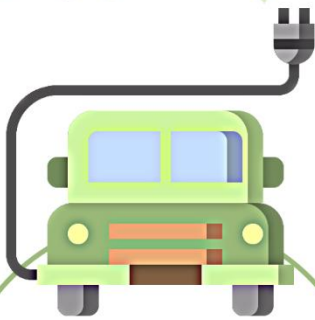

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1. INTRODUCTION

Dear Competitors,

We are back for the 89th edition of the Rallye Monte-Carlo, from the 18th to 24th January 2021. I sincerely hope that the World Rally Championship takes place in full and as planned, allowing us to celebrate the 110th anniversary of the Rallye Monte-Carlo. On this notable occasion we have taken the opportunity to increase the number of competitors by allowing up to 90 to participate.

At the time of publication, the global health crisis is not yet over and medical protocols are still in force at all FIA World Championships, Trophies, Cups, and Challenges. The health and safety of all, Organisers as well as Competitors is paramount and as such, we will adapt and apply protocols as and when necessary and in the same manner that is currently being undertaken in other motorsport events worldwide.

This next edition of the Rally will begin from Gap on Thursday, 21st January at 6.10pm directly from the Service Park, eliminating the need for competitors to travel between Monaco and Gap on the same day.

The "Shakedown" will take place that same morning from 9.01am and remains on Route de la Garde, 5km from the Service Park.

Two SS will take place at night and will cross the Massif de Dévoluy, Valgaudemar, and Champsaur totalling approximately forty kilometres before the arrival of the first car is anticipated to return to the Park at 9.01pm.

The following day, Friday 22nd January, the Rally moves to the Drôme Department in which we will conduct three SS totalling approximately 65 km which includes the notorious ascent of Col du Perty from Montauban-sur-l'Ouvèze, a classic stage from the Rallye Monte-Carlo. Competitors will return to the Gap Park from 12.57pm onwards before completing the same SS for a second time that same afternoon.

On Saturday, 23rd January, four SS are scheduled totalling more than 80 km with "Saint-Clément – Freissinières" featuring twice and "Saint-Apollinaire – Embrun" once before the competitors will convene again at the Service Park for the last time during the event.

Competitors will leave the Gap Park from 5.16pm in the direction of the Principality and will complete the fourth SS between La Bréole and Selonnet before heading to Digne-les-Bains and Monaco where they are expected to arrive from 10.09pm onwards.

Sunday, 24th January, after leaving the Park from 6.59am, crews will head to the Tyre Fitting Zone located on Quai Albert 1^{er} and will complete four SS in the Nice hinterland i.e. two SS twice with the last one being the Power Stage (1st car at 12.18pm). Competitors will navigate the Col de Turini twice from Peïra Cava to reach Moulinet and the Col de Braus twice from Col Saint-Jean finishing at Col de l'Orme.

The return to Monaco is expected from 1.43pm and the Prize Giving Ceremony will once again take place on Quai Albert 1^{er} from 3.00pm.



As always, considering the large number of people involved I hope that our Rally will take place in a harmonious manner. I also take this opportunity to remind everyone, competitors and spectators alike, that our event has received the FIA "3 stars" awarded for the quality of its organisation and its environmental management. This accolade marks the Automobile Club de Monaco's commitment to waste management, limiting the use of paper, protecting natural spaces and setting up areas reserved for the public on specific sites.

4.2 Entry procedure

Any RGT and non-priority drivers wishing to take part in the "89th Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2021" must complete the electronic entry form available on the ACM website and pay online **before Friday, 18th December 2020 - 24h00.**

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship, as well as the WRC 2 and WRC 3 Competitors must use the standard FIA entry form available on the FIA website.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2021 FIA WRC SR Art. 22.5. Competitors will sign the entry form at the Administrative Checks.

If a competitor cannot make the entry on the internet, he must contact the rally secretariat before close of entries for further instructions.

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of entrants is 90, divided in 5 priority groups: priority 1 (P1), priority 2 (P2), priority 3 (P3), RGT and non-priority (NP).

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority drivers entered in the name of the driver (driver = competitor).

18.2 Accreditation procedure

18.2.1 Principles

1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 89th Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or Radio tabards are not issued for websites.

2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....



5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website www.fia.com

18.2.2 Procedures

1. Foreign Media must submit their request to the FIA before **Thursday, 31th December 2020**. The international accreditation form is available on the FIA website:

2. Monegasque Media must send their request on the ACM official website www.acm.mc before **Thursday 24th December 2020**.
3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2020).
4. The request must include:
 - The accreditation form completed;
 - An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
 - A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
 - Copies of the published articles covering the 2020 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Monte-Carlo;
 - A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Monte-Carlo 2021;
 - Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Monte-Carlo 2021, with details on release dates or broadcast.
5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.

21. COVID-19

From the 1st September 2020, the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix S protocols have been applied to all FIA Championships, Cups, Trophies, Challenges, Series, and International Series registered on the FIA international sporting calendar. This coincides with the resumption of a number of FIA-regulated events.

The extension includes the same key sanitary measures as the Formula One protocol: mandatory physical distancing, PCR pre-testing, wearing of face masks and hand hygiene, with adapted implementation to a smaller organisational structure. 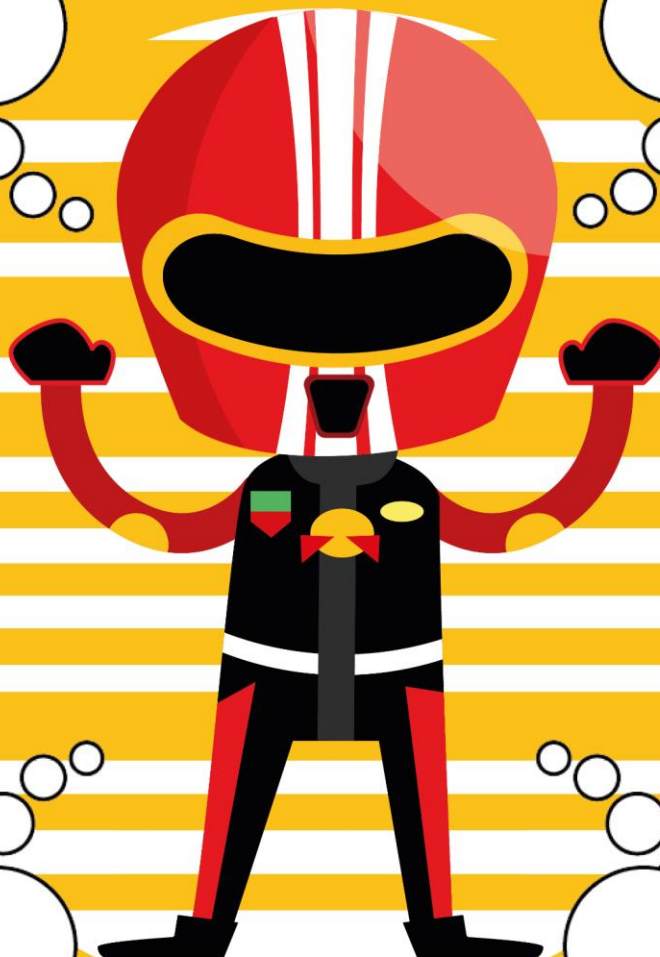
