5. SERVICE PARK

5.1 SERVICE PARK INFORMATION

5.1.1 SERVICE PARK

Location: Autodromo Nazionale Monza

NOTICE: inside Service Park it is absolutely forbidden to park trolleys, transporters and trailers outside the individual service area. For parking these vehicles competitors have at their disposal the area called P8. Thank you for your kind cooperation in using this parking area.

Requests for additional space have to be sent to Rally General Secretariat (pronti@monzanet.it) by Wednesday 25 November.

The cost for each additional square meter is: € 20,00 + VAT

5.1.2 ACCESS TO SERVICE PARK

SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates, necessary to enter Service Park, are included in the materials that competitors will receive during the pre-reconnaissance checks.

8 For the entire duration of the Rally only cars with Service and Auxiliary plates distributed by the Organizers will be allowed to enter Service Park. Plates must be fixed inside the vehicle, on the right side of the windscreen. Service Park will open for Competitors and Suppliers on Saturday 28 November at 10:00.

5.1.3 ADJOINED SERVICE AREAS

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of Service Park. P2, P3 and non priority drivers wishing to have a working area next to another competitor must inform the Organisation (ninni.russo@acirallymonza.com) by Wednesday 25 November 2020.

5.1.4 SERVICE PARK FACILITIES

The Organiser will provide the following services to all competitors:

- waste recycling (oil, paper, etc...)
- toilets and chemical toilets
- General security patrol inside the Service Park area
- electricity
- water
- car washing before entering Service Park

The Organiser is available to supply the following services at charge:

- extra security service
- additional toilets in team area
- internet connection (ADSL, VDSL)

The list of extra facilities and the related request form are available on the event website.

5.2 SERVICE PARK FACILITIES AT CHARGE

All orders for at charge facilities have to be sent by Wednesday 25 November to the Rally Secretariat (pronti@monzanet.it) filling in the attached form.

5.3 MEDICAL CARE

A First Aid point will be available inside Service Park.

5.4 CAR WASHING

Competitors are NOT allowed to wash cars inside their service areas. The organiser will provide a car washing in an area located inside the circuit, that will be indicated in the final layout.

Competitors are NOT allowed to wash spare parts inside their area in Service Park. The organiser will prepare a dedicated area for washing inside Service Park that will be indicated in the final layout of the SP.

6. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

6.1 LICENSE

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. In order to obtain the license it is necessary to fill in the request form and submit it to the Organizer, no later than Friday 20 November 2020 (the form will be available from the Secretariat and to be downloaded from the website). The Organizer will submit all requests, with frequency details, to the Italian Ministry of Communication. The Ministry will decide whether the required frequencies can be assigned and will release a license. The Ministry Officials will monitor the use of radio transmitters during the event. It is forbidden to use radio frequencies without license, such a use may lead to the prohibition of using the transmitter, as well as a fine and the confiscation of the radio equipment.

7. HELICOPTERS

7.1 REGISTRATION

In order to ensure air traffic to develop in the best safety conditions and in compliance with FIA Safety Regulations and the Italian Air Traffic Authority, all helicopters wishing to fly over the area of ACI Rally Monza during the event must be registered at the Rally Organisation. Only duly registered helicopters will be allowed to fly over the Rally area and land in the helicopter areas or other sites within the competition zone.

7.2 REGISTRATION FORM AND PROCEDURES

Application form must be sent to the Rally Secretariat (pronti@monzanet.it) by Wednesday 25 November 2020.

The documents proving registration and all other information will be delivered to the pilots after the briefing to be held by videoconference on Thursday 3 December 2020

7.3 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

7.4 BRIEFING

Attendance to the pilots briefing by videoconference on Thursday 3 December at 18:00 is compulsory for all pilots. Failing to attend the briefing will imply the cancellation from the registered helicopters list and consequently the prohibition to over-fly the rally area. After the briefing all pilots will have to reach the Secretariat in order to collect three stickers with identification numbers that must be placed on the bottom and on both sides of the helicopter for the entire duration of the event.

1. Media play an important role in the FIA World Rally Championship and members of Media must be permitted to carry out their work in the best conditions. However, Media must respect safety rules. When possible safety requirements will not interfere with the work of the Media.
2. Media are divided into two groups:
 - a) MEDIA
 - b) MEDIA TABARD
3. Each group is identified as follows:
 - a) MEDIA- Media car plates, named and numbered, issued by the Accreditation Centre.
 - b) MEDIA TABARD - Media car plates, named and numbered, issued by the Accreditation Centre, plus numbered tabards issued by FIA.
4. Only media representatives wearing FIA WRC tabards and having a MEDIA TABARD car plate will be allowed to enter the re-served areas along the SS, where spectators will not be admitted. These areas are marked in the event Media Safety Book as designated media tabard zones. All other members of Media must remain in the spectators areas along the stages

12.12 TRAFFIC RULES IN ITALY:

- Speed limit in town: 50Km/h;
- Speed limit suburban roads: 90 Km/h;
- Speed limits are usually signposted;
- It is forbidden to drive with an alcoholic rate higher than 0.5 g/l;
- It is compulsory to wear seat belt at all times (front and back seats);
- It is compulsory to carry all documents of the driver and of the vehicle (driving license, insurance and registration document);
- It is compulsory for all vehicles to keep always lights on at all times on suburban roads;
- Motorcycles must keep lights on at all times;
- Motorcycles drivers and passengers must always wear homologated helmets.

Gas stations:

Gas stations are open every day from 07:30 until 12:30 and from 15:00 until 19:30, except on Sundays and holiday. On Sundays just a few gas stations are open. Some gas stations have self service facilities working with bills of 5,00 €, 10,00€, 20,00 € and 50€.

Inside the circuit and during its opening times a ENI gas station is available. It has 98 and 100 octanes fuel and diesel. It works self-service only and both cash and credit card payment are accepted.

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13. RIFIUTI

This year the waste collection of household and special waste will be carried out according to precise rules that each competitor must follow as per art. 12.16 of the Supplementary Regulation.

MUNICIPAL WASTE

The Organizers will give each competitor a set composed of 4 bins and several bags to be put inside each bin. The bins will have different colours depending on the waste they are supposed to contain as per the table here below:

WASTE	COLOR OF THE BIN
Mixed municipal waste	Green
Biodegradable kitchen and canteen waste	Brown
Plastic and aluminium	Yellow
Paper	White
Glass	Green 1000 lt. bin placed in the middle of Service Area

Furthermore each competitor will receive a set of two different kinds of bags:

- 1) Bags for biodegradable kitchen and canteen waste
- 2) Transparent biodegradable bags for the other waste categories.

All competitors must carry out the waste disposal following the table above described with the four different categories. The Organizers will provide the waste collection from the different stands twice or three times a day depending on the necessity.

Here below the explanation in detail of what can be put in each bin:

MIXED MUNICIPAL WASTE , NOT RECYCLABLE - green bin

- Not usable clothes;
- tampons, cotton swabs, cotton used, face or body cream, disposable blades,
- dental floss, rubber and latex gloves, chewing gums and rubbers;
- glazed paper, sliced ham/salami or cheese paper, greasy paper, dirty paper of glue or other chemicals, charcoal and wax paper, photo paper, greasy pizza boxes;
- greasy sponges and rags;
- rubber bands, sticker labels, tape;
- Smoke products, ashes, lighters, jewellery, buttons, bags, candles, mirrors, leather belts and leather in general, shoe laces, gaskets, glasses, crystal objects, (of small or very small size, without electric and electronic parts and anyway not usable);
- compact Disc (CD), Digital Versatile Disc (DVD), Blu Ray Disc (BRD), Video Home System (VHS);
- every other item not provided in the other categories.

BIODEGRADABLE KITCHEN AND CANTEEN WASTE AND BIOCOMPOSTABLE - brown bin

- raw or cooked leftovers, including spoiled (meat, eggs, small bones, bread, etc.);
- eggs, nuts, seafood and crustaceans shells;
- fish and fish bones;
- vegetables, fruits and fruit skins; c
- coffee and filters of tea;
- white napkins, tissues and absorbing paper;
- matches and toothpicks;

PLASTIC AND CANS - yellow bins

- empty and well-rinsed containers for turpentine, acetone, alcohol, bleach, ammonia and detergent;
- cosmetic containers and toothpaste tubes, mayonnaise and creams (empty),

- personal deodorants (spray and stick);
- polystyrene packaging and fruit and vegetable net;
- Aluminium containers and cans containing no toxic products (lacquers, etc.);
- plastic, steel or small containers, vessels or tanks (small for home use);
- Tin cans, cans and cans for oils, soft drinks and food preservatives;
- bottles, containers, phials, and cleaning products in general;
- Dishes, glasses and cutlery are used and disposed of without food residue;
- coat racks and hangers;
- empty blister, Screw and crown caps, metal and plastic lids;
- bags, shopper, envelopes and bags or food pans (pasta, salad, etc.)
- foil paper and aluminium foil (clean);
- plastic boxes, plastic films (pluriball) for food, cellophane and plastic film;
- nylon made of plastic and metal packaging for packing, plastic trays and plastic or polystyrene jars for foodstuffs empty;

PAPER AND CARDBOARD - white bin

- paper, cardboard, cardboard, trays and sheets or paper or cardboard bags;
- boxes and cardboard (empty boxes of pasta, food pans, eggs, etc.);
- Pizza boxes (if not too dirty);
- Shoppers and tablecloths in paper (if not too dirty);
- Books, newspapers, magazines, photocopies, notebooks;
- Cardboard and paperboard packaging (small size);
- containers in TetraPak, pure-Pak for beverages, milk juices, fruit juice, wine, cooking cream, etc.;

GLASS (EMPTY CONTAINERS) - green bin

- perfumes;
- jars;
- bottles;
- phials
- containers

SPECIAL WASTE

Regarding special waste, an ecological area has been set up within the Service Park (see annex to RG2 - layout of the Service Park) in which the following special waste can be disposed of:

- Car batteries
- Exhausted oils
- Lamps
- Engine oil
- Other emulsions
- Oil filters
- absorbents, filter materials (including oil filters not otherwise specified), wiping cloths, protective clothing contaminated by hazardous substances.

Used tyres must be disposed of by the suppliers, in case this is not possible they must be deposited in a special area of the ecological area. Competitors who will need to dispose of special waste above listed are obliged to notify the responsible person, Edoardo Mancuso +39 347 4325644. A person of the staff will then take the applicant to the ecological area, located inside Service Park, where they can dispose of the special waste depositing it in the dedicated container.

WASTEWATER

DISCHARGES OF DOMESTIC WASTEWATER

1) It is forbidden to discharge domestic waste water from toilets, kitchens or washbasins to the ground in general. The same must be collected in special wells indicated by the service area control staff.

WASHING OF THE CAR OR PARTS OF IT

1) It is forbidden to wash cars or part of it inside the stands.

2) A car wash area is provided inside the Old Garages zone, as indicated in the general map.

3) Spare parts and other parts of the cars (e.g. rims, etc.) can be washed in the appropriate area (see annex to RG 2-layout of the Service Park) in which wastewater tanks have been prepared.
