1.2 Event presentation

Rally Italia Sadegna will be held in Sardinia for the 13th time in a row. Scheduled from 6 to 12 June, the Italian round of the FIA World Rally Championship will have the Service Park and the HQ once again based in Alghero. As in the past two years, the Service Park will be located at the tourist harbour, the "Ramblas of the Bousquets promenade" and Piazzale della Pace, while the Rally HQ will be at Lu Qualté, historical building of Alghero centre restored and reopened in 2015, inaugurated by Rally Italia Sardegna last year. Calata Sassari on the town Ramparts will host the night Parc Fermé, the starting and arrival Podium and also the collateral initiatives and shows connected to the rally.

2016 Rally Italia Sardegna will be run in the north of the island. It'll have 19 Special Stages and over 325 timed kilometres, the 25.32% of the total length of the rally. The event will start on June 6th with the opening of the Rally HQ, the reconnaissance will take place on Tuesday June 7th and 8th. The first competitive step will be the Shakedown and the SSS 1 Ittiri Arena Show, respectively on Thursday June 9th in the morning and in the afternoon. After three competitive days Rally Italia Sardegna will conclude with the traditional final Podium Ceremony on Sunday June 12th at 13:45, preceded by the Power Stage at Cala Flumini scheduled on Sunday at 12:08. Among the news of this year edition, the new location of the Shakedown (Olmedo – Monte Baranta) and two new Special Stages: Tula and Sassari – Argentiera. The SS Castelsardo and Tergu-Osilo are back in the programme of the event, while SS Monte Lerno will be once again and as usual, the most demanding stage with almost 45 timed kilometres to be repeated twice on Saturday June 11th.

1.3 Validity

Rally Guide 1, published in the month of February 2016 has no regulatory power. It is a document produced for all Teams, Competitors and Media representatives to prepare in advance the Italian round of the 2016 FIA World Rally Championship. 4.2 Criteria for the acceptance of Entries

The maximum number of entrants will be limited to 90 competitors.

Acceptance will be guaranteed as follows:

- 1. Priority 1 Drivers (P1)
- 2. Priority 2 Drivers (P2) registered in the FIA WRC2
- 3. Priority 3 Drivers (P3) registered in the FIA WRC3
- 4. Non Priority Drivers.

If more than 90 entries are received the Organizers reserve the right to decide which drivers, among the nonpriority, will be accepted according to drivers' results obtained and the characteristics of their cars. In case an entry is not accepted the Organizers will refund the entry fee reduced by any bank charges incurred during the banking process.

4.2.1 Closing date for Entries

The entry form duly filled in together with the entry fee receipt sent only by registered letter or courier must reach the Permanent Rally Office in Sardinia - **Via Stanis Dessy, 7 07041 Alghero (I)** - by **Monday 9 May 2016**. The entry form and the payment receipt may also be sent by e-mail (m.furlanetto@rallyitaliasardegna.com). In any case, the original entry form and the entry fee payment receipt have to reach the Rally Office within seven days **(Monday 16 May 2016)** after sending the e-mail.

The entry form will be accepted only if sent with the total amount of the entry fee or a receipt issued by the Competitor's Sporting Authority;

Any entry form sent without the corresponding fee will not be taken into consideration and the Organizers have no obligation to inform the concerned party.

5. Service Park

5.1 Information about the Service Park

5.1.1 Service Park

Location: Porto Turistico and Piazzale della Pace - Alghero

Inside the Service Park all entrants will have available the following spaces: WRC Manufacturers, WRC Teams, WRC2 and WRC3 entrants will have the space recommended by the FIA. All other competitors will have an area of 100 square meters.

Should an entrant require more space, he/she must contact the Organisers (a.debianchi@rallyitaliasardegna.com) no later than **Monday 23 May 2016**. The Organisers will try to satisfy the needs as much as possible. After this date requests will not be accepted.

5.1.2 Access to the Service Park

SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates necessary to enter the Service Park are included in the Entry Package, that will be given to Competitors during the Pre-reconnaissance sign on, **Monday 6 June 2016**.

During the entire duration of the Rally, only cars provided with SERVICE or AUXILIARY plates distributed by the Organizers will be allowed to enter the Service Park

Plates must be fixed inside the car, on the right side of the windscreen (co-driver side).

The Service Park will open on Saturday 4 June 2016 at 10:00 a.m. for authorized persons only.









5.1.3 Allocated Service Areas in the Service Park

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. 5.1.4 Facilities in the Service Park

The organiser will provide the following common services :

6. Two Way Radio

6.1 License Application Procedure

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to get the license it is compulsory to fill in and send the radio license application form to the organisers no later than **Monday 9 May 2016** (Application form will be available upon request from the Permanent Secretariat and on the event website). The organisers will forward all requests to the Ministry of Communications with all details about frequency range. The Ministry of Communications with all details about frequency range. The Ministry Officials will monitor the use of radio transmitters during the Rally. Unlicensed use of a radio transmitter is forbidden and may lead to prohibition of the use of the transmitter, as well as a fine and/or the confiscation of the equipment.

In order to ensure that air traffic may flow within the maximum safety conditions and according to the FIA Safety Regulations and the Italian Air Traffic Authority, all helicopters flying over the area concerning Rally Italia Sardegna during the event, must be registered at the Rally Office. Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopters zones or other sites provided during the competition.

All the needed documentation and all other information will be given out during the Pilots' Briefing that will take place at Rally HQ on **Thursday 9 June 2016**.
