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1 – INTRODUCTION

Dear Competitors,

The first round of the 2014 World Rally Championship will be the Monte-Carlo Rally. All drivers holding an international licence are welcome but as the number of entrants is limited to 80 may be not all will be able to participate. Nevertheless, the “Promotion” class will be held again and will gather all the non-professional crews.

The 82nd Monte Carlo Rally, held the third week of January, will be marked by many changes due to its new location in the Hautes-Alpes around Gap. However, the daily schedule will still follow the traditional order with the first three days (11th to 13th January 2014) reserved for reconnaissance as well as administrative and technical checks.

On Tuesday 14th January, all competitors will have to attend the Starting Ceremony, which will be held in Monaco, on the Place du Casino at 2.30 pm. Competitors will then drive straight to the prefecture of the Hautes-Alpes.

The next day, Wednesday 15th January, Shakedown will take place in the village of Chateaufieux (RD 245), very closed to Gap, from 8 am. to 12 noon, over a distance of 3.52 km. The proximity with the Service Park will ensure to go back and forth quickly.

But the real competition will start on Thursday 16th with three Special Stages, each run twice, and a break scheduled for midday at the Gap Service Park: Orpierre – St André de Rosans via Col du Rey chasset (25.50 km), Rosans – La Charce via Col de Pomerol (18.00 km) and Montauban sur l’Ouveze – Laborel via Col de Perty (19.50 km).

Friday 17th January will be the longest day of the Rally, with 177 km of special stages, comprising Vitrolles – Faye via Col d’Espreaux (49.25 km run twice), Selonnet – Breziers via Col des Garcinets (22.75 km), Sisteron – Thoard via Col de Fontbelle (36.70 km) and Digne (Ets Thermal) – Chaudon Norante (19.25 km) via Col du Corobin. Competitors will return to the Gap service park around 12 noon and complete the second passage of the Col d’Espreaux before going to Col de Fontbelle. The last Special Stage of the day will be preceded by a one-hour Regroup Park in the centre of Digne-les-Bains and a tyres change in front of the Palais des Congrès. Col du Corobin will be run by night and competitors then continue to the Port Hercule in Monaco, where cars will be in Parc Fermé.

The final day of the Rally (Saturday 18th January) will see competitors leaving the Monaco Service Park from 2.45 pm, in the direction of the Vesubie Valley, where they first drive a loop of two Special Stages in first by day, then, after returning to Monaco at around 7 pm., a second identical loop by night, with the ascent of Col de Turini (La Bollene-Moulinet - 23.5 km), and the Col de Brouis climb (Sospel-Breil-sur-Roya - 16.69 km). The first car is expected to arrive around 11.30 pm at the entrance of the Parc Fermé.

In total more than 380 km of special stages have to be covered before climbing the steps of the podium, on the Place du Palais at 11 am., Sunday 19th January 2014.

5.3 Service Park rules and environmental requirements

5/3/1 Environmental requirements

The emptying of waste water, the washing of cars and the driving of trucks into the ground are not permitted in the Service Park.

Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties.

5/3/2 Rules

Evacuation of trucks and trailers will be compulsory done on Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 January 2014, as from 20h00. All vehicles must be parked on the "Stade de rugby" parking. A signposting will be set up. After the delay, all trucks/trailers parked in the Service Park will get a 1.000 euros penalty per vehicle immediately paid to the Organiser by Teams or Competitors.

Only vehicles carrying a "Service" or "Auxiliary" plate may enter the Service Park. Such vehicles may not be driven in the lanes used by competing cars during a period extending from 15 minutes before the due check-in time of the first competitor at "TC SP in" to the last competitor's check-in time at "TC SP out".

In Gap, vehicles carrying a "Auxiliary" plate or "Route Note Car" plate may only be parked in the "Stade de rugby" parking.

In Monaco, vehicles carrying a "Auxiliary" plate or "Route Note Car" plate may only be parked in the "Pêcheurs" parking.

6 – TWO-WAY RADIOS

6.1 Application procedure

The use on Monegasque and French territories of radio transmission equipment is subject to prior approval of temporary use of frequencies.
