I. INTRODUCTION / WELCOME

I.I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

Rally Poland is organized by Polish Automobile and Motorcycle Federation (PZM) in cooperation with Polish Automobile Club. Rally Poland is the second oldest rally in the world and the most prestigious motorsport event in Poland. As many as 76 editions of Rally Poland were held since I921. In 2021 Rally Poland marks IOOth anniversary of this event with opening ceremony in Mikolajki and champagne spraying at the finish in Warsaw.

We have prepared I4 special stages. I3 out of I4 speed tests are gravel stages. After covering I2 special stages in Masurian Lakes District and one around city of Przasnysz, ORLEN 77th Rally Poland competitors will tackle famous stage at Karowa street in the heart of Warsaw, which uses only paved roads – tarmac and cobblestone-covered. Final stage of 2021 ERC-opener has been proudly named Rally Poland IOOth Anniversary to celebrate a hundred years of event's history.

The Rally HQ will be placed in a popular tourist resort Hotel Gołębiewski in Mikolajki. Service Park will be located on a hard-leveled ground in the vicinity of Hotel Gołębiewski situated in very heart of the Land of Great Lakes, surrounded by wonderful tourist trials.

I.2. HISTORY

The first edition of Polish classic was held in 1921. All competitors tackled the loop from Warsaw through Bialowieza and back to Warsaw. Tadeusz Heyne (Dodge) was the fastest among the six drivers and went down to the history of the event. In the twenties and thirties of the XX century there were twelve editions of the event. Rally Poland was stopped by the II World War and returned in 1947. Since 1960 the history of Rally Poland as a round of the FIA European Rally Championship has begun and such famous names like Rauno Aaltonen, Tony Fall, Timo Makinen, Jean-Claude Andruet, Walter Rohrl, Bernard Darniche, Antonio Zanini or Sobieslaw Zasada can find on the entry and the winners lists. In 1973, right after the launch of the FIA World Rally Championship, the event was once adopted for the series and won by Achim Warmbold co-driven by Jean Todt. Rally Poland was organized on tarmac stages in various parts of the country: in Cracow, Wroclaw and Klodzko. Since 2005 the headquarters of the event is located in Mikolajki, north-east part of Poland. Spectacular gravel roads winding along Mazurian forests and lakes substituted the tarmac stages.

In 2014, for the first time in history, Rally Poland was organized not only in Poland. Four special stages were scheduled to take place in neighbouring Lithuania. Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia racked up their fifth victory of the season when they won 7Ist Rally Poland on its return to the series for the first time since 2009. The French duo has diced for honours throughout the event with Polo R WRC teammates Andreas Mikkelsen and Ola Floene. Behind Mikkelsen, Thierry Neuville and Nicolas Gilsoul picked up the final podium position, their second of the season with the Hyundai i20 WRC.

In 2015 Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia claimed their triumph in 72nd Rally Poland holding off Polo R WRC team-mates Andreas Mikkelsen and Ola Floene after a thrilling battle to the finish of the rally. A stunning performance from the Ford Fiesta RS WRC crew of Ott Tanak and Raigo Molder rewarded them with their first podium of the season. Tanak has driven the rally of his life, winning a number of stages as well as leading on Friday. Going into the final Power Stage he and Latvala were neck and neck but second fastest time, coupled with an off for Latvala, secured the Estonian the second podium position of his WRC career and Molder's first-ever WRC podium. While Latvala managed to reach the

end of the stage, a damaged radiator halted his progress on the road section back to service and ultimately the Finn incurred penalties for lateness, dropping him to fifth. Hayden Paddon therefore climbed to an unexpected fourth in the lead Hyundai i2O WRC and team-mate Thierry Neuville finished sixth behind Latvala. The Belgian was also lucky to reach the finish, having rolled in the first stage. Kris Meeke climbed to seventh, benefitting when Robert Kubica was slowed with a diff and handbrake problem in the opening stage and then a puncture in the Power Stage.

In 2016 Andreas Mikkelsen snatched victory in one of the most dramatic finishes to a round of the FIA World Rally Championship, when he and fellow Norwegian Anders Jaeger won PZM 73rd Rally Poland on Sunday. The Volkswagen Polo R WRC driver confirmed his second ever WRC win and a first for codriver Jaeger with the fifth quickest time on the final Power Stage. But the damage had been done on the previous special when long-time leader Ott Tänak of the DMACK World Rally Team sustained a puncture, lost over 40 seconds and slipped to second overall. The flat tyre deprived the heartbroken Estonian of a maiden WRC win and Ford and M-Sport of taking their first victory on a round of the championship since the 2012 Wales Rally GB. Hyundai's Hayden Paddon stayed out of trouble over Sunday's four treacherous stages to seal the final place on the podium for the Korean manufacturer. Belgian Thierry Neuville was a mere 0.8 seconds behind in fourth in a second i20 WRC. Jari-Mati Latvala held off a fierce charge from World Champion and team-mate Sébastien Ogier to confirm fourth place, although the treacherous final morning's road conditions surprised even Ogier who missed out on a podium finish for the first time this year.

WRC 2 category developed into a three-horse race over the closing four stages between the Finnish duo of Esapekka Lappi and Teemu Suninen and Welshman Elfyn Evans. The latter managed to slither into second with the quickest time on the muddy opening stage, but Lappi maintained his composure until a flat tyre destroyed his dream of taking a second successive Polish WRC 2 win in SS2O and gifted the victory to Suninen. Evans also took advantage of Lappi's misfortune to move back into second.

In 2017 Thierry Neuville and Nicolas Gilsoul racked up their victory in Poland after a neck and neck fight which ultimately forced Ott Tänak into an unlucky mistake as he pushed to the maximum for the win. The Estonian powered into the lead in a final day opener but then hit a tree in the following stage. While he was able to complete the stage, he was then forced out with too much damage; the second consecutive year he has been so close to claiming the winner's trophy in Poland. As such, Hayden Paddon and Sebastian Marshall moved up to second to give Hyundai a one-two, with Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia claiming the final podium position for M-Sport. Ogier was hanging back for a push and maximum points in the Power Stage but he ended up in a field in the penultimate stage when the car snapped out at the rear. Four points in the Power Stage were a welcome addition to his tally however. Behind the leading trio, Dani Sordo had a near miss with a tree final day morning and then a puncture this afternoon, but fourth for the Spaniard alongside Huundai's one-two was a great result for the team. Stéphane Lefebvre had a tricky morning, off the road in the first stage and then he clipped a fence in the second, distracted by a tool kit that worked loose and ended up under the brake pedal. Nevertheless he managed to move into fifth in the Power Stage, benefitting when Teemu Suninen had a near off. While a fine result for the Finn in his first outing in a 2017 World Rally Car, he was disappointed to have made a mistake in the final stage of the rally. Mads Rstberg claimed seventh and Elfyn Evans eighth.Ole Christian Veiby won the FIA WRC 2 Championship, the Norwegian claiming his first victory in the category after leading for all but the first stage. He beat Pontus Tidemand by 32.9 seconds and moves into second in the Championship. Nil Solans took his third consecutive victory in the FIA Junior WRC Championship.

In 2018 Rally Poland returned back to European Rally Championship and Nikolay Gryazin has secured his victory on PZM Rally Poland, surviving a late charge from Hyundai development driver Jari Huttunen.



Running on worn tyres, ERC Junior Under 28 star Gryazin lost time throughout a final day afternoon but still managed to beat Huttunen, who threw caution to the win on the rally's final stage, Baranowo. Huttunen brought his battle-scarred Hyundai i2O home with a rear puncture, broken bumper and spoiler in a last-ditch attempt to overhaul Gryazin for overall victory. Despite winning Baranowo by 4.6s, it was not enough for Huttunen, Gryazin hanging on for victory by only 8.3s. Huttunen had incurred a IO second penalty for checking in one minute late to SSI4, which transpired to be pivotal in settling the lead battle. Toksport WRT's Chris Ingram completes the overall podium and secured second in ERC Junior U28, holding off ŠKODA AUTO Deutschland driver Fabian Kreim. Fellow ŠKODA driver Miko Marczyk finished fifth, ensuring four of the top five positions were occupied by young stars in R5 cars.

In 2019 Alexey Lukyanuk after taking his first win on PZM 76th Rally Poland and scoring maximum points, was back in the hunt for his second FIA European Rally Championship title. Taking the lead from Hyundai Motorsport N's ERC3 Junior graduate Jari Huttunen first thing on Saturday morning after stage two. Lukyanuk didn't look back, winning by 59.8 s. After a broken damper and puncture on Saturday only caused a minor delay, another puncture occurred when Lukyanuk hit a rock on the morning pass of Gmina Mragowo. His lead was reduced but he still remained out front and from there he was untouchable, winning the remaining stages to cement his first win of 2019 and his ninth in the ERC. Huttunen's return to the European championship was equally as successful as his appearance on this event last year, repeating his second place finish with a factory-supported Hyundai i20 R5. Championship leader Łukasz Habaj added another podium to his impressive 2019 trophy cabinet, limiting his points loss to Lukyanuk to ensure he would leave his home country still top of the ERC standings.

In 2020 Polish Automobile and Motorcycle Federation (PZM) has decided to postpone 77th Rally Poland to the 2021 season. The decision was the result of a pandemic situation caused by coronavirus in Poland and Europe. The situation related to COVID-19, including restrictions on cross-border traffic and the unpredictable deadline for their total removal did not allow the time to implement the arrangements required to conduct the round of the European and Polish Championships. Bearing in mind the safety of competitors, spectators, media representatives and people involved in the organization of this great international event, it was decided to postpone it to next year.

I.3. ROUTE

The route of Rally Poland 77th edition has 870 kilometres in total, with I4 special stages covering as many as 202 kilometres. I3 out of I4 ORLEN 77th Rally Poland speed tests are flowing and spectacular gravel stages. Three of them use a new route (SS 2/5 Świętajno, SS 4/7 Wieliczki, SS I3 Przasnysz), even though its names were used in previous editions of ORLEN Rally Poland. Mikolajki Arena (SS I/8), Mikolajki Max (SS 9/II) are the same as in 2019 when last edition of Polish ERC counter was held. The route both of SS Gmina Mragowo (IO/I2) and SS Olecko (number 3/6) is pretty similar to the version from 2019 season. The latter one includes the mind-blowing Rosochackie jump, famous among rallying fans.

Qualifying stage Talty will kick-off the high-speed gravel competition on Friday (18th of June) afternoon. After settling the running order for top I5 crews, the opening stage will be held at Mikolajki Arena track. 7 stages with total length of I33,I kms are scheduled for Saturday (19th of June). Sunday morning begins with loop of 4 stages around Mikolajki, followed by road section to Warsaw, with a brand new special stage nearby Przasnysz. Final test, Rally Poland IOOth Anniversary stage will be run in the heart of Warsaw. Its route covers one of the most famous places in Polish rallying – the Karowa street. Every December, this cobblestone-paved street host traditional season-ending super special stage of Barborka



Rally – Polish Race of Champions. The finish of **SSI4** is located in the centre of Warsaw, nearby well-known Bristol Hotel and Presidential Palace.

The grounds of PGE National Stadium is where finish and prize-giving ceremony of ORLEN 77th Rally Poland is planned on Sunday evening.

5. SERVICE PARK

5.I. LOCATION

The location of the main Service Park in Mikolajki is:

The Service Park is located on a hard-leveled ground with a pedestrian access to the Rally HQ.

5.2. ACCESS

Service Park will be opened from Wednesday, I6 June 2021, 08:00. If any team needs to access the park before this, please contact the Service Park Coordinator by e-mail.

Service Park can be entered only with competition cars, Service cars (SERVICE plates) and Auxiliary vehicles (AUXILIARY plates). All plates must be affixed to the upper side of the windscreen on the right (passenger) side. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.

Reconnaissance cars and VIP vehicles are not allowed to enter the Service Park. Nearby Parking area will be available for the other registered vehicles (Recce/VIP). Trailers will not be allowed to park inside the Service Park.

Due to the regulations of Appendix S to FIA ISC, which are obligatory at the ERC rallies, it is not possible for spectators and other people to enter the Service Park, except for those reported to the organizer in the COVID-I9 accreditation process. It is necessary to fulfill duties specified in the COVID-I9 section on the rally website – www.rallupoland.pl.

5.3. SERVICE AREAS

The competitor is obliged to service only within the allocated service area in the Service Park. These regulations will be controlled by the Service Park Coordinator. Any infringement in this field will result in charging a double fee for additional service area.

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited by 30 km/h. Failure to comply with this limit shall result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course as follows: 25 Euro per kilometer per hour over the speed limit.

5.5. CATERING WITHIN THE SERVICE PARK

Apart from the provision of a catering service for the drivers and service crew personnel of a team, any other form of catering or sale of food and beverages in the service park is prohibited. The only exception is where a written agreement has been entered into between a team and the Organisers. A fine of I 000 Euro will be applied in respect of any infringement of this regulation. The Organiser will provide a catering service within the Service Park for all team personnel and spectators.

5.6. SHOWS AND EXHIBITIONS IN SERVICE AREA

If any team or company would like to organise shows or exhibitions for their guests in service area, they must ask the Organiser for permission before Administrative Checks. All shows and exhibitions in service area without permission of the Organiser are strictly forbidden.

5.7. TIDINESS

All crews are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a financial penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course.

7.I.2.2. Refuelling procedure

Solely for the purpose of assisting with the refuelling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew with the team passes may access the Refuelling Zone. Team members assisting during refuelling, should wear industry homologated PPE for hydrocarbons handling, such as safety glasses, protective rubber gloves, safety shoes and anti-static clothing. Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation. It is recommended that the crew stay outside the car during refuelling; however, should they remain inside, their safety seat belts must be unfastened.

The Organiser will provide to each competitor an Environnement Mat to protect the ground.

7.2. TYRES

12. RECONNAISSANCE

12.1. REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Competitors are permitted a maximum of two passages (except SSS I4) over each special stage during Reconnaissance. All stages driven more than once in the rally will be considered as one stage for Reconnaissance purposes.

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, except in cases described in Recce Road Book (competitors may drive from the finish to the start of special stage using road which is a short part of the stage in the opposite direction of the rally traffic).

The speed limit on this part of stages during Reconnaissance is 40km/h.

Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish.

The special stages will be open to normal traffic, therefore safety and rights of other road users must be respected. Competitors are reminded that vehicles may be travelling in the opposite direction.

Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

Competitors must fully respect the Polish Traffic Law regulations, including use seatbelts and speed limits:

- 50 km/h in the built-up area (if the signs does not show otherwise).
- 90 km/h outside the built-up area (if the signs does not show otherwise).

Maximum speed allowed during Reconnaissance is 70 km/h on special stages, unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instructions in the Road Book or Bulletin.

All Competitors must note that there will be police controls to prevent speeding or other road infringements. Any speeding offence whether recorded by police or officials on a special stage or on a road section, will result in a fine as shown in 2021 FIA-RRSR Art. 34.2. The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during Reconnaissance is forbidden.

12.2. REGISTRATION FORM

The Reconnaissance registration form including details of the car that will be used during Reconnaissance must be completed and submitted during the registration. This form is available at www.rallupoland.pl (Competitors section).



12.3. PARTICIPATION IN RECONNAISSANCE ONLY

Any driver holding an appropriate international license and not entered in the rally may apply to take part in the Reconnaissance. The registration form for this purpose must be sent by e-mail to biuro@rallypoland.pl before the closing date for entries. The final permission for taking part in Reconnaissance is left to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The fee for taking part only in Reconnaissance is 300 Euro. The regulations on Reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety.

12.4. RECONNAISSANCE SCHEDULE

Reconnaissance will be held according to the schedule specified in Appendix I. The schedule of Reconnaissance must be fully respected by the crews. Reconnaissance outside the schedule as set by the Organiser is considered a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards who may apply a penalty.

IB. SHAKEDOWN, FREE PRACTICE AND QUALIFYING

I3.I. LOCATION

Free Practice, Qualifying Stage and Shakedown will be held in Tałty, about 6,5 km from Service Park in Mikolajki. The stage is 3,26 km in length. Service Zone and Refuelling Zone for Free Practice and Qualifying Stage will be located in the main Service Park in Mikolajki: Hotel Gołębiewski parking - Mikołajki, ul. Mrągowska 34.

13.3. RULES

Only competitors, who passed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering, can participate in Shakedown, Free Practice and Qualifying Stage. Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to their cars. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal Special Stage.

Any passenger on board the car during Free Practice / Shakedown who is not entered for the rally must have signed a disclaimer provided by the Organiser. The form will be available in the Rally Office and at Free Practice / Shakedown start.



14. START PROCEDURE

14.1. START ORDER SELECTION

The selection of start positions, according to 2021 FIA-RRSR – VIa ERC Art. 37.8, will take place on Friday, 18 June 2021 at 17:45 at the Media Centre Mikolajki. Only drivers are required to attend.

14.2. OFFICIAL START OF THE RALLY

The official start of the rally will take place at the TC O (Service - Out) on Friday, I8 June 2021 at I8:45. The starting order for Leg I (Section I) will be published on Friday, I8 June 2021 at I7:45 on the rally website www.rallypoland.pl and on the Official Notice Board. The crews will start from the lowest to the highest starting numbers.

15. FINISH PROCEDURE

The Ceremonial Finish will take place at the PGE Narodowy - Warsaw National Stadium (near Gate 2) on Sunday, 20 June 2021 at 19:00. Drawing of Finish Area is published in Appendix 4. First three crews of the rally will be awarded on the podium. Other prizes will be over-given on the finish ramp.

After the Ceremonial Finish, competitors are obliged to go straight to the final Parc Fermé and they must follow the route described in the Road Book.

Cars are subject to Parc Fermé rules from the moment they reach the end of the competition element of the rally until the Stewards have authorised the opening of the Parc Fermé.

16. OFFICIAL PRE-RALLY TEST

I6.I. PARTICIPATION

The Organiser of ORLEN 77th Rally Poland will organise official pre-rally test for competitors, on Wednesday, I6 June 2021, 08:00-18:00 (I2:00-I3:00 technical break). The stage is 4,20 km in length and is representative for the rally. Further details will be send to all entered competitors or may be given after sending an inquiry to biuro@rallypoland.pl.

16.2. RULES

Official pre-rally test will be run as if it were a stage run during the rally with full technical and medical support and professional time measurement.

Any passenger on board (driver and co-driver) must have an approval from the Organiser and must declare and sign that goes on his own risk (not of a responsibility of the Organiser) – the form will be available at the start.

Only first driver entered to the rally can drive the car during pre-rally test.





ORLEN 77TH RALLY POLAND OVERVIEW RALLY MAP LEG I / LEG 2










SPECIAL STAGE MAPS: SS 3/6 - OLECKO






SPECIAL STAGE MAPS: SS 4/7 - WIELICZKI






SPECIAL STAGE MAPS: SS 9/II - MIKOLAJKI MAX






SPECIAL STAGE MAPS: SS IO/I2 - GMINA MRAGOWO






