1. INTRODUCTION

Dear Friends,

2022 will mark the revival of Rallye Monte-Carlo for its 90th edition. Service Park returns to the Principality for our winter event, which will be located on the quays of the Monaco harbour and its special stages which will take place only in the two French departments of the Alpes-Maritimes and the Alpes-de-Haute-Provence.

These are not the only innovations. Manufacturers' WRC cars (Ford, Hyundai, Toyota) will be hybrid cars for the first time, equipped with an additional 100 kW (136 hp) battery, allowing them to run in purely electric mode and to provide extra power during special stages. Another revolution, after the electrification, is in the fuel tank with the use, for the first time also in the cars of the World Rally Championship, of synthetic fuel supplied by the FIA exclusive distributor, the Company P1 Fuels.

Apart from these technical evolutions, the route will also undergo adaptations due to this refocusing on the Principality : the Starting Ceremony will take place on the Place du Casino on Thursday 20th January from 6.45 pm and will precede two night special stages between Vésubie and Bévéra, with "Luceram / Col Saint-Roch / Lantosque" and "La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini / Moulinet", traditional stages which represent about forty kilometres.

On Friday 21st January, the competitors will head further north in the Alpes-Maritimes with three special stages taking place between the Var and Tinée in the morning, followed by a second run in the afternoon, with a regroup and a tyre fitting zone in Puget-Theniers. " Roure / Beuil ", " Pierlas / Ilonse ", " La Tour-sur-Tinée / Utelle ", each with a total of about twenty kilometres, which will make this Friday the busiest day of the Rally with 120 km of SS.

On Saturday 22nd January, we will go to Digne-les-Bains and complete three stages on that day, of which only two will be repeated in the afternoon. We will find the Col de la Colle Saint-Michel between Le Fugeret and Thorame-Haute to start the day. Then we will go through Saint-Jeannet to Malijai, and finally reach Sisteron to climb to Saint-Geniez and going down to Thoard on a shortened version of this long mythical stage. Back to Digne-les-Bains with a regroup and a tyre fitting zone before reaching Monaco without repeating the passage of the Colle Saint-Michel. Less than a hundred kilometres will be completed on this day.

On Sunday 23rd January, two stages will still have to be run, without any service park or tyre fitting zone after the start in Monaco. These will be "La Penne / Collongues", via Saint-Antonin and "Briançonnet / Entrevaux", (as in the previous edition) which will act as a Power Stage and may determine the final winner of this 90th edition.

Ultimate novelty: the Prize-giving ceremony will exceptionally take place on the Place du Casino from where the cars will have left and we will meet again from 4 pm to celebrate all those who will have braved the difficulties to finally return to the Principality.

The health crisis, which is not over yet, could reserve again access restrictions, nevertheless we hope to see spectators as soon as possible in the dedicated public zones around the special stages.

Any RGT and non-priority drivers wishing to take part in the "90th Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2022" must complete the electronic entry form available on the ACM website and pay online **before Friday, 17th December 2021 - 24h00.**

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship, as well as the WRC 2 and WRC 3 Competitors must use the standard FIA entry form available on the FIA website.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2022 FIA WRC SR Art. 22.5. Competitors will sign the entry form at the Administrative Checks.

If a competitor cannot make the entry on the internet, he must contact the rally secretariat before close of entries for further instructions.

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of entrants is 70, divided in 5 priority groups: priority 1 (P1), priority 2 (P2), priority 3 (P3), RGT and non-priority (NP).

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority drivers entered in the name of the driver (driver = competitor).

18.2 Accreditation procedure

18.2.1 Principles

1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 90^e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or Radio tabards are not issued for websites.
2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.



4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

18.2.2 Procedures

1. Foreign Media must submit their request to the FIA before **Friday, 31st December 2021**. The international accreditation form is available on the FIA website:

2. Monegasque Media must send their request on the ACM official website www.acm.mc before **Friday, 24th December 2021**.
3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2021).
4. The request must include:
 - The accreditation form completed;
 - An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
 - A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
 - Copies of the published articles covering the 2021 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Monte-Carlo;
 - A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Monte-Carlo 2022;
 - Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Monte-Carlo 2022, with details on release dates or broadcast.
5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.
