4. Entries

4.1 Closing date for entries

The closing date for entries is:

Tuesday 21 May

4.2 Entry procedure

Competitors wishing to take part in the 2013 Rally Italia Sardegna must send the entry form duly completed (including co-driver details), available on www.rallyitaliasardegna.com to the Rally Permanent Secretariat (see Article 2.3 for contact details).

Manufacturers and WRC Teams, as well as entrants registered for WRC 2 and WRC 3, should make their entries using the standard entry form provided for their championships.

In compliance with the 2013 FIA International Sporting Code, foreign entrants/drivers must be in possession of the approval of their ASN which must be attached to the entry form or produced at administrative checks at the latest. With the submission of the entry form, each foreign entrant and/or driver/co-driver declares that he/she is in possession of this authorisation.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total entry fee. If the entry form is sent by fax or e-mail, the original must reach the organiser by Tuesday 28 May.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- The total entry fees or a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority
- Photocopies of the Competitor, Driver and Co-driver competition licence
- Photocopies of the Driver and Co-driver valid driving licence
- One passport photo for each member of the crew
- Photocopy of the 1st page of the car homologation form for the entered car
- **4.2.1** By submitting their entries, the competitors, drivers and car owners waive any claims or rights to pursue action for damages in connection with the event against the Organiser

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and classes

- **4.3.1** The maximum number of entrants will be 90. If more than 90 entries are received, the Organiser reserve the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

4.6 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- in case of the rally not taking place

5. Insurance

- 5.1 The entry fee includes the insurance premium for the competitors' civil liability to third parties (not among participating crews, even if one of them has retired) whilst taking part in the rally (the entire route). Cars participating in the "Free Practice / Qualifying Stage / Shakedown" and in the Ceremonial Start will be covered by the same Insurance.
- 5.2 The cover of this Insurance is limited to € 10,000,000.00 per accident, in corporal or material damage.
- This Insurance will become effective at the start of the rally and will cease at the end of the rally or at the moment of permanent retirement or exclusion, time limit for appeal, end of Podium Ceremony or end of Technical Scrutineering (selected cars).
 Cars having retired and re-started the next Leg shall not be considered to have permanently retired. In case of withdrawal, the time taken into account will be the closing time of the following TC.
- The Insurance cover all the itineraries provided in the Road book for the cars participating in the "Free Practice / Qualifying Stage / Shakedown", from 07:00 to 15:00 on Thursday 20 June.
- The Insurance cover all the itineraries provided in the Road book for the cars participating in the Ceremonial Start, from 16:00 to 24:00 on Thursday 20 June.
- 5.6 Competitors are reminded that only damages caused to third parties by the Organiser and the entered drivers is covered by the Insurance policy taken by the organisation. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars is not covered by this insurance.
- 5.7 The Organiser decline liability for any accident sustained by competitors or competing car during the duration of the event, even in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism, etc. Entrants and crew members shall suffer all the consequences (material, criminal and sporting) raised by any type of accident.
- Vehicles carrying "Service" or "Auxiliary" plates and / or any other special plate issued by the Organiser (apart the cars used by the Officers and the Delegates, the Safety and the Zero Cars of the Organiser) are not covered by the event's Insurance policy. These vehicles circulate under the sole responsability of their owners and the organiser bears no responsibility for them.
- Vehicles used by the crews during reconnaissance, even if bearing the event's specific stickers, must be insured by their owners. The Organiser bears no responsibility for such vehicles.The same rule applies to those vehicles used by drivers who participate in reconnaissance only.

5.10 Accident notification

In case of accident during the Rally, the Free Practice, the Qualifying Stage, the Shakedown or the Ceremonial Start the Competitor or his representative must **immediately notify it in writing** to the Clerk of the course. He must explain the circumstances under which the accident occurred, causes and consequences. Likewise he must mention the names and addresses of any witnesses. He must also mention the names and addresses of any eventual injured people.

6. Advertising and Identification

6.1 Advertising restrictions

Tobacco or tobacco products' advertising is prohibited in Italy; this law applies to competing and service cars, equipment and clothing.

6.3 Identification

Competition numbers and rally plates according to the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Articles 18 and 19.2 and Appendix 4 to the present SR will be issued by the Organiser.

Numbers and plates must be applied to the rally car before the car is brought to scrutineering and must be visible throughout the duration of the rally.

The following stickers will be placed on the car, by the Officials:

- at scrutineering: a "Scrutineered" sticker, size 10 x 6 cm (below the left side rear window);
- at the start of Section 1 (TC0) and of Section 4 (TC8D): a "2 Minutes" sticker (right upper corner of the windscreen) on cars with a Start Interval of 2'.

7.2 Studded tyres

The use of studded tyres is prohibited.

7.3 Tyre marking

- **7.3.1** Tyre marking for the tyres that will be used during the Free Practice, Qualifying Stage or Shakedown will take place at the exit of the SP. For the sole purpose of assisting the tyre marking / bar code reading procedure, one team member for each crew may access this zone.
- **7.3.2** Tyre marking zones for the rally will be organized after the TC OUT of the SP or the Remote Service Zone (RSZ).

7.4 Tyre barcode

As per 2013 WRC Sporting Regulations Articles 60.4 and 62.1 each tyre must have a specific permanent moulded bar code number supplied by an approved FIA bar code supplier. The tyre bar code must always be visible from outside the car.

7.5 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

- **7.5.1** Tyres used during reconnaissance must be designed primarily for tarmac road use.
- **7.5.2** The tread of tyres used during reconnaissance must not exceed a depth of 8,5 mm. Straight circumferential grooves may be no wider than 10,0 mm; all other grooves at any angle to the circumference may be no wider than 7,0 mm.

8. Fuel

All Priority competitors must use FIA fuel as provided by the FIA appointed supplier (see Articles 58 and 59 of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations).

For environmental and safety reasons all competitors must refuel in the designated refuel zones (RZ). Refuelling is not allowed in the SP (no refuel from cans, drums or similar).

8.1 Ordering procedure

Competitors must order their fuel requirements using the order form which is available on the official Rally Italia Sardegna website: www.rallyitaliasardegna.com.

Competitors are responsible for setting direct with the supplier, all matters relating to supply and payment. The price of the fuel is € 5.48 per litre.

8.2 Closing date for ordering FIA fuel

The last date for notifying fuel order requirements is: Wednesday 29 May

8.3 Fuel for Non-priority drivers

Non-priority drivers may either use:

- FIA fuel, following the same conditions and rules as the Priority drivers
- Commercially fuel available at filling stations marked in the Road book: this fuel must be dispensed directly into the competing cars from pumps

8.4 According to the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 59.3.2 all competitors are required to fit FIA specified refuel couplings, except non-priority drivers using a car that retains the standard tank.

9. Reconnaissance

9.1 Procedure for registration

A reconnaissance registration form including details of the car that will be used during reconnaissance, must be completed before commencing reconnaissance.

The identification numbers and "R" sticker given at the registration shall be displayed and remain visible during reconnaissance, as follows:

- the identification numbers on the front doors or on rear side windows of the car;
- the "R" sticker on the top (middle) of the front windscreen.

9.1.1 Participation in reconnaissance only

Any driver holding an FIA licence but not entered in the rally may apply to take part in the reconnaissance. The regulations on reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety. A registration form for this purpose will be sent on request. The final permission for tacking part in reconnaissance is left to the discretion of the Organiser.

9.2 Specific and / or National restrictions

9.2.1 Crews are authorised to drive each SS in accordance to the schedule given in Appendix 2 of the present SR, only in the same direction as the rally, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the Traffic Laws.

A maximum of two (2) passages is permitted over each SS during reconnaissance. SS run twice are considered to be one stage. All passages throughout the SS will be recorded by the Officials of the rally. Time cards will not be used.

- 9.2.2 The maximum speed allowed during reconnaissance on SS is 70 km/h unless another speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or written instruction on the Road book or in a bulletin.
 Competitors not respecting the allowed speed limit will be penalised as per Articles 20.2.2 and 20.2.4 of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.
- **9.2.3** A maximum of 2 (two) passages is permitted over the Qualifying Stage / Shakedown.

9.3 Installation of speed control checking devices

In accordance with Article 25.4.4 of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, at least all cars of FIA priority drivers (P1, P2 and P3) must carry recce GPS recorders on board during reconnaissance. Should additional non priority drivers be required to carry GPS recorders on board, this will be communicated in a Bulletin. The use of such recorders may involve a fee.

9.3.1 Location of collection and return of GPS recorders

GPS recorders will be distributed to competitors and will be returned as stated in the Article 3 of the present SR.

10. Administrative Checks

10.1 Documents to be presented

11.2 General

- Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team
- The competitor must show the car's complete certified homologation form
- The Manufacturers or WRC Teams registered in the Championship may present a signed Certificate of Technical conformity
- After scrutineering, if a car is found not to comply with technical and / or safety regulations, the Stewards may set a deadline before which the car must be made to comply or may refuse the start

11.3 Driver's safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR intended to be used must be produced at scrutineering. Compliance with Appendix L - Chapter III will be checked.

11.4 Sealing and Marking

Car's chassis and engine will be marked as prescribed on Article 26.1.6 of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations. Sealing of the cars' mechanical components (fitted and spares) will be carried out according to the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Articles 63 to 65.

All cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials, and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighing (sealing wires must be installed according to the instructions given in the RG2).

The transmission (fitted and spares) of non priority Drivers' cars will not be sealed.

11.5 Transversal mud flaps

Fitting of transversal mud flaps (all wheels) is compulsory and must comply with the Article 252.7.7 of FIA Appendix J.

11.6 Noise level

The maximum permitted noise level is 98 dBA. The noise level will be measured with a sonometer regulated at "A" and "Slow", placed at a distance of 50 cm. from the exhaust outlet with an angle of 45 degrees, the car engine running at 3.500rpm.

11.7 Special and / or National requirements - Cars equipment

Competing cars must be equipped with:

- One reflective triangle
- One red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42x29,7 cm (A3 size)
- Two fluorescent jackets (one per person)

11.8 Installation of on-board cameras (2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 65.1)

The Entrant of any car which carries an on-board camera must have the prior agreement of the 2013 FIA WRC Championship Promoter. Authorised cameras will be identified by an adhesive decal and must be mounted in the car at the time of scrutineering. Competitors wishing to use a camera must supply the following information to the Promoter (rally@thesportsman.de) before Tuesday 11 June (one week before the start of reconnaissances): entrant name, car number, entrant address and use of footage.

11.9 Installation of Safety Tracking System (2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 65.2)

All competitors must make provisions in their rally car(s) for the installation of the FIA Safety Tracking System and the Emergency button. Installation instructions will be given later in RG2. The correct functioning of the equipment will be checked at scrutineering.

A deposit with credit card imprint will be collected from the competitors, when they pick up their equipment from the SIT Sports, according to the programme given in Article 3 of the present SR. Should a crew retire, the equipment must be returned immediately to SIT Sports. The units may be removed in the Final Parc fermé, so cars must not be locked.

12. Other procedures

12.1 Ceremonial start - procedure and order

The Ceremonial Start is compulsory for all competing cars and crews and will take place at Piazza Italia - Sassari on Thursday 20 June, from 19:30.

All competing cars will enter a holding area at Piazzale Segni - Sassari (same venue of RSZ of Leg 1 - Friday 21 June), from 17:00 to 18:30.

Teams are free to drive or transport their rally cars as they wish to and from the holding area. Entering the holding area outside the indicated time window will incur a cash penalty of € 250,00. The transfer of the rally cars in numerical order from the holding area to Piazza Italia - Ceremonial start and vice versa, will take place in convoy of 5 cars escorted by the Police.

Crew members must wear their approved overalls at the Ceremonial start.

After the Ceremonial start competing cars are free until TCO.

12.2 Start List for Section 1

For safety reasons, the Stewards reserve the right to change the start list for Section 1 of the rally, as selected by Priority 1 and Priority 2 drivers.

12.3 Starting system of SS

The standard light sequence mentioned in Article 37.2 and Appendix VII of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations be used. Should this start system fail the start will be given as specified in Article 37.3 of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

12.4 Permitted early check-in

Following the Italian Administrative Authorities' instructions, early check-in is not allowed at the end of Qualifying Section and of Sections 3 and 6 of the rally; penalties as per 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will be applied.

12.5 Finish of the Rally and final Parc fermé

- **12.5.1** The final TC of the Rally is TC 16D from were competing cars will be driven by their crews, under Parc fermé conditions, to the Podium ceremony and then in final Parc fermé in Marina Vecchia Porto Cervo.
- **12.5.2** Competing cars subject to final scrutineering at FIAT Pincar Zona Industriale Olbia (see Article 3 of the present SR) will remain in the same place, under Parc fermé rules, until they are released.

12.5.3 Removal of the cars from final Parc fermé

All cars must be removed from the final Parc fermé within 60 minutes of the results becoming final and the Stewards have authorised the Parc fermé to be opened. Beyond this time the Organiser will not be responsible for the cars.

To collect the competing car, competitors or their representative must present the receipt issued to the crews when entering the final Parc fermé.

12.6 Finish procedure

Finish procedure will be in conformity with Appendix IV of the 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

12.7 Water distribution

The Organiser will provide water only for their own consumption to all crews at the STOP Control of each SS.

12.8 Car wash facility

An official car wash facility will be available before TC QS, TC 6A, TC 8A, TC 12A and TC 16A. The exact location of the car wash will be shown in the Road book.

12.9 Official time used during the Rally

Throughout the Rally the official time will be the UTC-GPS time.

12.10 Re-start after retirement - Rally 2

As per Article 46 of 2013 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.




