

Due to major construction works, which meant that all the areas required for the service park and other infrastructures were no longer available in the Principality, the Organizing Committee of the Automobile Club de Monaco opted to return to the Hautes-Alpes department, and more specifically to Gap, the host town from 2014 to 2021.

With 14 passes to be crossed along the 17 special stages spread over 5 French departments, the route of this inaugural round of the 2024 FIA World Rally Championship (WRC) has moved up in latitude - and therefore in altitude - in the hope of an even snowier course than in previous editions.

However, the official start, finish and prize-giving ceremony will continue to be held in Monaco.

The purpose of Rally Guide 1 is to provide you with the main information about our event, 4 months before it kicks off. Even if it has no regulatory value, it will undoubtedly help you prepare and anticipate your future participation in the 92nd Monte-Carlo Automobile Rally.

We hope you enjoy reading it, and look forward to seeing you from November 22 onwards for the official publication of our event's special regulations...

4.2 Entry procedure

Any RGT and non-priority drivers wishing to take part in the "91st Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023" must complete the electronic entry form available on the ACM website and pay online **before Friday, 22nd December 2023 - 24h00.**

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship, as well as the WRC2 and WRC3 Competitors must use the standard FIA entry form available on the FIA website.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2024 FIA WRC SR Art. 22.5. Competitors will sign the entry form at the Administrative Checks.

If a competitor cannot make the entry on the internet, he must contact the rally secretariat before close of entries for further instructions.

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of entrants is 75, divided in 4 priority groups: priority 1 (P1), priority 2 (P2), priority 3 (P3), and non-priority (NP).

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority drivers entered in the name of the driver (driver = competitor).

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Vehicles from the European Union do not need a specific document for Customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to Customs Authorities at their point of entry into the European Union. 9. HELICOPTERS

In accordance with articles L363-1 to L363-3 of the French Environment Code, amended by law no. 2022-217 of February 21, 2022, article 63, which prohibits the landing of aircraft for commercial purposes in mountainous areas (+800m altitude), helicopters intended for VIPs will no longer be authorized.

Only security and television helicopters will be allowed.

18.2 Accreditation procedure

18.2.1 Principles

1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 92^e Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or Radio tabards are not issued for websites.

2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

18.2.2 Procedures

1. Foreign Media must submit their request to the FIA before **Thursday, 11th January 2024**. The international accreditation form is available on the FIA website:

2. Monegasque Media must send their request on the ACM official website www.acm.mc before **Thursday, 4th January 2024**.
3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2023).



4. The request must include:
 - The accreditation form completed;
 - An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
 - A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
 - Copies of the published articles covering the 2023 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo;
 - A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2024;
 - Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2024, with details on release dates or broadcast.
