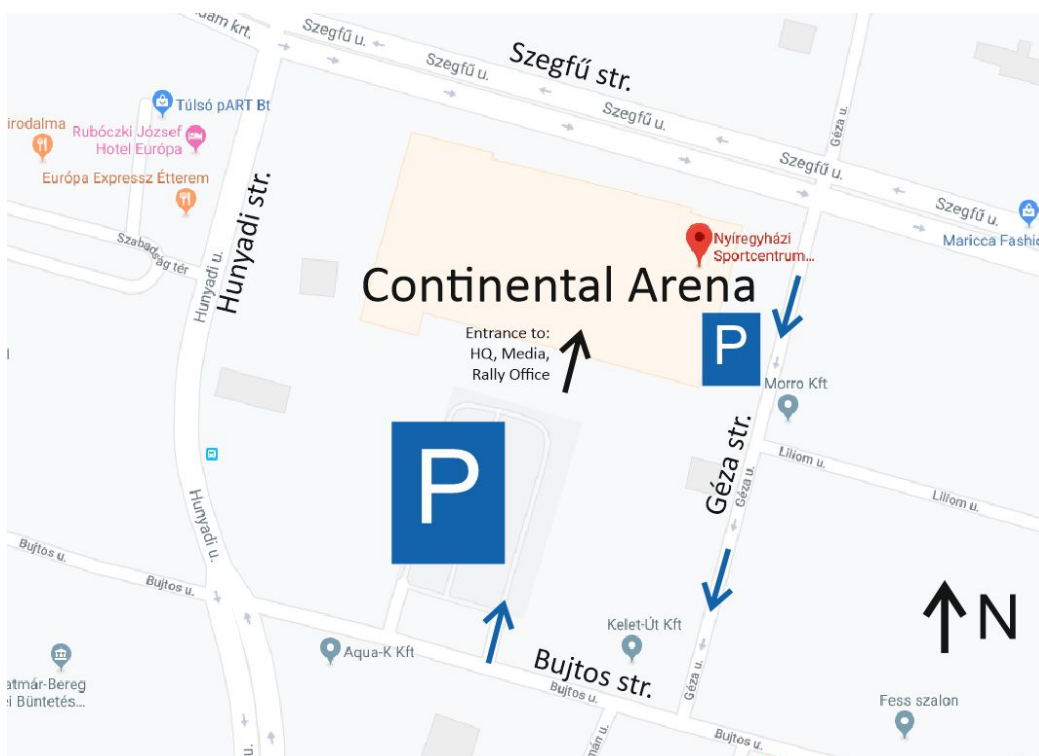

Drilling on the ground surface will NOT BE ALLOWED.



5.2. Facilities at Service Park

Plastic sheet ground protection, under competition car, during service: Mandatory for all competitors.

This groundsheet must be sufficiently strong, i.e. impermeable to oil, fuel, cooling, brake fluid, and battery acid. Any above residues liquids, dirt, and similar must be collected and be disposed of environmentally – friendly. It also must have oil-absorbing materials available.

Facilities provided:

- Electrical power: available 1x16 A (230 V); Extension cables must be provided by the teams, up to 50m from the distribution point; Sockets: the European standard

7. Fuel

Fuel must be in compliance with FIA 2019 Appendix J (Article 252.9).

Crews may refuel only in the RZ's or remote RZ's designated in the roadbook, except as detailed under **Article 50** of the FIA RRSR.

Only the use of fuel in complying with FIA Appendix J will be permitted. Solely for assisting with the refueling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew, identified with the official passes supplied by the organizers (Service) and wearing a reflective green tabard, according to Road Traffic Laws, may access this zone. In the event of a breakdown, the car concerned may be pushed out of the zone by the crew, officials and/or the two team members without incurring a penalty.



7.1. Procedures - Refueling zones (RZ)

Only actions inside an RZ directly involved in the refueling of the competing vehicle are permitted. In RZ, a 5 kph speed limit will apply. Engines must be switched off throughout the refueling operation. It is recommended that the crew stay outside the car during refueling; however, should they remain inside, their safety seat belts must be unfastened.

7.2. Personal protective equipment (PPE)

Team members assisting during refueling should wear industry homologated PPE for hydrocarbons handlings, such as safety glasses, protective rubber gloves, safety shoes, and anti-static clothing. It is highly recommended these team members wear fire-resistant clothing.

7.4. Refueling area - spill kit

All competitors and team members are responsible for running their own refueling operation and to protect the ground against spills. Therefore, it is their responsibility to protect the ground with an environmental mat which shall be composed of an absorbent upper part, and an impermeable lower part, in accordance with art. 58.2.4 - FIA RRSR



8. Tyres

At all times during the event in Hungary, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm. All tyres used during the rally must be in conformity with RRSR Art. 60 and with Appendix V. Tyres used for reconnaissance can only be road-homologated series production tyres for asphalt.

Tyre quantity for competitors:

For all drivers entered in class RC2 and RGT, a maximum of 18 tyres may be used during each rally.

For all drivers entered in class RC3, RC4 and RC5, a maximum of 14 tyres may be used during each rally, except art. 62.1.3.

TYRES FOR FREE PRACTICE / QUALIFYING, SHAKEDOWN

- For competitors eligible to take part in Qualifying, tyres will be taken from the overall quantity as per ERC regulations Art. 62.1.

- In Qualifying, only the tyres fitted on the car will count in the overall quantity. The spare wheels will not be marked.

- For competitors taking part in the Free Practice / Shakedown, used tyres will not count in the rally overall quantity.

Any breach of the tyre regulations will be submitted to the Stewards who may impose a penalty in accordance with art. 12.1 and 12.2 of the FIA International Sporting Code.

FIA-approved barcode is compulsory and must always be visible from outside the car.

Pirelli Rally racing tires could be purchased from the official Hungarian distributor who is providing fitting service for free of charge during the event for the purchased Pirelli tires in the Service Park.

9. Reconnaissance

9.1. Registration

Before the beginning of reconnaissance each crew has to announce the type, and registration plate number of its reconnaissance car. The crew receives identification for its car (starting numbers), a reconnaissance timecard (which is built in the roadbook) and monitoring GPS unit. GPS unit must be in a Recce car during the whole time while making Reconnaissance, also in liaison. The starting number must be affixed in the right upper part of the windscreen and in both rear side windows during reconnaissance at all times. Any change of the car must be announced to the organizer in time. A reconnaissance timecard and monitoring GPS unit must be returned to the organizer at the end of reconnaissance at HQ.

9.2. Reconnaissance time cards

In the roadbook a time card, valid for up to **2** (two) passages over each special stage – considered each version - will be supplied and must be carried in the car and presented at the beginning (Start) and at the end (Stop) of each SS and, if requested, to the intermediate points distributed along the itinerary.

Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the reconnaissance. Reconnaissance time cards returning – see Supplementary Regulations 3.2



9.3. Program

The reconnaissance schedule for all drivers will take place as described in **Appendix 2** of the **Supplementary Regulations**.

9.4. GPS Tracking system - reconnaissance

The reconnaissance GPS tracking system must be used all the time.

Caution Fee payment = During Reconnaissance Registration (see supplementary Regulations 3.2).

Collection and mounting of devices = (see Supplementary Regulations 3.2 and Appendix 6).

Returning = (see Supplementary Regulations 3.2 and Appendix 6).

- Crews are authorized to drive a maximum of 2 (two) passages through each special stage - **maximum speed is 50 km/h**

- on public roads **respect of the local Road Traffic Laws is mandatory.**

- In the SSS, crews are authorized to drive only one complete lap on each track. One complete lap on track 1 and one complete lap on track 2.

- Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the race route at the Special Stages:

- During reconnaissance, crews must stop at the start and at the finish (Stop) of each stage, which will be duly signposted.

- Rally Officials will endorse the reconnaissance time card in order to control the pass of vehicles over the stages.

- During each passage through a special stage, only the crew (driver and co-driver) are permitted in the car.

- The presence of a driver and/or his co-driver on a special stage, in any way whatsoever, is considered as reconnaissance, except on foot, as **per article 25.4.2 of the FIA RRSR**.

- Special Stages will be supervised by Rally Officials and crews must follow their instructions.

Speeding Fines during reconnaissance and/or shakedown and road sections

- Speed will be monitored by GPS tracking system, which has to be maintained in suitable conditions during all periods. Speeding during reconnaissance and/or shakedown liaison will incur a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows:

Per km per hour over the speed limit: € 25,00.

Other traffic infringements will incur a fine applied by the Stewards according to Art. 20.3.4 of the FIA RRSR. The amount of the fines will be unaltered by any fine imposed by the police. The fine will be doubled in case of a second offense committed.

SCRUTINEERING PREPARATION

- At scrutineering, competitors must present all items of clothing, including helmets and an FIA-approved head retaining device (FHR) intended to be used. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked. (FIA-RRSR Art. Art. 26).
- Marking and sealing of components and spares will take place on **Thursday, 07-11-19**.
- Competitors must make the necessary preparations before attending scrutineering; this includes the removal of the sump guard which must be kept with the car for weighing purposes. (FIA-RRSR Art. Art. 26 and 63).

ALL COMPETITORS ENTERING S2000, R5 AND S 1600 CARS

- All competitors entering S2000, R5 and S 1600 cars which are on the official entry list, have to present during scrutineering their FIA Technical Passport.

The valves on the R5 cars should be prepared for sealing but should not be sealed in advance, to allow the check of the pop-off valves during scrutineering.

Cars subject to final checks (by the decision of stewards) must have one representative of the entrant as well as mechanics (in case of dismantling) present at the final scrutineering. Subjected cars will be escorted from the finish podium to the place of the final scrutineering, and after it to the Parc Ferme.

12. Free practice/qualifying stage (FIA and ERC priority drivers) / SHAKEDOWN

12.1. Basic information

Only competitors, who passed the administrative checks and scrutineering, can participate in Shakedown, Free practice and Qualifying stage. Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to their cars. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal SS.

For the shakedown and Free Practice only, If there is a person, by exception, not rally participant, this person must have an approval from the Clerk of the Course and this person must together with the competitor declare and sign a disclaimer of responsibility – the form will be available at the administrative check and the shakedown start.

The crew whose car breaks down during the shakedown / Free Practice / QS shall nevertheless attend the ceremonial start according to the CoC decision.

Tyre marking zone will be located before the TC QS.

Only tyres on rally car for Qualifying stage will be marked (spare wheel will not be marked). Tyres for Free practice are not count for the overall quantity.



12.2. Stage length and service park

Stage Length = 3,9 km

Service Location: Nyíregyháza Market – Main Service Park of the Rally

Distance from service to start line = 13,5 km.



Distance to the start from the end of the stage: 3,1 km

13. Start procedure

Participation is mandatory for all Crews.

Crews must wear overalls and attend the ceremonial start with their competition cars.

On the official notice board (in given times according to SR Program) there will be published starting order for:

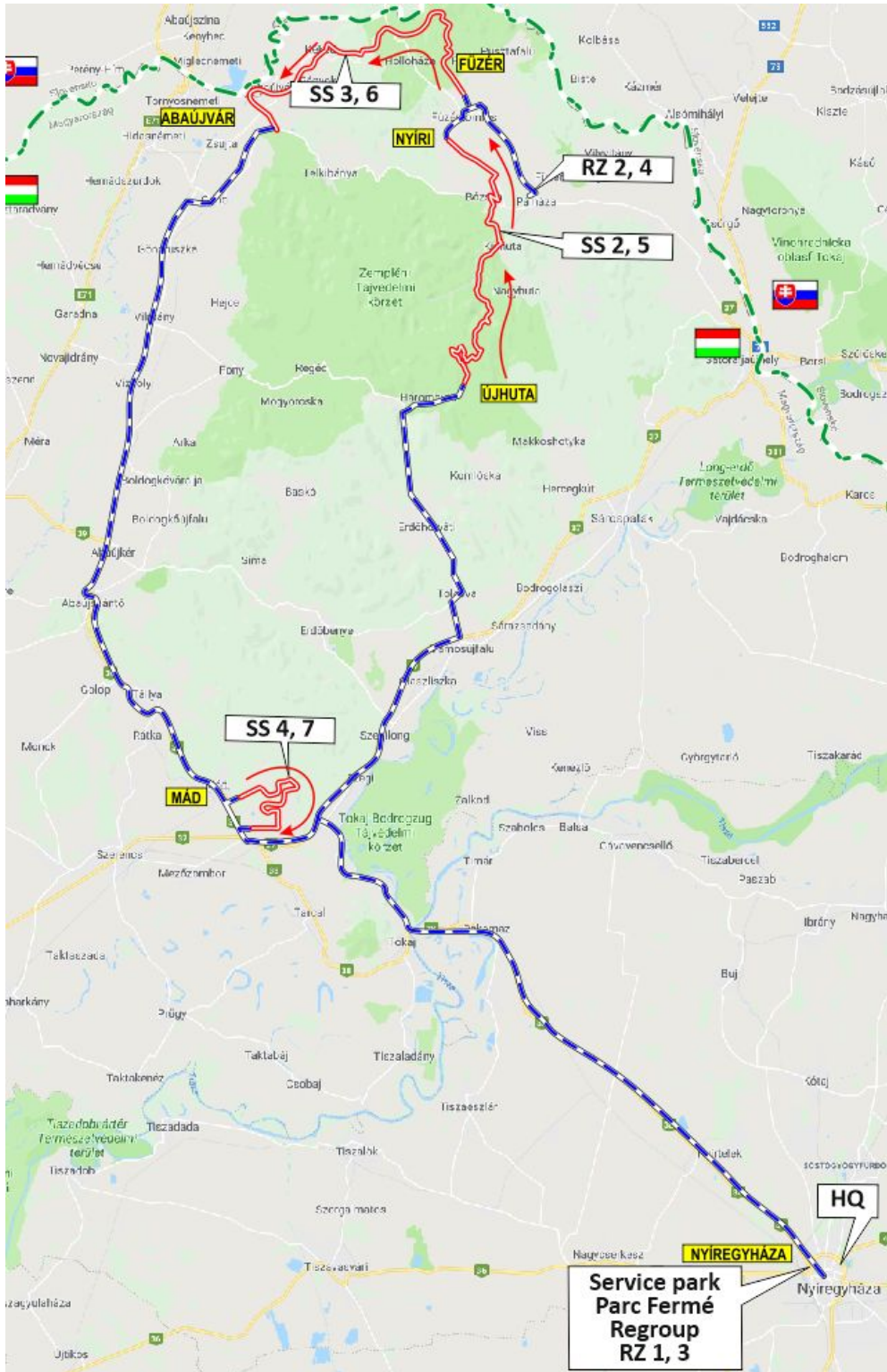

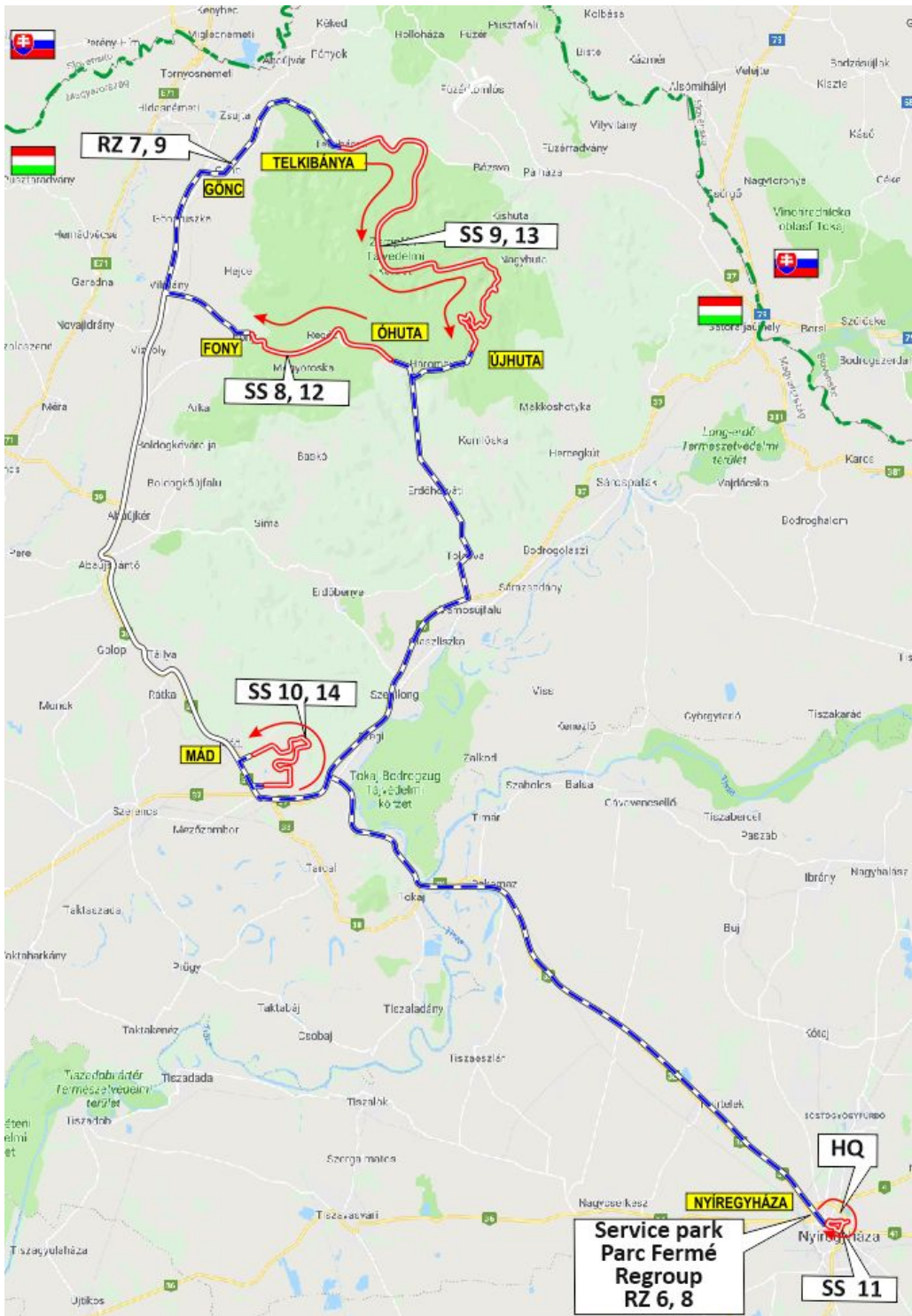

Overview map - Leg 1





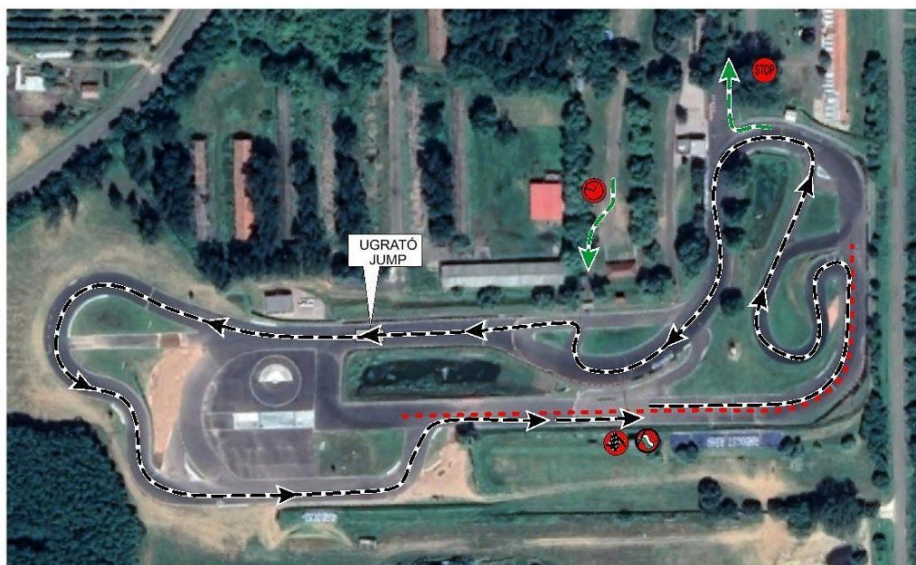
Overview map - Leg 2



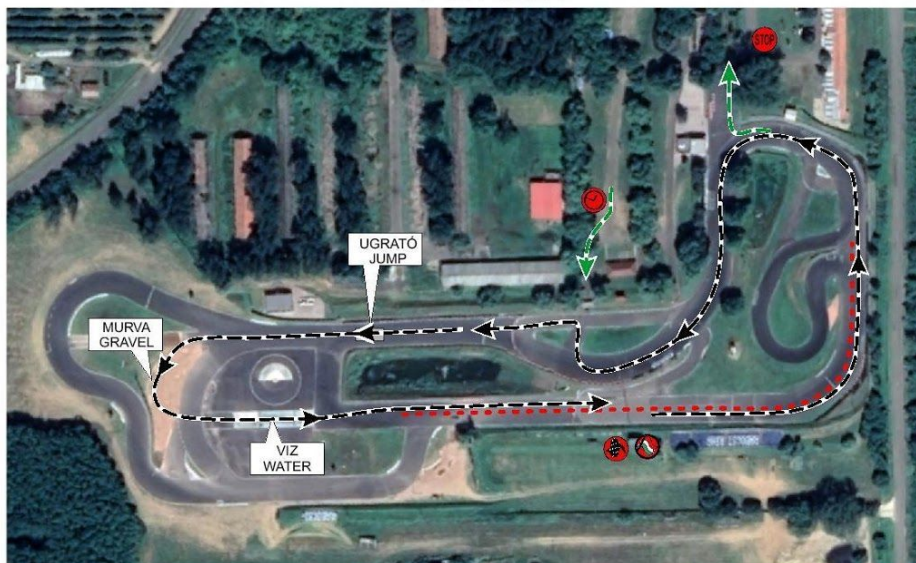

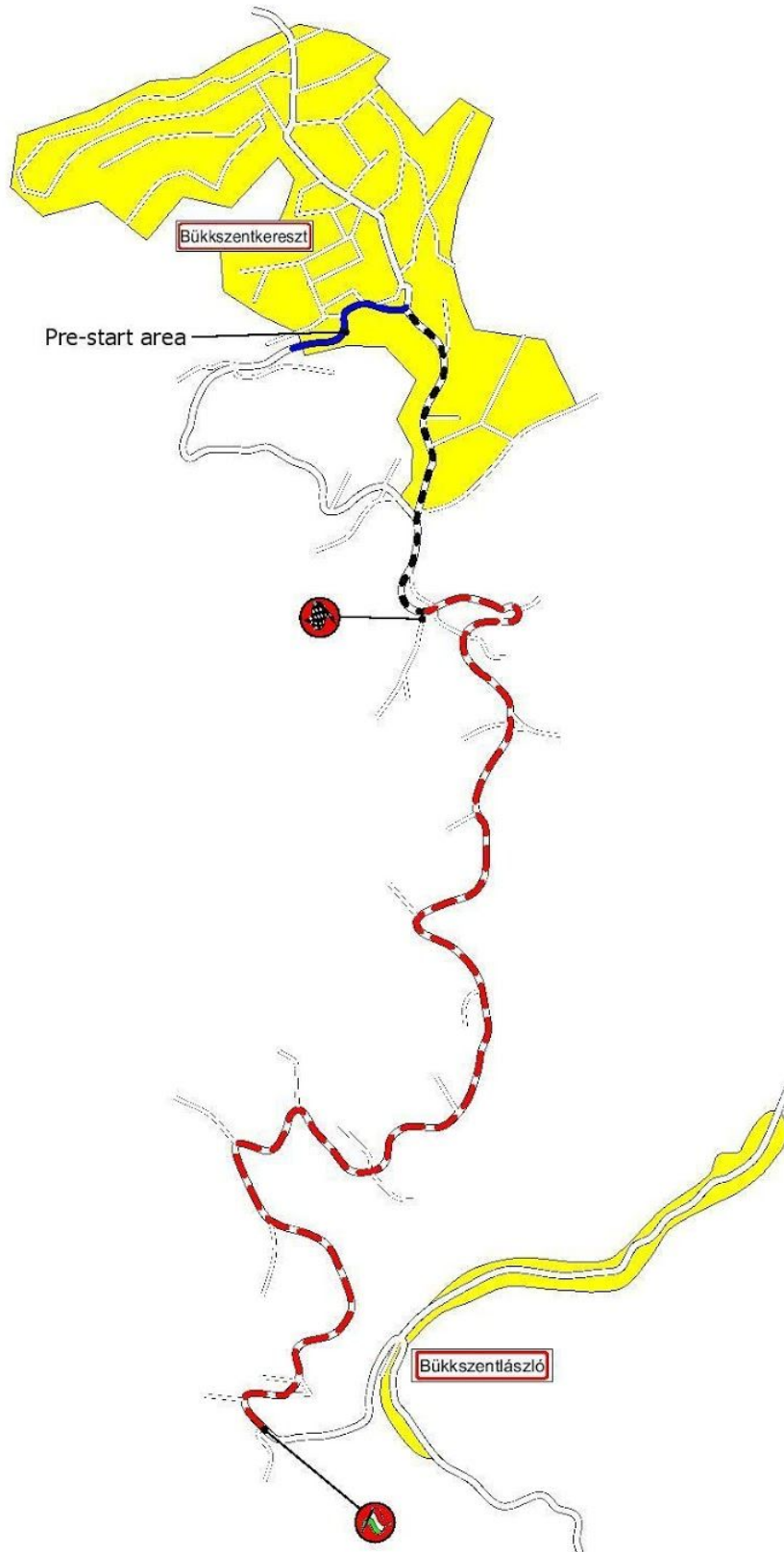


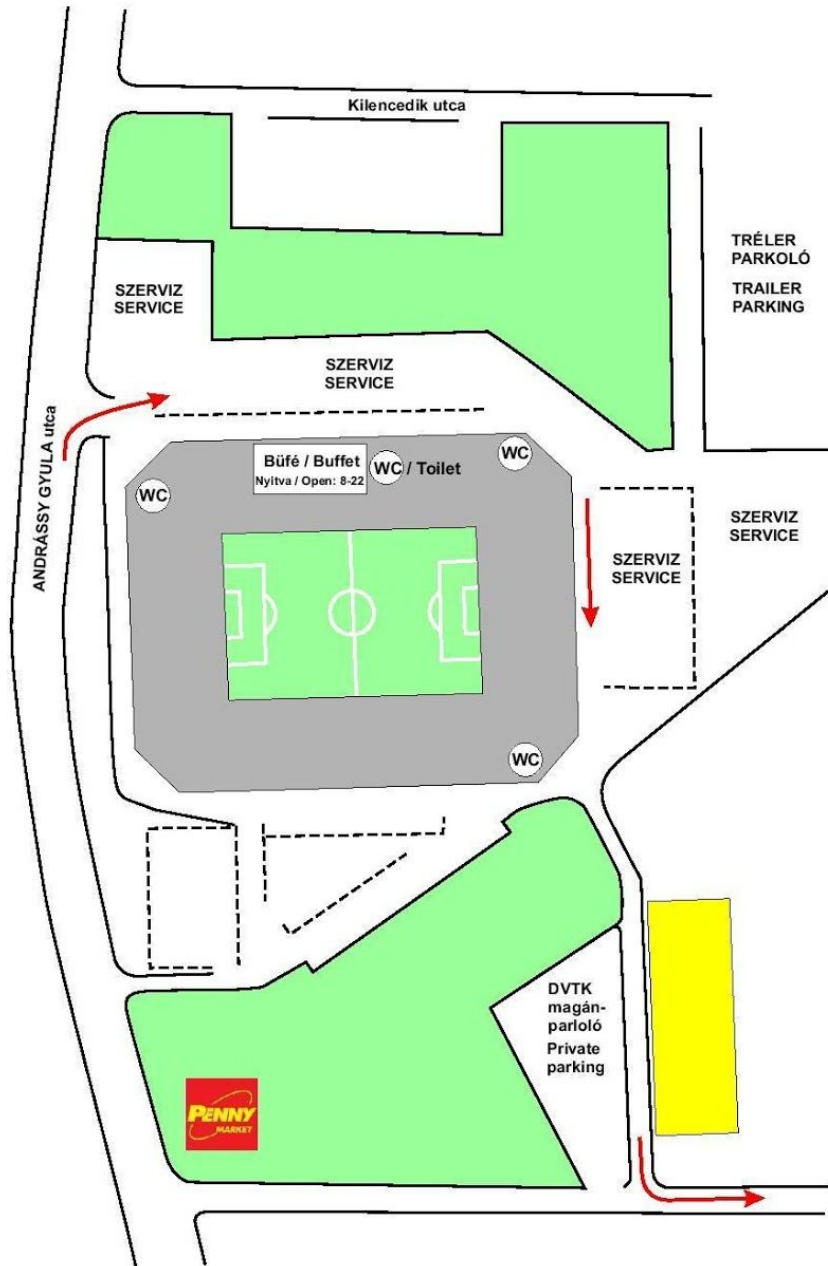


Official test routes and auxiliary Service Park



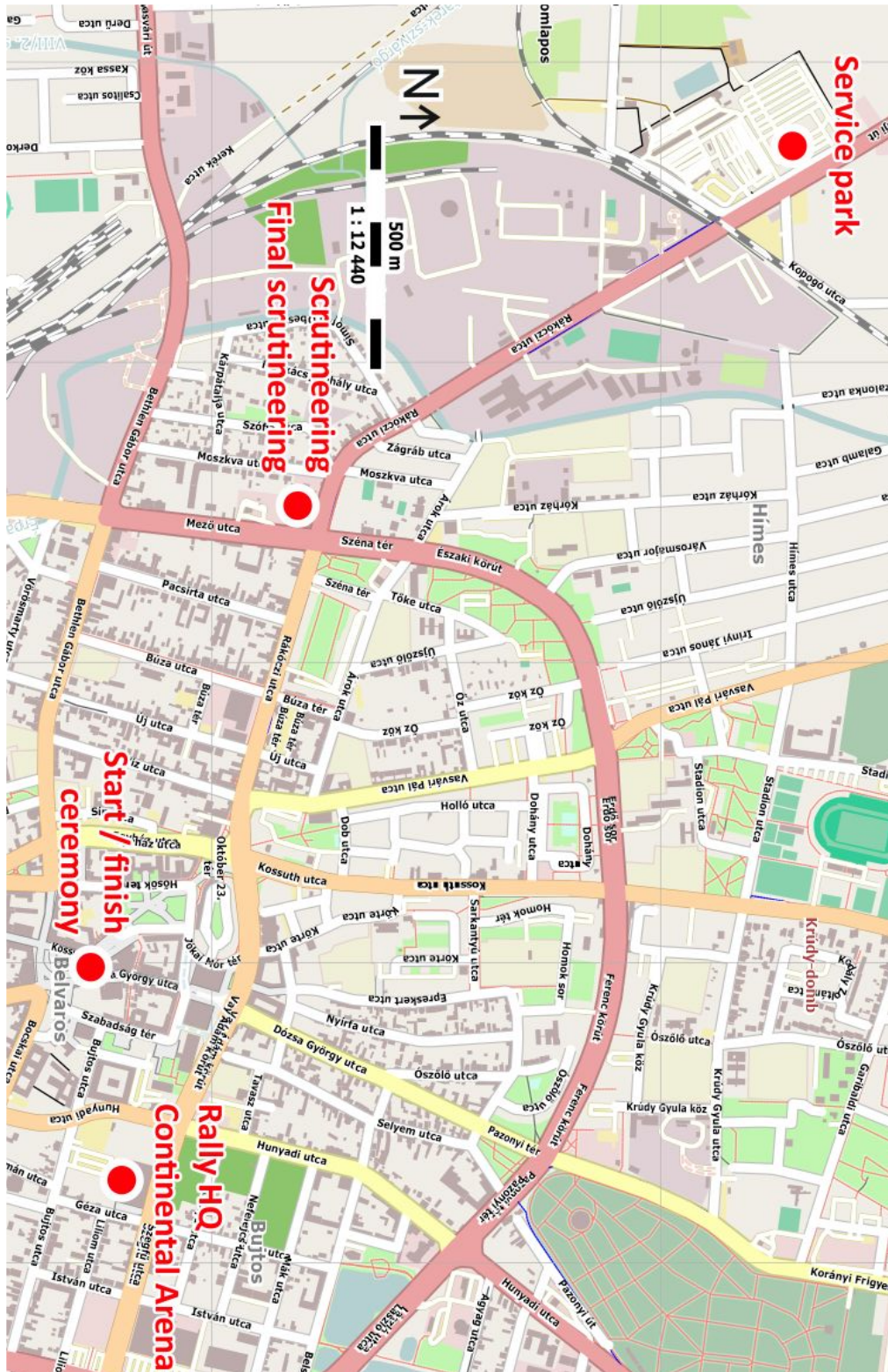
