## RALLY GUIDE 1

### 1/2 The stakes

#### Year IV

The 2012 Rally France-Alsace saw the expected, triumphant victory of Sébastien Loeb and Daniel Elena who were taking part in their last full World Rally Championship campaign. The local lad won his ninth world championship title in Alsace helping the Citroën World Rally Team to its eighth world manufacturers' crown.

The 2013 Rally France-Alsace will count towards the FIA World Rally Championship titles for Drivers, Co-drivers and Manufacturers, and it will also be open to the WRC 2, WRC 2 Production Car Cup, WRC 3 and WRC Junior entrants.

The 2013 event will mark Sébastien Loeb's last outing in the WRC and the return of Sébastien Ogier to the top level: it will again provide four days' first-class racing on 100 per cent tarmac stages.

Dominique Serieys' team, in close collaboration with the State Services and in compliance with the format recommended by the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA), have made some modifications to the 2013 route.

The Zenith in Strasbourg will remain the nerve centre of the event and will house the main rally infrastructures: service park, parc fermé, HQ, press room, merchandising area, exhibitors' village, Platinum Paddock Club, Finishing Ceremony, etc.

The festivities will begin on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October with a morning shakedown in the HautePierre quarter. After receiving unanimous approval in 2012, the Rally France-Alsace will again kick off in the middle of Strasbourg in the Wacken-Europe quarter.

To provide even more thrills a new 920m section has been added to the SSS1 Strasbourg layout, which will provide even better viewing conditions for the huge crowd of spectators who turned up last year. SSS1 will be the Power Stage, a 2013 French innovation in the context of the World Rally Championship.

The order of stages 2 and 3 has been modified compared to 2012.

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October the drivers will set out on the Bas-Rhin and Vosges roads to tackle a loop of three stages to be covered twice for a total of 116.08 timed kilometers.

The Vosges - Pays d'Ormont stage is the one that has undergone the greatest number of modifications. Around ten kilometers have been lopped off, and the crews will tackle a completely new section through the Raids pass in Bande-Sapt by way of Saint-Jean-d'Ormont.

Special stages 4-7, which could prove crucial in deciding the outcome of the rally, will be as intense as ever from a sporting point of view.

The third day in the Haut-Rhin with Colmar again as the hub will be the longest leg (134.93 timed km).

On Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> October the crews will have to face the challenge of the classic Hohlandsbourg - Firstplan and Soultzeren - Pays Welche stages whose varied layouts and sporting intensity add so much to the rally's renown. The Vallée de Munster special stage has been modified for logistical and meteorological reasons and its distance reduced to 16.73 km.

On Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October the fourth and final leg will consist of 56.58 timed kilometers and will be run in the same order as in 2012.

Although the Vignoble de Cleebourg stage has been reduced by 2.48 km, it will still be as tricky as ever.

Everybody praised the format of the other two stages last year, Bischwiller- Gries and Haguenau, which boosted the sporting intensity of the rally so no changes there. They will provide Haguenau with the opportunity to welcome its local hero before the survivors return to the Zenith in Strasbourg for the finishing ceremony.

The number of timed kilometers of the 2013 Rally France-Alsace has been reduced by 22.76% to 312.14 kilometers out of an overall total of 1250,37 kilometers.

## 5/4 Service park rules and environmental requirements

### 5/4/1 Environmental requirements

The emptying of waste water, the washing of cars and the driving of stakes into the ground are not permitted in the Service Park. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties.

The Rallye de France-Alsace impact on the environment is one of the main organiser's priorities.

### 5/4/2 Rules

Only vehicles carrying a 'Service' or 'Auxiliary' plate may enter the Service Park. Such vehicles may not be driven in the lanes used by competing cars during a period extending from 15 minutes before the due check-in time of the first competitor at "TC SP in" to the last competitor's check-in time at "TC SP out".

Vehicles carrying a "Service" plate may only be parked in its allocated area in the Service Park. Such vehicles are not allowed to access in the "Auxiliary" car park.

Vehicles carrying an "Auxiliary" plate or "Route Notes Cars" plate may only be parked in the parking P6 designated for this purpose.

Reconnaissance's cars will be permitted to use the parking P6 until Wednesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>; after that they will not be permitted to use anymore this parking except carrying "Auxiliary", "Route Note Car" or "Meteo" plate.

Any vehicles or trailers found parked outside the zones in which they are permitted or which fail to respect the published timetable will be towed away immediately.

### **Dismantling:**

For safety reasons, dismantling competitors' service structures in the Zenith SP is not permitted before 6.30 p.m. on Sunday, 6<sup>th</sup> October, after the public has cleared the service park.

Any team which breaks this rule will be fined 500 €.

In case of retirement during the rally, the team concerned must firstly obtain a dismantling authorization from the Service Park Coordinator.

In accordance with FIA safety regulations and with the requirements of the civil aviation authorities, all helicopters participating in the rally must be duly registered with the Organizer. The registration Form (Appendix 6/2 on website) must be forwarded before August 21, 2013.

The fee due to the Organizer is €2 508, 37 which amounts to €3 000 with VAT (19.6%).

A 10% fee will be charged for cancellations.

Pilots of registered helicopters will receive a 'Helicopter Guide' containing the rules, a traffic manual, maps of the special stages, authorised dropping zones with their GPS points and overflight areas.

#### Registration and materials

Reconnaissance will take place on Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> October, and Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October, in accordance with the schedule specified in the Supplementary Regulations.  
All crews taking part in reconnaissance must complete the registration form (Appendix 6/3 or 6/4 on the website) and return it to the Rally Office, following the procedure specified on the form.

They must register with the Rally Office at Administrative Checks on Monday, September 30, from 14:00 to 21:00 (by arrangement for Manufacturer & WRC Teams, or by appointment for other crews) in order to obtain the necessary materials.

Each crew will be given 'Reconnaissance' stickers, as well as a specific reconnaissance control card.  
"Reconnaissance" stickers have to be fixed on reconnaissance cars on the windscreen, rear side windows and rear window.

The reconnaissance control card must be shown and endorsed by the marshals (identifiable by a tabard) at the stage start, in order to gain access to the special stage (including shakedown), and at the Stop Point.  
On completion of reconnaissance, this reconnaissance control card must be returned to the Rally Office (Zenith) no later than 10:00, Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>.

A shakedown session will be organised for all drivers registered to the Rallye de France-Alsace on Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2013 with the following schedule:

07:30 / 09:30	Mandatory shakedown for P1 & P2 drivers
09:30 / 10:30	Optional shakedown for P1, P2 & P3 drivers
10:30 / 13:00	Optional shakedown for P3, no-priority and Junior WRC drivers

Shakedown will take place in Strasbourg - Parc des Sports - Hautepierre.  
Special Stage safety arrangements will apply.  
The start is located at about 200 m from the service park.

Shakedown takes the form of a loop to be completed 2 times, as outlined in the road book (1 complete loop + ¾ of a 2<sup>nd</sup> loop). The total distance of shakedown is 3,80 km.

The road section to go back to the Service Park is about 3,7 km (depending on competitor's location in the service park).

A 4,36 km long additional and optional road section may be used before the shakedown start in order to warm up the car; it must be strictly used under road traffic rules.

A 9,55 km long optional liaison for trip calibration is available.

Any person on board the car during shakedown who is not entered for the rally must have signed a disclaimer provided by the organiser.

When a crew in its competing car is unable to start section 1 due to an accident during shakedown, it may re-start the rally from the start of section 2 provided they notify the Clerk of the Course by writing before 15:00 on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October.

A time penalty as in FIA-WRC Art 46.2.2 & 46.2.3 will apply.

The car must be returned to the Parc Fermé (Zénith) at least 4 hours before the start of the section 2 and must have passed inspection by the scrutineers before being allowed to start.

It is forbidden to drive with a BAC greater than or equal to 0.5 grams per liter of blood, or 0.25 mg of alcohol per liter of air breathed. (Source: <http://www2.securiteroutiere.gouv.fr>)

The presence of an ethylotest (breathalyzer) in the car is recommended.

Seatbelts:

Compulsory for all passengers on front and rear.

Phone:

The use of mobile phones is prohibited while driving.

Trucks:

The circulation of vehicles or combinations of vehicles over 7.5 tones of gross weight is prohibited throughout the network from Saturday or the day before the bank holiday 22:00 to Sunday or bank holiday 22:00. Exemptions may be issued by the local authority of the loading department of the vehicles or the department of entrance in France.
