1 PRESENTATION / WELCOME

1/1 A word from the President of the FFSA



Ladies and gentlemen,

Once again this year we'll be very happy to see you in March 2019 on the Island of Beauty for the 62nd running of the Tour de Corse. The heavy involvement of the Collectivité de Corse and cities alongside us means that we can confirm once again that the CORSICA linea – Tour De Corse will take its place among the major national and international motor sporting events.

The Federation has been able to take advantage of the experience acquired over the past four years to provide entrants and spectators with a route on which spectacle and suspense will be ever present. Boosted by this experience the organisation team is now ready to offer you a new staging of the event that will satisfy your passion!

In 2019, the CORSICA linea – Tour De Corse will open the ball on tarmac and it is buckling down to take up a huge challenge with several novelties. Our iconic round has benefitted from work carried out in close collaboration with the authorities and our private partners: It will start in Porto-Vecchio passing by Bastia in particular where the service park will be located before finishing in Calvi for the first time. The WRC field will be faced at almost 350 km of special stages offering the best possible conditions to works drivers and amateurs alike!

With a playing field that's especially challenging and 75% new special stages, we're hoping to attract as many entries as for the last event in which over 90 cars – the highest number of the 2018 season – started the rally.

In parallel, the FFSA has made a point of giving drivers of Historic Racing Cars a unique opportunity to race in the wake of the WRCs. On 30-31 March 2019 some 60 crews are expected to cover slightly more than 160 timed kilometres in the Tour de Corse – 10.000 Virages, an event counting for the 2019 French VHC Rally Championship.

I would like all the entrants to be able to enjoy all the marvels on the Island of Beauty. Of course, I'm thinking not only of professionals led by our six-time world rally champion, but also amateur drivers. Thanks to preferential welcoming conditions we have the privilege of offering our licence-holders the opportunity of sharing the same playing field as the world elite and racing in the traces of Sébastien Ogier. Next year he'll be back with Citroën, and he'll be determined to aim for victory on home turf with the team that gave him his chance to move up to the world rally championship.

In the name of the FFSA and its executive committee, I look forward to seeing you all on 28 – 31 March 2019 and I wish you all an excellent CORSICA linea – Tour De Corse!

1/2 CORSICA linea - Tour de Corse presentation

The 2019 Tour de Corse WRC will take place between Thursday 28th and Sunday 31st March on a route that has been remodelled by 75% with 14 special stages (9 in 2015, 12 in 2018).

The service park, which is the heart of the rally, will be installed in a specially laid-out bespoke zone at the Bastia-Poretta international airport. It is open to everybody free of charge for three days, Thursday to Saturday, and will enable visitors to immerse themselves in the world of the WRC, get near the cars and their crews and discover the various activities on offer: concerts, fun fair, special stages shown on a giant screen, exhibitors' village, restaurants etc.

After a day devoted to administrative checks and scrutineering followed by two-and-a-half days reconnoitring the route by the crews, the rally will begin on Thursday morning with the shakedown, a practice session in race conditions and the last opportunity for the crews and mechanics to make the final tweaks to the cars.

Thursday 28th March: Shakedown

Sorbo Ocagnano (5,39 km)

A few kilometres to the south of the service park the entrants will set off from the village of Querciolo on a very technical fairly wide and twisty road with excellent spectator zones. After Sorbo Ocagnano, the change of surface and the narrowness of the road will make the second part of the shakedown a much trickier challenge. The crews will then take a narrow downhill section in the woods that is often damp to reach the finish in Castellare di Casinca.

In the early evening, Porto-Vecchio will host the starting ceremony of the Tour de Corse WRC for the first time. The main crews will sign autographs and photos of the drivers. The cars will be presented on the starting ramp, while spectators can enjoy the exhibitors' village, activities, etc. The cars will spend the night in the parc fermé on the port.

Friday 29th March: leg 1

After the start in Porto-Vecchio, the Tour de Corse will spend the day in the Alta-Rocca region. The rally starts at the Fiumicelli bridge, not used for over 30 years (1989 SS Kamiesh – Maison Forestière Arza), for a special stage in one of the most beautiful sites on the island.

SS 1-4 Bavella (17.60 km)

The rally kicks off on a wide fast road, a bit like a hill climb, in a huge pine forest. The first upward section takes the crews to the Larone pass and includes the only narrow and twisty sector followed by a very quick downhill run before they tackle another uphill section leading to the finish in the Bavella pass, 1218m above sea level. Around 10 hairpins await both drivers and spectators near the village.

After crossing Zonza and undergoing a passage control in Quenza in front of the Sole e Monti auberge, one of the historic places on the rally route, the crews will go to Zerubia for a stage already run in 2015, but now shortened by 16 kilometres at the finish.

SS 2-5 Valinco (25.94 km)

Start in the Zerubia village on a smooth very narrow road in the woods before joining a wider road, which runs through the villages of Cargiacca and Loreto di Tallano in a very long twisty downhill section as far as the Acoravo bridge. This is followed by an uphill run that begins at a constant speed and then becomes quicker on a road that alternates three different surfaces until the finish at the entry to Arbellara.

The crews will follow the liaison section to the heights of Propriano for the start of the 3rd stage of the day, which will bring them to the east coast.

SS 3-6 Alta-Rocca (17.37 km)

The stage starts a few dozen metres from the Caldane bridge and a hairpin bend will bring the crews to the west. They will cross Chialza on a very narrow road from curve to curve, then the Bisene village where they will have to watch out for dampness in the woods followed by Tirolo with a series of curves on a narrow road to the finish just after the very spectacular Orone hairpin.

The crews will then rejoin Porto-Vecchio for a regrouping halt and a tyre change (carried out by the crews themselves) before the second passage through the three specials stages of the 1st leg.

After SS 6, the cars will return to Bastia-Poretta for technical service and a night in parc fermé.

Saturday 30th March: leg 2

The second day of the race begins with the only two specials carried over from 2018 starting with the very popular Cap Corse stage renamed and shortened by 10 km at the start.

SS 7-10 Cap Corse (25.62 km)

Start from Luri on a wide road so the drivers can go pedal to the metal on the very quick climb up to the spectacular crossing of the Santa-Lucia pass (381m), after which they swing towards the western side of the Cap via a technical downhill section. There's a radical change after Pino as the second half of the stage takes place on a very narrow twisty road that gives a magnificent panoramic view of les Agriates. After crossing the Barrettali and Canari villages the crews will reach the finish via a final hairpin.

They will follow a liaison section along the west coast of Cap Corse and Saint-Florent and head to Casta for the stage that is both the fastest and the shortest in the rally where the quickest cars average almost 110km/h!

SS 8-11 Désert des Agriates (14.45 km)

Start from the exit of the Casta village in the heart of Les Agriates on a fast wide road that crosses an uninhabited maquis 300m above sea level. After crossing the Vezzo pass a quick downhill section brings the cars towards Pietra Monetta. As the road is very wide the best drivers can make the most of their lines to gain a few precious seconds.

The crews will go to Ponte-Leccia for the longest emblematic stage of the Tour de Corse.

SS 9-12 Castagniccia (47.18 km)

Start at the exit from Ponte-Leccia followed by a very quick climb to the Riscamone and Serna passes before turning off onto a narrow tricky road that crosses Castello-di-Rostino and Bisinchi. The passage of the cars in front of the Campile church, easily accessible from Barchetta, will be one of the highlights of the 2019 Tour. It's followed by an uphill section via Crocicchia leading to the Saint-Antoine pass after which they continue along the mountainside to Piano on a new road, which the Tour de Corse has probably never used before. After Piano and Silvareccio, comes a change of direction to the San Agostino pass and the final uphill section in the muddy woodlands to the finish in Loreto di Casinca.

The crews will then go to the service park for a well-deserved rest.

At the start of the second loop they will stop in Bastia for a passage control before going on to tackle the three stages of the second leg.

In the late afternoon, they will rejoin the service park in Bastia-Poretta before a ceremony marking the end of the leg and spend a night in parc fermé in the heart of Bastia, place Saint-Nicolas.

Sunday 31st March: leg 3

The third and last leg will unfold in the heart of the Balagne region, which the WRC hasn't visited since 1995. The first stage of the day will run through the hinterland from Ile-Rousse to Calvi.

SS 13 Balagne (31.85 km)

Start at the Tesa auberge followed by a passage to the golf de Regino and the lac de Codole before a spectacular hairpin bend at the entry to Feliceto followed by a very quick passage through Muro and Avapessa before a radical change of direction in Cateri. The crews then climb up to the Salvi pass 510m above sea level before tackling a long, twisty technical downhill run with a spectacular view on Calvi. Unfortunately, the crews won't have time to enjoy this! The finish will take place on the plain below Montemaggiore and its five very spectacular hairpins.

Direction Calvi's commercial port for a regrouping session beside the sea.

The surviving crews will then set off for Galeria for the start of the power stage, the last stage of the rally on an iconic road.

SS 14 Calvi (19.34 km) Power Stage

Start in the Crovani bay just beside the old Argentella mine. The well-worn road traverses agricultural land first of all and then continues overhanging the sea - sometimes in a vertiginous manner - with the La Revellata peninsula in the background. The finishing line is located just after the ND de la Serra road, 3mn from the centre of Calvi.

The crews that have survived the 346 kms of special stages will then go to Calvi where the finishing ceremony is being held for the first time. After the podium the cars will line up in the parc fermé in the commercial port until the end of scrutineering checks.

Thus ends the 62nd Tour de Corse!

5/3 Service Park rules and environmental requirements

5/3/1 Environmental requirements

The impact of the CORSICA linea - Tour de Corse on the environment is one of the organizer's main priorities. The FIA awarded the Progress towards excellence certification following the 2018 event. The organizer's aim is to continue implementing actions in respect of environment and sustainable development.

An inventory of each competitor's service area will be drawn up upon his arrival in the Service Park and he will receive the rules of good conduct that each competitor must respect. The inventory will be signed by the representative of the Team and the manager in charge of the Service Park. When leaving, the team must contact the manager of the Service Park for a new inventory of fixtures in the presence of the Team representative.

We remind you that it is forbidden to ground picketing. The emptying of waste water and the washing of cars and rims outside the areas provided for that purpose are not permitted in the Service Park. Any infringement during the rally will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties.

5/3/2 Rules

Service Park Traffic

Vehicles carrying a "**Service**" plate are the only ones allowed to enter the Service Park through the **South Entrance** and they may only park within the area reserved for their competitor in the Service Park. Such vehicles may not be driven in the lanes used by competing cars during a period extending from 15 minutes before the due check-in time of the first competitor at "TC SP in" to the last competitor's check-in time at "TC SP out".

Vehicles carrying an "**Auxiliary**" plate, "**Route Note Car**" plate, "**Meteo**" plate or "**Reconnaissance**" plate may only enter the Service Park through the **North entrance** and may only be parked in the parking P6 for the entire duration of the rally.

Any vehicles or trailers found parked outside the zones in which they are permitted or which fail to respect the published timetable will be towed away immediately.

Dismantling:

For safety reasons, dismantling competitors' service structures in the Service Park is not permitted before **10:00 on Sunday, 31 March**, after the public has cleared the service park.

Any team which breaks this rule will be fined 500 €.

In case of retirement during the rally, the team concerned must firstly obtain a dismantling authorization from the Service Park Manager.

6 TWO-WAY RADIOS

12 RECONNAISSANCE

Registration and materials :

Reconnaissance will take place on Monday 25, Tuesday, 26, and Wednesday, 27 March, in accordance with the schedule specified in the Appendix 1/3.

All crews taking part in reconnaissance must complete the registration form (website) and return it to the permanent Rally Office, following the procedure specified on the form.

Only the driver and codriver entered in CORSICA linea -Tour de Corse are authorized to drive or codrive during shakedown.

Any crew arriving late at the Ceremonial Start Park will incur a cash penalty of €250.

After the Ceremonial Start, cars must be entered directly into the Parc Fermé.

The competitive element of the rally will start on Friday, 29 March from TC 0.

16 FINISH PROCEDURES

The rally ends at TC 14A (early check-in allowed).






