1 INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

Welcome to the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal, once again held in the northern and central regions of the country, between the 11th and 14th of May.

Following the success of previous years, the 56th edition of the Rally Portugal, included in one of the main championships in the world of motorsport – World Rally Championship (WRC) – will certainly be the sporting and touristic event which will contribute the most to the positioning of the country as a tourist destination and to the cohesion of the territory.

After the success of the last year's introduction of a new era of cars in the WRC, with the more eco-friendly hybrid Rally1 cars which combine a 100W electric motor with the internal combustion engine working with a new 100 percent sustainable fuel, seeking to create the conditions to enter a new era of cleaner and more sustainable Rallies.

With the headquarters at Exponor, in Matosinhos, the Automóvel Club de Portugal, has, yet again, elected Coimbra as the starting point of the rally, with the traditional Ceremonial Start and a Super Special to be run in the city center.

Portugal's image abroad has proven to be one of the vectors of excellence of the impact of the WRC Rally de Portugal. As a promoter of the tourist destination, the media value generated by the 2022 edition of the competition exceeded 77.7 million euros of AEV (Advertising Equivalent Value), according to the study of the University of Algarve in partnership with the University of Minho.

The appreciation results from the international exposure through TV, Print, Web-TV, online and social media image of the event and the North and Center regions in the various international channels, with emphasis on television exposure to more than 150 countries, namely France, Finland, Belgium, Spain, Japan, Poland, Sweden, Germany, Czech Republic, and Bulgaria.

In addition to the full coverage of the race by the WRC Promotor, the 2023 edition of the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal has already secured six live international television broadcasts during the four days of competition.

The WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal is eligible for the World Rally Championship with the Rally 1 cars, for the WRC2 championship with the Rally2 cars and also, like last year's for the Peugeot Rally Cup Iberica with the Peugeot 208 Rally4. The rally is also eligible for the Portuguese Rally Championship.


A word of appreciation is due to all the Municipalities involved in the itinerary of the event and for the essential support of our sponsors – Turismo de Portugal, Turismo do Porto e Norte, Turismo do Centro, as well as Vodafone, BP, Hertz, KontraProduções – and a special recognition to the various entities involved in the safety of the rally, without them it will be impossible to run it: Guarda Nacional Republicana, Polícia de Segurança Pública, Proteção Civil and INEM.

According to the Environmental Certification Framework, the ACP (Automóvel Club de Portugal), while organiser of the Rally de Portugal has been certified since 2017 with the accreditation Achievement of Excellence by the FIA (Federation Internationale de l'Automobile).

The Portuguese National Olympic Committee elected, in 2019, the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal as the first case of environmental sustainability success in Motorsport, through his environmental accreditation program.

The Automóvel Club de Portugal is committed to the FIA Sustainability Program in order to proceed with the improvement work and minimize the environmental impact of the event, continuing the implementation of the necessary measures which have resulted in this level accreditation.

Last but not the least, a reference to a very relevant issue for the success of event: the spectators safety. The huge popular enthusiasm stirred by the Rally Portugal should always be an added value to national sport and tourism. Only with the commitment of all the WRC Vodafone Rally de Portugal will be crowned with success.

5.1 Information about the service park

The Service Park will be located in the Exponor Exhibition Centre, in Matosinhos, by the A28 and only 6.5 km away from the Francisco Sá Carneiro International Airport.

Manufacturer teams, WRC teams, and FIA support Championships teams will benefit from the FIA recommended area. Remaining competitors will be attributed an area of 10m x 8m.

WRC Teams will be able to access the Service Park from 09.00 a.m. on Saturday, 06th May, 2023. Should any team need to access the park before this or should they arrive at night, when normal access is closed, please contact the Rally Organisers, by e-mail servicepark@acp.pt or call +351 963 929 021.

Service vehicles arriving at Service Park on Sunday, 07th May, in the morning, i.e., before teams have attended the administrative checks to get the corresponding documents and necessary vehicle plates, will be able to access the Park without a plate. From Tuesday, 09th May, at 09.00h, all vehicles will have to be duly identified with the corresponding plates. From that moment on, there will be an exhaustive control in order to guarantee that all vehicles parked or trying to access the Service Park carry the necessary plate.

Trailers are not allowed to park inside the Service Park.

Only vehicles with "SP – Service Park" plate will be authorised to stay inside the Service Park.

5.2 Facilities at Service Park

- General Lighting in the whole Service Park

- Waste containers – Selective waste collection

8 IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Competitors from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment for the purpose of participating in the 2023 Vodafone Rally de Portugal. Vehicles from outside the European Union must show their ATA (Admission Temporaire/Temporary Admission) carnet, which normally is applied for at the Chamber of Commerce in the country of origin.

9 HELICOPTERS

9.1 Registration Procedure

Complying to the requisites imposed by FIA on the safety and use of helicopters at the Rally, helicopters wishing to operate at the rally will have to register with the Organization. A protocol for controlling the restricted airspace over the SS's (Special Stages) prevents any unregistered helicopter of operating in that airspace. The registration fee for each helicopter is € 3000,00 (+VAT). Registration deadline is the 6th of May 2023.
