4. ENTRIES

4.1. Closing date for Entries

Tuesday 5 September, 2012, before 24:00 (GMT +3:00)













4.2. Entry procedure

Those wishing to take part in Prime Yalta Rally 2012 must send the Entry form, available on www.yaltarally.com, duly completed to the organiser before the closing date and time for entries (Art 16 2012 FIA Regional Rally Championships Sporting Regulations – 2012 FIA RRCSR).

In case the competitor is not one of the drivers a copy of the valid competitors' license must accompany the entry form.

For foreign competitors, drivers and co-drivers, authorization must be given by their ASN according to Art.70 of the Code and the original has to be presented at the Administrative checks.

A competitor may freely replace the car declared on the entry form with another from the same group and the same class, up to the moment of Scrutineering. A competitor is permitted to cancel his entry application up to the close of entries. After closure of entries, one member of the crew may be replaced with the agreement of:

- The organisers, before the start of the administrative checks
- The stewards, after the commencement of the before of these checks and before the publication of the list of crews.

4.3. Number of competitors accepted and classes

The maximum number of entrants is 120. If more than 120 entries are received, the Organisers reserve the sole right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

Regional cars shal have their own classification for the National Championship and will not appear on any classifications of the International Event.

4.6. Refunds

5. INSURANCE

5.1. Organisers insurance

The Organiser has contracted a Civil Public Liability Organiser Insurance according the National Sporting Rules that covers for damage to third parties caused by an accident during the preparation, conduct and the physical settlement of the event and is due an organized fault.

Details of insurance policy will be announced via bulletin.

5.2. Competitors insurance

Cars insured by foreign companies must have traffic insurance valid for Ukraine. For cars coming without a green card, insurance must be taken at the Ukrainian border.

Both members of crew must have personal insurance for accidents with cover limit not less than 10000 Euro.

5.3. Insurance policy cover

The service vehicle, even those bearing special plates issued by the Organiser, may never be considered as official participants in the Rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the event and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

6. ADVERTISING & IDENTIFICATION

6.1. Advertising

6.1.1. General information

Competitors are allowed to affix any kind of advertising to their cars, provided that

- It is authorized by the national laws and the FIA regulations
- It is not likely to give offence
- It is not political or religious in nature.

The advertising space on the competition numbers and the rally plates belong to the Organiser. The advertising is obligatory and described in Appendix 4. Any cutting, damaging, or foreign advertising on competition numbers or rally plates will give the following penalty: start refusal or exclusion.

The optional advertising cannot be removed or displaced; any infringement will be penalised by payment of the entry fee "without optional advertising". (Art. 4.4)

6.1.2. Obligatory Advertising, Competition Numbers (See App.IV)

• 1 – Competition numbers.

Rear side windows (2 per car): Two competition numbers measuring 20cm high, with a stroke with of 25 mm coloured fluorescent orange (PMS 804) and may be reflective, one for each rear side window, adjacent to the crew's names and national flags.













- 2 Official front plate (bonnet, 1 per car): One front plate measuring 43x21.5cm placed on the bonnet of the car, including the competition number and the full name of the Rally: PRIME YALTA RALLY (Art. 11 2012 FIA RRCSR).
- 3 Rear window (1 per car): One Official rear window panel measuring a maximum of 30 cm wide and 10 cm high shall be positioned at the top of the rear window at the right side. An adjacent area of 15 cm (cutting not allowed) shall contain a fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the rear at eye level (as shown in the drawing).
- 4 door panels (2 per car): Two rectangular panels measuring 67x17cm including 1 cm white surround. Each of those panels shall comprise a matt black competition number box, which shall always be at the front of the panel. Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803) 14 cm high and with a stroke width of 2 cm. The remainder of this door panel is reserved for the compulsory advertising of the Organiser. This advertising is (cutting not allowed) for both front doors of the car with the number facing the front of the car (5 to 7 cm of the bottom line of the side window). Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. No signage other than the colour scheme of the car shall be placed within 5 cm of this panel.
- 5 Roof Panel (1 per car): One rectangular roof panel measuring 50x52cm with matt black competition number will be displayed on matt white background of 50 cm wide and 38 cm high. One rally plate measuring 14x50cm will be situated above the number, placed on the roof with top facing towards front of the car.
- 6 Driver and Co-Driver names on the front wings and rear side windows according to FIA RRCSR.

6.1.3. Optional Advertising (See App.IV)

- 7 front wings: 2 stickers measuring 20x40cm by one from both sides on front wings.
- 8 front drivers doors. 2 stickers measuring 30x15cm by one from both sides on front doors.
- 9 rear wings: 2 stickers measuring 20x40cm by one from both sides on wings
- 10 roof. 2 stickers on the roof with top facing towards front of the car.

6.1.4. Driver and Co-Driver Names (See App.IV)

 6 – Driver's Initials + name and co-drivers Initials + name with their national flag of licensing country (6 cm high and stroke 1 cm) according to FIA RRCSR Art.13 adjacent to the competition number (rear side windows).













6.1.5. IRC cars branding (See App.IV)

Several elements remain exclusive for the IRC:

- IRC 1 A 15cm stripe on the front windscreen of each Rally car
- IRC 2 A 8cm stripe on the rear windscreen of each Rally car
- IRC 3 2 Side mirrors stickers
- IRC 4 − 2 stripes on both rear and front bumpers.

6.2. Identification Violation and advertising location

The absence of at least one rally plate at any moment during the rally will be fined in amount of 300 UAH for each.

The absence on the car of name of the driver and national flag (unless rear side windows of the car were broken during the competition) will cause penalization in amount of 500 UAH fine.

7. TYRES

The use of studded tyres is now allowed.

7.1. During the reconnaissance

Only homologated commercial road tyres are allowed.

7.2. During the rally

The tyres for IRC classification are in accordance with IRC requirements. In addition to complying with the 2012 Regional Rally Championships Sporting Regulations

Only tyres marked by the organizers may be used. Cars may use a maximum of two spare wheels. Any complete wheel fitted on the car or installed inside the car during servicing must reach the next Service Park or the next service area where a tyre change is authorised. No complete wheel may be loaded on or taken from the car elsewhere than in the Service Parks or service where a tyre change is authorized.

There will be a two marking zone and a tyre checking zone. (Art 50.4 FIA, RRCSR).

8. FUEL

See App. V for Reccomended Fuel Suppliers List.

8.1. Refuelling zones

For environmental and safety reasons refuelling is permitted only in the refuelling areas specified in the Road Book. After Service Park, Renorming Area and Parc Ferme at Yalta waterfront there will be the following refuelling procedure:

- There will be refuelling zones stated in the Road Books
- All the crews must refuel only at the place shown and marked on the scheme; the team's mechanics are allowed to move towards the refueling zone with the full container (reservoir) for the one rally day only from 05:30













to 07:00 in the morning on 14, 15 and 16 of September 2012. They leave fuel at special storage zone under surveillance of rally officials working all-around the clock.

- At the Administrative checks, each crew gets additional ID numbers for sicking onto the containers (reservoirs) in sufficient quantitiy.
- The Organiser shall bear responsibility only for the containers (reservoirs) left for storage.
- The responsibility for marking and sealing of the containers (reservoirs) is completely on the team's mechanics.

8.2. Refuel at commercial fuelling stations

Competitors may refuel at commercial filling stations on the rally route designated by the organizers in the road book.

8.3. Violation of refueling rules

In case of identification of violation of refueling rules, steward will apply penalization up to exclusion.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1. Procedure for registration

Location: Rally HQ, Sea station

Tuesday 11 September 7:00-19:00

Wednesday 12 September 9:00-19:00 (For crews which takes part only in

National Championship)

One of the crew members must sign at the registration a special ID –form including details of the car that will be used during the reconnaissance.

9.2. Schedule

Reconnaissance must be carried out according to the schedule stated in App. II.

9.3. General rules

Crews are authorized to drive a maximum of 2 times through each special stage (special stages run twice are considered to be one special stage) but only in the same direction as the Rally, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the traffic Laws.

Time cards will be used.

THE RECONNAISSANCE CONTROL CARD HAS TO BE RETURNED BY THE CREWS NOT LATER THAN 18:00 13 SEPTEMBER, 2012

All passages through the SS will be recorded by the Marshals and signed by the competitors. Identification numbers, given at the registration shall be affixed on the both sides (on windscreen and rear window) of the car during the reconnaissance. All reconnaissance operations, for all crews, may only be carried out using Series production cars complying with the specifications defined in the FIA RSCSR and these Regulations.













Series production car, the Safety harnesses in colors similar to those of the interior of the car are authorized.

The car must be painted in a single color.

Underbody protection is authorized (compiling with the group N regulation). Maximum speed on the Special Stages during reconnaissance is 60 km/h. The maximum excess over the maximum speed is 10 km/h.

9.4. Infringement of the reconnaissance

9.4.1. Speeding

The Road Police will check the speed on the SS and the Road Section using speed check Equipment. Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows (per km per hour over the speed limit plus maximum excess):

FIA Priority drivers
ASN Priority drivers
Non-priority drivers
150 UAH
10 EUR

The amount of this fine will be unaltered by any fine imposed by the road police.

9.4.2. Other

Any infringement of the reconnaissance regulations will be reported to the Stewards of the meeting. Further, the Stewards may report the competitors.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. Documents to be presented

- Entrants license
- Driver and Co-driver competition licenses (For Ukrainian drivers including medical history sheets)
- Driver and Co-driver passports (identification) and driving licenses
- ASN authorization for all foreign competitors
- International insurance (green card) for foreign competitors
- Insurance for Ukrainian competitors
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car insurance registration papers
- Authorization of the owner of the car if he is not one of the drivers

11. SCRUTINEERING CHECKS, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1. Scrutineering venue and timetable

Location: Bosch centre, 1b Krasina Street, Yalta.

Time: 08:15 – 19:45, Thursday 13 of September, 2012.

Scrutineering Timetable will be announced via bulletin.

11.2. General

Each crew must report to the scrutineering according to the times given in Supplementary Regulations.

Cars must be presented to the scrutineers with rally plates, competition numbers and optional advertising affixed, if taken.

11.3. Driver's safety equipment

Competitors must present all items of clothing including helmets and a FIA approved head restraint (FHR) intended to be used at Scrutineering. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

11.4. Noise level

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J.

11.5. Schedule violation

Any crew reporting late at Scrutineering (according to the time indicated in the entry confirmation) will be penalized as follows:

• Up to 10 minutes 750 UAH

From 10 minutes to 30 minutes 1000 UAH

Over 30 minutes
 1250 UAH

12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. Ceremonial start procedure and order

The Ceremonial start of the «Prime Yalta Rally 2012» will take place at Yalta's waterfront at 17:00 on 14 of September, 2012. It is compulsory for all crews. Any late arrival will be penalized by 5000 UAH.

They must appear in their overalls.

All cars will start according to the start list.

The starting order of the Leg 1 is established as follows:

- Drivers seeded by the FIA Priority
- Drivers seeded by the ASN Priority

All the other entrants left to the discretion of the Organiser.

12.2. Time card distribution

The Time Card for Section 1 will be issued at TC 0.

The Time Cards will be changed at the following time controls:

Section 1: TC 2C













Section 2: TC 5B

Section 3: TC 8C

Section 4: TC 11B

Section 5: TC 14C (Park Ferme)

12.3. Finish podium procedure

Finish procedure will be described and announced.

12.4. Ukrainian rally Championship

The last TC for crews which taking part in round of Ukrainian Rally Championship is 8C.

12.5. Starting system of Special Stages

At the start of each SS there is the following equipment:

- Photocell
- "stop" marker
- Display for time, connected with lighting elements
- Printer

12.5.1. Start procedure

The electronic start procedure coupled to a device to detect and record if a car leaves the start line ahead of the correct signal (jump start). The display shows the current real DIRECT astronomic time (hh.mm.ss.) is being counted, sourced by GPS time. Second line consists of small, one yellow and five red rounded indicators of light. A yellow lights up 30 seconds before start of the next full minute, the red ones light up in the order, in accordance with the elapsing of the last five seconds before the next minute (i.e. 5,4,3,2,1). The start of the next full minute (i.e. the START) is marked by lighting of green traffic light, whichis on the third line of the starting traffic light complex, and is natural cutter of red and yellow indicators in the second line. To ease readiness of the report showing, the third line is additionally provided two-segment (C.C. format) COUNTDOWN.

All the complex structure (i.e. the starting table, timekeeping printers, the transit ray that passes starting line) is worked as the following: the time source is taken from the same GPS device avoiding temporary disparity.

The "Stop" marker is on the starting line, 40 cm after it, is located the photocell. The photocell is connected with the display and a printer, where the eventual jump start time is recorded.

The false start is accordingly recorded at the printer. A false start will be penalized as follows:

1st offence: 10 seconds
2st offence: 1 minute
3st offence: 3 minute.

Further offence: at the steward's discretion













12.5.2. Finish procedure

Timing will record at the finish line, using electronic beams, and be backed up by stopwatches. The timekeepers will be positioned level with the finish line, indicated by the sign bearing a chequered flag on a red background. The crew must report to stop point indicated by a red "STOP" sign to have its finishing time entered on the time card (hour, minute, second, and when applicable tenth of a second). If the timekeepers cannot give the exact finishing time to the marshals immediately, the latter may only stamp the crew's time card and the time will be entered at the next regrouping control. Stopping between the yellow warning sign and the stop sign is forbidden and will be reported to the stewards.

12.6. Early check-in

Early check-in is permitted at:

- TC 2C (PF in) end of Section 1, Leg 1
- TC 8C (PF in) end of Leg 1
- TC 14C (Parc Ferme in / Finish TC) end of Leg2.

12.7. Official time

Official time for rally will be local time – Kyiv, +3:00 GMT. You can adjust your clock or watch to agree with the official time at Registration, Administrative and Technical inspections.

12.8. Repairs to start Leg 1/Section 2

For those cars that failed to complete the super special stage/road section (Section 1 of Leg 1), repairs may be carried out in accordance with Article 39.6.2 FIA RRCSR and the competitor may start Section 2 of Leg 1. The competitor will be deemed to have completed the super special stage / road section and will not have retired.

12.9. Restart after retirement during Leg 1/Section 1

For all competitors who failed to complete the super special stage and/or the road section a time penalty will be applied. This time penalty will be added to the fastest time of the drivers' for each missed stage. This time penalty will be as follows:

- For every missed super special stage 5 minutes
- Should retirement occur on the road section after the SSS 2 the crew will nonetheless be deemed to have missed that last super special stage.

12.10. Re-start after retirement

A crew which has failed to complete a Leg can re-start the rally from the start of the next Leg only if they confirm their intention to the clerk of the course one hour prior to the publication to the start list of the subsequent Leg. The competitor must advise the organiser of the reason for retirement (e.g. accident, technical problems, etc.) and the intention to have the car re-scrutineered. This shall apply to any car that has been excluded on the grounds of exceeding the time limit or has failed to report to a control, but shall not apply where the car has been













excluded for breach of eligibility requirements, traffic infringements or by a decision of the stewards.

12.11. Scrutineering of repaired cars.

The car must retain its original body shell and engine block as marked at pre-event scrutineering. The competitor must be represented during this re-scrutineering at a time advised by the organisers.

12.12. Service Park

There is one Service Park for the entire rally. Each team/competitor will be allocated at the Service Park.

Location: Yalta waterfront

Opening: Monday 10 of September, 2012 as from 16:00

Closing: Monday 17 of September, 2012 at 12:00

Maximum one service vehicle per racing car will be authorized in the service parks. This vehicle must imperatively be parked in the allocated surface of each competitor. Any breach of this rule will be fined 15000 UAH.

Allocated surfaces in service parks for competitors registered in IRC:

- 200 sq.m per entered IRC Manufacturer
- 130 sq.m for one entered car
- 200 sq.m for 2 cars
- 50 sq.m for each additional car

Allocated surfaces for other competitors:

FIA Priority: 20x10 m.Non-priority: 10x10 m.

It's sctrictly prohibited at the Service Park area:

- To move sports and Auxiliary cars in the direction different from the stated in the scheme (except for the teams with big trucks and only for parking them in the special parking places, stated and allowed by the Rally HQ).
- To have more than one Service vehicle per competitor and park, breaking the set parking limits (the Auxiliary vehicles are only allowed to park at the areas stated by the Organiser).
- To leave at the Park Service the items for carrying the sports cars like car carriers (they must be parked at the parking areas stated by the Organiser)
- To do the fix/repair works outside the protecting ground covers.
- To spill, by any means, any liquids on the Waterfront ground or sea, and break the acting standards and requirements for environmental protection legislation.
- To move along the Yalta's Waterfront or along any other Yalta's streets with fuel containers (reservoirs), except for the time stated by this Supplementary Regulations.













The speed limit in the Service Park is 10 km/h.

Any service vehicles are allowed to leave the Service Park Area during and after the rally only after permission of the person in Charge for the Service Park area.

The big service vehicles or trucks are only allowed to leave the Service Park Area on Monday the 17^t of September, 2012 from 00:00 till 12:00.

Service vehicle is only allowed to enter the Service Park only if it is identified with Service plates affixed on the vehicle as instructed by the Organiser.

For the access to the Auxiliary parking vehicles must carry Auxiliary plate. The plates must be affixed on the vehicle as instructed by the Organiser.

Each participating crew gets additional pass-stickers for vehicles:

Service 1Auxiliary 1Team 1

For the breaking of the requirement stated above the could be applied both financial penalty (even after the rally) and the exemption from the rally on the Stewards decision. During the night time due to the safety reasons it is recommended to store the equipment from the Service area of each team in the service vehicles or trucks.

12.13. Accident reporting

In all cases the crew should complete the Incident Report form in the back of the Road Book and hand it to an official of the rally as soon as possible.

Special stage – if a crew is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver or co-driver concerned must remain at the scene and stop the following car which has to report this to the next radio point as specified in the road book and signed on the route.

Public road – Should a crew be involved in a traffic accident on the public highway in which injury is caused to a member of the public or an animal, or damage caused to the other car or to any property, the crew involved must stop, – the police and after emergency services should be contacted as soon as possible.

- For a protest involving the whole car: 15000 UAH.




