3. ENTRIES

3.1 Opening and closing dates.

Opening date for entries is Monday, 3 April 2006.

Deadline for sending the entry form: each entry must reach the Organiser by Friday, 12 May 2006, 24.00 h (reduced entry fee) or Friday, 26 May 2006, 24.00 h (normal entry fee). If this application is sent by fax or e-mail, the original must reach the organiser 7 days after the relevant closing date of entries at the latest.

3.1.1 Entry procedure

3.4 Payment

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority, unless the organizer decides otherwise in individual cases.



3.5 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted and in the case of the rally not taking place.

The organisers may refund up to 50 % of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN) were unable to start in the rally.



4. INSURANCE

The entry fee includes the insurance premium, which guarantees the competitors cover for civil liability towards third parties up to the sum of 400 000 PLN. The insurance cover will come into effect from the start and will cease at the end of the rally or at the moment of retirement, disqualification or exclusion of the crew in question. All foreign competitors must hold the International Insurance Card, which should be presented in the Rally Office at the administrative checks.

The organiser does not take any responsibility for the losses and the damages in regard to competitors. The competitors take part in the rally at their own risk. In case of any accident, the competitor or his representative should report this fact at the next SOS point or control point, respecting the prescriptions of the Accident Procedure and then submit a written report in the Rally HQ before the time of publication of the results. By the very fact of signing the entry form, the crew relinquishes any rights to compensations of any kind which may occur following the incidents during the rally. This relinquishment concerns the FIA, the PZM (ASN of Poland), the Organiser, officials and other competitors.

5. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

- **5.1** All advertising must comply with the Polish Law.
- **5.2** Organizers compulsory advertising will be placed on the door numbers and the rally plates. Organizers optional advertising will be published later in bulletin.
- **5.3** Details concerning official sponsors and media sponsors of the Rally will be published later in the bulletin.
- **5.4** The organiser reserves for himself the exclusive right to place any kind of advertising in the Rally Headquarters and along the route of the Rally. All advertising activities must be agreed with the organizer.
- **5.5** The competing cars may not be accompanied onto the Start / Finish podium by team members or any other persons. Displaying of any advertising elements such as flags, banners, umbrellas etc. as well as distributing of any advertising materials is not allowed, unless the organiser grants the written permission upon request from the competitor.
- **5.6 Plates**: Rally plates must be affixed as shown in Appendix 4 to present Regulations for the entire duration of the Rally. The front plate must under no circumstances cover, even partially, the car's registration number plate. Such an infringement will result in a penalty decided by the Stewards, who may impose a penalty as in art. 152 and 153 of the Code.
- **5.7 Competition numbers** supplied by the Organisers must appear on both front doors of the car according to Appendix 4 during the whole rally. If it is ascertained at any time during the rally that any competition number is missing, this will be reported to the Stewards, who may impose a penalty as in art. 152 and 153 of the Code.





6. TYRES

All competitors must only use tyres complying with the General Prescriptions, the FIA European Rally Championship sporting regulations and other regulations. Use of studded tyres is prohibited under penalty to be decided by the Stewards.

7. FUEL

- 7.1 All competitors must only use commercial fuel meeting the requirements of Appendix J (Art. 252.9). The maximum lead content permitted in Poland is 0,15 g / l.
- **7.2** Refuelling may only be performed during the rally in the refuelling zones as specified in the Road Book. A maximum of 2 refuellers per competing car are allowed in the refuelling zone in the same time.

8. RECONNAISSANCE

8.1 Procedure for registration

Each crew who is going to perform the reconnaissance must register with the organiser in the Rally Headquarters as specified in the art. 2.10 on Tuesday, 6 June 2006, 14.00 – 19.00 h or on Wednesday, 7 June 2006, 7.00 – 10.00 obtain the reconnaissance documents, including the reconnaissance card. Competitors who fail to register in this date may register later.

8.2 Schedule

Leg 1 – 7 June 2006, 8.00 – 18.00 h

Leg 2 – 8 June 2006, 8.00 – 18.00 h

The reconnaissance will be carried out according to art. 14.1.2 of the General Prescriptions.

10 8.3 Restrictions

8.3.1 Any kind of practice on the rally route is forbidden.

- 8.3.2 During the reconnaissance the crews must strictly observe the prescriptions of the Polish Traffic Code. Particularly, they must respect speed limit of 50 km/h in the built-up area and 90 km/h outside it. Using the radar detector is forbidden.
- 8.3.3 Each crew will be allowed to drive a maximum 2 times each special stage during the reconnaissance. Speed limit during SS reconnaissance is 70 km/h outside the built-up area. The crews are required to present their reconnaissance cards at the start and finish of each special stage for time entry.
- **8.3.4** In no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction to that of the rally in the special stages during reconnaissance.
- **8.3.5** Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the Platinum 63 Rally Poland, who will be found present on the route of any special stage of the rally between 3 March 2006 and 11 June 2006 outside the reconnaissance schedule as well as during the rally, will be considered a person performing the forbidden reconnaissance.

Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the 63 Rally Poland, who wishes to drive on road which is used as the special stage of the rally before 12 June 2006, must notify the organiser beforehand in writing of his / her intention, giving the date and time of the passage and must obtain the organiser's written permission.

- **8.3.6** The organiser will control thoroughly the route of special stages on regular basis.
- 8.3.7 Any infringement against reconnaissance regulations and particularly reconnaissance



outside the given schedule will be considered a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards who will judge each case and may impose a penalty which may go as far as start refusal.

8.3.8 Reconnaissance cars

The reconnaissance may only be carried out using series production cars complying with the specifications given in the art. 14.3 of General Prescriptions.

8.4 Any testing in voivodeship Warmińsko – Mazurskie before 63 Rally Poland are prohibited without local government agree

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

- 9.1 The administrative checks for all competitors will take place at the Rally Headquarters in the Gołębiewski Hotel in Mikołajki on Friday, 9 June 2006, 7.00 10.00 h. Alternatively, any competitor will be allowed to report for their administrative checks on Thursday, 8 June 2006, 16.00 20.00 h.
- **9.2** Each crew will report to the administrative checks in its individual time given in the schedule published later in the bulletin.
- 9.3 Documents to be presented:
 Sporting licences of the competitor and both crew members;
 Driving licences of both crew members;
 Medical certificates of both crew members with updated entry;
 Registration document of the rally car;
 Insurance policy of the rally car;
 Rally car book (only for cars registered in Poland);

10. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

- 10.1 The scrutineering, sealing and marking will be carried out in Rally Park Mikołajki on-Friday, 9 June 2006, 8.00 – 13.00 h.
- **10.2** Each crew will report to the scrutineering in its individual time given in the the schedule published later in the bulletin.
- **10.3** Other regulations
- **10.3.1** Any crew reporting with a lateness at the Scrutineering will be penalized with a fine of 50 % of the basic entry fee.
- **10.3.2** Using of tinted film on the rear and side windows is allowed according to art. 253.11 of Appendix J and Polish Traffic Law ("Prawo o Ruchu Drogowym")
- **10.3.3** The noise level of each rally car must not exceed 98 dB(A) during the whole rally. The measuring of the noise level may be carried out during the pre-rally Scrutineering as well as in every moment of the rally.







11. FEATURES OF THE RALLY

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

11.1 The ceremonial start of the rally will take place on Friday, 9 June 2006 at 18.00 at the Rally Park Mikołajki. Each crew will report to the starting area before 17.45h.

Oficial start will take place on Saturday, 10 June 2006 at 8.00 at the Rally Park Mikołajki.

Further instructions and information about the ceremonial start and the procedure will be published in Rally Guide 2

11.2 Time card change during the rally:

The tin 5 – TC 12Bme card for section 1 will be issued at TC 0

Section 2 – TC 3A Section 3 – TC 6D Section 4 – TC 9A Sectio

- **11.2.1**Official Time: Atomic Clock from Maineflingen BCS 77 Radio 77,5kh.
- **11.3** Starting procedure for the special stage will be as follows:

The electronic equipment provided with 2-digit display and 2 green lights will be employed on each start of the special stage. It will be electronically coupled with the photo cell for possible false start detecting. The photo cell will be positioned approx. 40 cm ahead of the starting line.

When a car with its crew stops at the start line, the counting down will be made by an electronic display positioned ahead of the starting line clearly visible for a crew standing at the start position. Numbers 30, 15, 10, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 will be displayed consecutively showing seconds remaining to the start. Precisely in the moment of the start, the 2 green lights will on. The time of displaying the green lights will be 20 seconds, showing the time in which the crew must start, according to art. 19.4 of General Prescriptions.

- **11.4** Crews are authorised to check-in early (before their target time) at the time control at TC 6C and 12D without incurring a penalty for early arrival.
- **11.4.1** From TC 12D Park Ferme regulations are obligatory.
- **11.5** Identification of officials:

11.6 No special stage during the Platinum 63 Rally Poland will be run under Super Special Stage regulations.

13. PRIZES

- **13.1** The prize giving ceremony will be held on Sunday, 11 June 2006, approx. 16.44 h on the arrival of crews in the finish of the rally in Rally Park Mikołajki
- **13.2** Cup prizes: 2 cups for:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the general classification;
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in group N classification;
- 1st place in Super 1600 category;
- 1st place in each class.
- **13.3** Prize giving for the Polish Rally Championship will be held according to the ASN regulations of this series.
- **13.4** The final list of others awards will be posted on the Official Notice Board on 9 June 2006.

14. FINAL CONTROL & PROTESTS

- **14.1** Immediately after the finish podium, cars appointed by the stewards will be taken for the final contrtol, which will be carried out in Rally Park Mikołajki. The final checks will start on 11 June 2006, approximately at 17.00 h. Crews are obliged to observe the instructions from organizer. The competitors are obliged to ensure that at least one representative of the entrant and the relevant number of mechanics be present at the final checks.
- **14.2** Sum of the protest fee set by the ASN is 100% of basic entry fee (see art. 3.3 of present Supplementary Regulations for definition).
- **14.2.1** If the protest requires the disassembling and re-assembling of certain parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit of:

 - 200 % of basic entry fee if the protest involves clearly defined part or assembly (engine, steering, transmission, brake systems, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.)

- 500 % of basic entry fee if the protest involves the entire vehicle.

- 14.2.2 The expenses incurred by the work and by transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protesthas been lodged if it is upheld.
- **14.2.3** If the protest is unfounded, and expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher the deposit amount, the difference will be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference will be returned to them.
- **14.3** Sum of the appeal fee:
- 14.3.1 Sum for a national appeal fee (ASN) is 2 500 PLN;
- 14.3.2 Sum for an international appeal fee (FIA) is 6000 EUR.




