## 4 - BRIEF HISTORICAL NOTE OF THE EVENT

The first edition of Azores Rallye dates back from 1965, at the time called “Volta à Ilha de São Miguel”. In 1968, it became part of the Portuguese Rally Championship and, by its eighth edition, receives international status. Next step was the European Rally Championship, becoming a coefficient 2 event in 1992. Due to several years of successful events, it climbs up to coefficient 10, soon before, from changes made on the FIA ERC Sporting Regulations, becoming part of the FIA European Rally Cups.

In 2008 comes the opportunity to join the most mediatized motorsport competition at the time, the Intercontinental Rally Challenge (IRC), organized and promoted by Eurosport. Named that year SATA Rallye Açores, the event assumes the role of IRC Support Event, with eyes placed on the coveted rise to a level of prominence in the world of motorsport. With the unique opportunity to cause a good impression, the organizing committee gets another great review and in the next year, SATA Rallye Açores finally reaches the desired entry in the IRC, with consecutive presences until 2012.

At the beginning of 2013, with the merge of the IRC with the FIA European Rally Championship, SATA Rallye Açores reached the goal of taking part of the most important FIA’s regional championship, something pursued since 1992.

The golden edition of SATA Rallye Açores, the 50th, takes place in 2015 with one of the best entry lists ever, being decided only on the last stage. In 2016 the name changed to Azores Airlines Rallye, due to the rebranding made by SATA, the Azorean airline, main sponsor of the event. It took 45 years to see an Azorean reaching the highest place in the podium, with local hero Ricardo Moura winning the event.

With the end of the partnership with SATA, a new name was found – Azores Rallye, on since 2019.

Many years and several names, but always being only “for the brave”!

## 6 - 55<sup>th</sup> AZORES RALLYE 2021

What a fantastic edition the 2021 55<sup>th</sup> Azores Rallye was!

For the first time, the special stages of Graminhais and Tronqueira opened the event. The rally started under a big storm, making it very difficult for the drivers to set a quick pace. The local hero Ricardo Moura imposed his knowledge and was the first leader, managing to keep his place until the last special stage of the day, the Super Special Grupo Marques, where dust became the protagonist, falling to third position.

Who benefited from this were the Spanish from Hyundai and the Norwegian from Skoda, the first three being separated by just 4.5s at the end of the longest and most demanding stage of Azores Rallye.

One of the big favorites to win, the European champion Alexey Lukyanuk, had a day to forget, with punctures and small accidents, which kept him away from victory.

As traditional in the Azores, after the storm, the calm. The closing day was a sunny and warm one.

And it was all about the fight between Sordo and Mikkelsen, in a rally of their own, marveling the thousands of spectators who followed the race. Everything was decided only in the last special stage, and by less than 15 seconds.

Also in Sete Cidades there was drama for Moura, throughout the day third place, but losing the position to Efren Llarena, by just 3.2s, after rolling. The Azorean would be awarded the prize "For the Brave".

## 14 - FUEL

### 14.1 - GENERAL

Crews may refuel only in the RZ's or remote RZ's designated in the road book, except as detailed under Article 61.1.1 of the FIA RRSR.

**Only the use of fuel in complying with FIA appendix J will be permitted.**

### 14.2 - PROCEDURES

Only actions inside a RZ directly involved in the refueling of the competing vehicle are permitted according to Article 61.2 of the FIA RRSR.

The Organizer will provide an Environment Mat to protect the ground.

Solely for assisting with the refueling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew, identified with the official passes supplied by the Organizers (SERVICE) and wearing a reflective green tabard, according to Road Traffic Laws, may access this zone.

In the event of a breakdown, the car concerned may be pushed out of the zone by the crew, officials and/or the two members without incurring a penalty

In RZ, a 5km/h speed limit will apply.

Engines must be switched off throughout the refueling operation.

It is required that the crew stay outside the car during refueling.

### 14.3 - PERSONNAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Two team members assisting during refueling, should wear industry homologated PPE for hydrocarbons handling, such as safety glasses, protective rubber gloves, safety shoes and anti-static clothing.

It is highly recommended these team members wear fire-resistant clothing.

## 18 - RECONNAISSANCE

### 18.1 - REGISTRATION

All competitors who wish to take part in reconnaissance must fill the form available on [www.azoresrallye.com](http://www.azoresrallye.com)

### 18.2 - IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

Organizer will supply 2 stickers that must be affixed on top of the windshields (co-driver's side), one on the front, and other on the rear of the reconnaissance car.

They must be visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

- Should a crew's reconnaissance car be replaced for any reason, the secretariat must be informed of the details of the replacement car.

### 18.3 - RECONNAISSANCE TIME CARDS

A time card valid for up to 2 (two) passages over each special stage – considered each version - will be supplied and must be carried in the car and presented at the beginning (Start) and at the end (Stop) of each SS and, if requested, to the intermediate points distributed along the itinerary. Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance time cards returning – see 3 programme.

### 18.4 - TIMETABLE

Reconnaissance schedule for all drivers will take place as described in Appendix 2 of the Supplementary Regulations.

### 18.5 - SPECIFIC RESTRICTIONS AND SPEED LIMITS

- Crews are authorized to drive a maximum of 2 (two) passages through each special stage – considered each version - at a maximum speed of 60 km/h unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic sign and fully respecting the local Road Traffic Laws and speed limits.
- In the SSS "GRUPO MARQUES", crews are authorized to drive only one complete lap on each track. One complete lap on track 1 and one complete lap on track 2.
- Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the race route at the Special Stages.
- The progress of the crews will be followed on the special stages by GPS tracking and officials, who mark the time and competitor number to a check sheet at each stage START and STOP control. Cars must stop at these locations and present their timecards for marking by rally officials.
- During each passage through a special stage, only the crew (driver and co- driver) are permitted in the car.
- The presence of a driver and/or his co-driver on a special stage, in any way whatsoever, is considered as reconnaissance, except on foot.
- Special Stages will be supervised by Rally Officials and crews must follow their instructions.

### 18.6 - SPEEDING FINES DURING RECONNAISSANCE

Speed will be monitored by GPS tracking system, which must be maintained in suitable condition during all periods.

Speeding during reconnaissance in road sections/SS/SSS/QS or shakedown will incur in a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows:

**Per km per hour over the speed limit: 25,00€;**

Other traffic infringements will be forwarded to the Stewards according to Art. 34.2.3 of the FIA RRSR.

The amount of the fines will be unaltered by any fine imposed by the police.

The fine will be doubled in case of a second offense committed according to Art. 34.2.5 of the FIA RRSR.
