#### 1.2 Event presentation

Rally Italia Sardegna will take place on the island of the Four Moors (symbol of Sardinia) for the fourteenth times in a row. The Italian Round of the 2017 FIA World Rally Championship is scheduled in the week 5-11 June and Alghero has been confirmed as base of the Service Park and of the Rally HQ, but also Olbia comes back. The town in the Gallura region, base of the first editions of the event, will host the night Parc Fermé after the traditional Super Special Stage of Ittiri, and the start of the rally on Friday morning.

The 2017 Service Park will be as usual locate along the quays of the touristic harbor, the "Ramblas of the Bousquets promenade" and Piazzale della Pace. The Rally HQ will remain Lu Qualté, historic building, completed restored and inaugurated in 2015. Calata Sassari and the ramparts will host the night Parc Fermé of each day and the Podium where the Ceremonial Start and the Arrival, followed by the Olympic Prizegiving, will be held. This location will host as well shows and collateral initiatives throughout the event.

2017 Rally Italia Sardegna from the motorsport point of view will have 19 Special Stages for 320 timed kilometers and a total distance of almost 1.500 km. The event is starting on Monday June 5th with the opening of the Sporting Secretariat, while the Reconnaissance of the route will take place on Tuesday 6th and Wednesday 7th June. The first competitive events are going to be the Shakedown and the SSS1 Ittiri Arena Show, respectively in the morning and in the afternoon on Thursday June 8th, after that competitors will move to Olbia. After three competitive days Rally Italia Sardegna will finish with the traditional party of the arrival podium on Sunday June 11th at 13:50, preceded by the well-established Power Stage Sassa-ri-Argentiera provided at 12:18. The Power Stage and also the SS Coiluna-Loelle, this last one on Saturday June 10th at 15:08, will be shown live by Fox TV and Sportitalia.

#### 1.3 Validity

Rally Guide 1, published in the month of February 2017 has no regulatory power. It is a document produced for all Teams, Competitors and Media representatives to prepare in advance the Italian round of the 2017 FIA World Rally Championship. - 3) Priority 3 Drivers (P3) registered in the FIA WRC3
  - 4) Non Priority Drivers

If more than 90 entries are received the Organizers reserve the right to decide which drivers, among the non-priority, will be accepted according to drivers' results obtained and the characteristics of their cars. In case an entry is not accepted the Organizers will refund the entry fee reduced by any bank charges incurred during the banking process.

#### 5.1 Information about the Service Park

#### 5.1.1 Service Park

Location:

Porto turistico e Piazzale della Pace - Alghero

Inside the Service Park all entrants will have available the following spaces:

WRC Manufacturers, WRC Trophy, WRC2 and WRC3 entrants will have the space recommended by the FIA.

All other competitors will have an area of 100 square meters.

Should an entrant require more space, he/she must contact the Organisers (a.debianchi@ rallyitaliasardegna.com) no later than **Monday 22 May 2017**. The Organisers will try to satisfy the requests as much as possible according to the availability. After this date no request will be accepted.

#### 5.1.2 Access to the Service Park

SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates necessary to enter the Service Park are included in the Entry Package, that will be given to Competitors during the Pre-reconnaissance sign on, **Monday 5** June 2017.

During the entire duration of the Rally, only cars provided with SERVICE or AUXILIARY plates distributed by the Organizers will be allowed to enter the Service Park

Plates must be fixed inside the car, on the right side of the windscreen (co-driver side). The Service Park will open on **Saturday 3 June 2017 at 10:00 a.m. for authorised persons only**.

#### 5.1.3 Allocated Service Areas in the Service Park

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. P1(except the ones entered by a Manufacturer), P2, P3 and non Priority drivers whishing to use a joint area with other competitors must send a request to the Organisers (n.russo@rallyitaliasardegna.com) by Wednesday 24 May 2017.

# 6. Two Way Radio

#### 6.1 License Application Procedure

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to get the license it is compulsory to fill in and send the radio license application form to the organisers no later than **Monday 8 May 2017** (Application form will be available upon request from the Permanent Secretariat and on the event website). The organisers will forward all requests to the Ministry of Communications with relevant details about frequency range. The Ministry of Communications will decide if the requested frequencies can be assigned and will issue a license. The Ministry Officials will monitor the use of radio transmitters during the Rally. Unlicensed use of a radio transmitter is forbidden and may lead to prohibition of the use of the transmitter, as well as a fine and/or the confiscation of the equipment.



## 8. Helicopters

#### 8.1 Registration procedure

In order to ensure that air traffic may flow within the maximum safety conditions and according to the FIA Safety Regulations and the Italian Air Traffic Authority, all helicopters flying over the area concerning Rally Italia Sardegna during the event, must be registered at the Rally Office. Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopters zones or other sites provided during the competition.
