appendix J art. 252.

All competitors may only refuel in the refuelling zone. There will be one refuelling zone. For safety reasons and competitors' comfort guarded fuel storage containers will be available in the refuelling zone for all competitors. More information concerning this container will be available at the Permanent Secretariat and with the Refuelling Officer. It is forbidden to use the competition car for transportation of fuel and personnel between Service Park and refuelling.

. To access the refuelling zone each service crewmember will have to wear the armband provided with the service pack.

Each team will receive 2 refuel armbands by Collection of Materials and Documents, these need to be returned together with the Safety Tracking System on Saturday evening after the last Service HQ to "Rally Welcome, Rally H" (Ter Waarde 10, 8900 Ypres at last on Sunday 26/06/2011 01h00. For each armband not returned the charge of € 20 will occur.

7.2. Tyres

7.2.1. Tyres specified for use during the Rally

In addition to complying with the 201 Regional Rally Championships Sporting Regulations, the quantities of tyre confirmed for use: no limitation.

The official tyre suppliers of the IRC championship will be present at the service park.

7.2.2. Tyres for use on Reconnaissance

Only homologated commercial road tyres are allowed.

7.2.3. National Laws or Special Requirements

The use of studded tyres is not allowed.

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

8.1. From the European Union

Competitors coming from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment with the purpose to participate in Geko Ypres Rally 2011.

8.2. From outside the European Union

If you are importing the rally car, service vans and/or spare parts/equipment from outside the European Union you must report to customs at arrival in Belgium. Please contact the Custom authority in Belgium in advance.

9. HELICOPTERS

9.1. Registration procedure

In accordance with the FIA guidelines on helicopter use, all helicopters flying in the support of the Rally must be registered with the Organisers. It is intended that, as a safety precaution, there will be a protocol to control Rally airspace and only registered aircraft will be allowed to fly in this airspace.

All pilots will receive an information manual containing time tables, maps and information about the Service Park, special stages, GPS coordinates, refuel information, radio frequencies to be used etc. An administrative fee of € 1.000 (excl. VAT) will be charged for this service.

12. RECONNAISSANCE

12.1. Registration

The registration for reconnaissance will take place as following:

Monday 20/06 10h00 – 20h00

For ERC registered and IRC teams with legal entry (See Art. 4.4 of S.R.) materials may be collected and reconnaissance registration may be done by a team member duly designated in writing (11milia.kivimae@ypresrally.com). Other crews will be obliged to attend in person.

12.2. Regulations and Restrictions

Competitors are permitted a maximum of 3 passages over each special stage.

A reconnaissance control card will record each competitor’s passage over the stages.

The reconnaissance control card will be returned during the administrative checks.

The reconnaissance pass must be posted on the top right of the front windscreen of the reconnaissance car.

Any infringement to traffic laws (except speeding) or case of dangerous behaviour or disrespect of the reconnaissance time schedule duly recorded and reported to the clerk of the course by **the police or any of the event officials listed in Art 2.7** here above, will result in a penalty as ruled by Article 153 of the International Sporting Code and/or in the hereinafter penalty schedules:

- 1st infringement: convocation by the Clerk of the Course
- 2nd infringement: a cash penalty of € 500
- 3rd infringement: a cash penalty of € 1.000 with a transfer of a file to the RACB Sport (2 & 3 are cumulative)
- 4th infringement: decision by the stewards of the meeting. Sanction can go as far as exclusion.

Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the Clerk of the Course as follows:

The amount of the fines will be unaltered by any fine imposed by the police.

The fine will be doubled in case of a second speeding offence is committed during reconnaissance in the same rally.

12.3. Schedule

Reconnaissance for all drivers will take place Tuesday 21/06 and Wednesday 22/06 between 9:00 and 21:00.

Separate Instructions for Shake Down reconnaissance will be given with the reconnaissance documents.

13. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

13.1. Scrutineering Venue and Timetable

On Wednesday evening between 18h and 22h, for competitors with a legal entry, an additional scrutineering/sealing will be organized for the spare parts of their participating cars. Appointments can be made by e-mail (12milia.kivimae@ypresrally.com).

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative, duly designated in writing must arrive at the scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable hereinafter.

The cars should be presented with dismantled sump guard and fully prepared for all necessary sealing:

1. body shell and engine-block for all competitors
2. compressor (turbocharger) and the spare one for all compressor equipped cars
3. transmissions and the spares for all cars of FIA priority drivers and 4WD IRC car drivers
4. FIA Technical passport and its marking is compulsory for all S2000 cars.

The car's complete certified homologation form must be shown.

Seat Belts

The driver and all passengers are required to use front and rear seat belts at all times.

Speed Limits

Belgium operates its speed limits in kilometres per hour.

Built up areas	50 kph (30 kph in school areas)

There are other limits indicated by traffic signs.

Traffic rules

Drive on the right and overtake on the left hand side of the road.

It is illegal to use a hand-held mobile phone whilst driving.

The blood/alcohol limit in Belgium is 0.5 milligrams of alcohol per litre of blood. The police have the power to carry out random alcohol tests on drivers at any time and a blood sample will be taken if a driver refuses a breathalyser test. Drivers can request to wait 30 minutes before taking a breath test. A driver found to have more than the legal limit of alcohol is fined an amount that depends on the blood alcohol level and in some cases the driver's license may be confiscated immediately or for a period of a few hours.

Signposts

Signposting is generally in Flemish in the area of Ypres however in the French speaking part of Belgium the signposting is generally in French

Passports and Visas

EU citizens when travelling to Belgium do not require passports. Such visitors should however carry identification. All visitors from other countries must carry a valid passport.
