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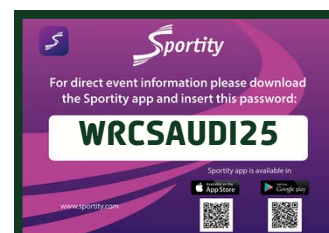

4. Entry Details

4.1 Event Eligibility

The WRC Rally Saudi Arabia counts towards the FIA World Rally Championship for the following categories and below are the titles for which the rally counts.

- FIA World Rally Championship for Drivers & Co-drivers
- FIA World Rally Championship for Manufacturers
- FIA World Rally Championship for Teams
- FIA WRC2 Championship for Drivers & Co-drivers
- FIA WRC2 Challenger Championship for Drivers and Co-Drivers
- FIA WRC2 Championship for Teams
- FIA WRC Masters Cup for Drivers and Co-Drivers
- FIA WRC3 Championship for Drivers and Co-Drivers

4.2 Closing Date for Entries

Closing date and time for entries: Monday, 27 October 2025 at 23:59 CET

Entry application will be accepted only online (FIA)

4.3 List of Entry Fees

Under the agreement between WRC Promoter and Rally Saudi Arabia, entry fees for FIA registered Manufacturer and WRC Teams, including all WRC Championships (WRC, WRC2, WRC2 Challenger, WRC Masters Cup and WRC3 as defined in the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations) are waived for Rally Saudi Arabia powered by Jameel Motorsport 2025.

Entry Fee Invoices

It is reminded that the entry form must be accompanied by the total entry fees or by an appropriate receipt. Invoices for entry fees will be automatically issued and sent out for each entry (competitor's name and address). Competitors requiring an invoice before payment is made must inform the organiser in due time so that the competitor can comply with the payment conditions.

Important Note:

Entries paid by a foreign company with a tax ID number and with business seat in a foreign country may be paid EXCLUSIVE OF VAT (reverse charge), provided that the INVOICE ADDRESS as well as the RESPECTIVE TAX ID NUMBER are indicated TOGETHER WITH THE ENTRY FORM.

Invoices/ receipts for additional materials/ facilities will only be issued upon request.

Entries Acceptance Criteria

The maximum number of entrants will be 50. If more than 50 entries are received the organiser reserves the right to convene a panel of representatives of FIA, WRC Promoter and ASN to decide which entries among the non-priority crews will be accepted. Such decisions will be at their absolute discretion and may be made based on any criteria they decide.

Entry Procedure:

Any competitor wishing to take part in Rally Saudi Arabia must register and fill in the electronic entry form on the FIA online platform before the closing date for entries. Entry is confirmed upon full payment.

Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. The FIA will need time to register you in the system and open your user account. Please do not wait until the last moment to make your entry in order not to miss the entry closing date. A duly completed electronic entry form must be sent before the closing date for entries.

After the online registration, each Competitor is required to upload the photocopies of the required documents to the Administrative Documents form in the Competitors section on the Event website <https://www.rally-saudi-arabia.com/> by Monday, 27 October 2025 at 23:59 CET at the latest. For the list of required documents, see Art.10.1 of these Supplementary Regulations.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The full payment of the entry fee must be on the Organisers bank account before the closing date for entries. No entry will be accepted without the full payment.

It is compulsory to mention the account holder on your bank transfer documents.

4.7 Advertising Regulation

- Advertising content must not include political, religious, or socially sensitive material, and must not be offensive or abusive in nature.
- Gambling, alcohol, and betting advertisements are strictly prohibited under Saudi law.
- Tobacco advertising is not permitted, in line with national health regulations and government restrictions.

5. Service Park

5.1 Service Park Location & Manager

There will be a single Service Park for the WRC Saudi Arabian Rally 2025, located at the Car Parking - Jeddah Corniche Circuit in the heart of Jeddah. This venue will host the Media Centre, and Scrutineering. Rally HQ and Rally Control will be based at Jeddah Corniche Circuit Car Parking.

For teams using trucks with tent extensions or other temporary structures, please note that these must comply with all local regulations regarding structural safety and temporary building approvals. Inspections by local authorities are to be expected.

It is essential to follow legal requirements related to the notification and approval of such temporary structures as outlined in the local Building Code. For assistance, please contact Venue Operations Team at vom@saudimotorsport.com

Service Park Regulations

- **Vehicle Washing:** Washing of trucks or any other vehicles inside the Service Park is strictly prohibited.
- **Wastewater Management:** All waste and wastewater tanks must be emptied prior to entering the Service Park. In exceptional cases where this is not possible, the organiser may provide disposal services. These will be charged at €100 per m³ + 15% VAT, plus €300 + 15% VAT for transport.
- **Parking Regulations:** Auxiliary team vehicles may be parked in the designated large parking area adjacent to the Service Park. Parking any team vehicle within the Service Park is strictly forbidden. Illegally parked vehicles will be immediately removed, and the team will be charged €300 + 15% VAT, payable on release.
- **Team-Related Vehicles:** Vehicles displaying official team stickers (e.g. service cars, recce cars, manufacturer meteo crews, route note cars) must be parked in the designated team parking area.
- **Joint Service Area Requests:** Teams wishing to share a service area with another competitor must notify the organiser by the deadline stated in Article 3.1. Please note that while all efforts will be made, not all requests can be accommodated.
- **Drone Policy:** The Service Park is a strict no-fly zone for drones throughout the event.

5.2 Service Park Facilities

General Provisions:

- Surface Type: Tarmac
- Available Space: As outlined in Section 4.3
- Facilities: Public toilets, water access points, and waste collection areas
- Power Supply: Provided by the organiser; teams must bring their own extension cables (European standard sockets)
- Lighting: General site lighting provided
- Security: General security will be in place from Monday, 24 November to Sunday, 30 November 2025
- Car Wash: A car wash facility will be available on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday before vehicles enter the regroup area/service park Exact locations will be detailed in the Road Book)

Manufacturer Areas – Additional Services (Provided Free of Charge by the Organiser):

- Allocated Space: As per individual agreements
- Power Supply: Available upon request
- Water Access: Fresh water and wastewater drainage provided; teams must bring their own hoses and adapters
- Waste Collection: One 1.1 m³ waste container per team, emptied daily from Tuesday to Saturday
- Additional Services: As outlined in the official administrative package, available on website.

5.3 Environmental Prescriptions

The compliance with the environmental and safety prescriptions (see also Supplementary Event Regulations) will be carefully checked by officials. Please make sure that all team members are aware of these prescriptions.

More details will be published in due course.

5.4 Service

There will be a 15-minute service after SSS1 Jameel Motorsport Super Special on Thursday morning. There will be NO service in the morning on Saturday between the overnight Parc Fermé and the first special stage of the day.

On Thursday and Friday, there will be a 40-minute mid-day service in the Service Park Jeddah (no flexi), preceded by a regroup.

For all other competitors, the car may be left in the Parc Fermé after the 10-minute Technical Zone and taken later for the 45-minute service, or driven directly to service, when the service time starts from Parc Fermé OUT time control.

On arrival to their service bays, all drivers will be asked to be accessible to the public for autographs and photos.

For any repairs prior to a re-start (i.e. after a retirement), please see the prescriptions of FIA WRC, Art. 55.

There will be no remote service zones or tyre-fitting zones outside the main service park during the rally. There will be a remote service zone for Shakedown on Wednesday. This is approximately 40kms from Jeddah. More information will be given in the Supplementary Regulations.

6.Two Way Radios

6.1 Applications

All applications to use two-way radios must be submitted prior to the commencement of the event.

To ensure smooth event operations, all radio frequency requirements must be submitted at least 2 months prior to the event, while satellite requirements should be provided 3 months in advance. Non-priority drivers' attention is drawn to the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 13.2 which states that all drivers with a 4WD car must use tyres from the nominated tyre supplier, as defined in the Supplementary Regulations of the rally. Alternatively, Art. FIA WRC SRs 13.3 allows the use of any make of tyres for non-priority drivers in 2WD cars, provided they all come from the same tyre supplier. For more details, contact the organiser.

7.2 FIA Fuel & Fast Couplings

Refuelling will be located in Service Park Jeddah (starting from Shakedown), as well as near Khulais General Hospital (Sections 2 and 3), near Al Kamil Road (Sections 5 and 6) and at University of Jeddah (Section 8). The competitors need to pay special attention to the various refuel locations on the itinerary when making their service plans. More information to follow in Supplementary Regulations and Rally Guide 2.

Cars driven by Priority drivers must be fitted with FIA fuel sample couplings for taking fuel samples (see FIA Technical List No. 5). All cars must be fitted with FIA-specified refuel couplings (manufacturer: Stäubli, model: SPT 127 658 LJV). Also, see FIA WRC, Art. 62.

7.3 Safety Fuel Tanks

Competitors' attention is drawn to the prescriptions of the FIA ISC, Appendix J, Art. 253-14, which states that all cars in groups N and A must be fitted with an FIA approved safety fuel tank. For car in other groups, please see technical regulations of the group concerned. Cars homologated under Rally5-Kit regulations may use their original, unmodified tanks.

The use of FIA fuel is obligatory for all priority drivers (FIA WRC, Art. 62.1.1).

As per FIA WRC regulations Art. 62.2.1, no later than 10 weeks prior to the event (see Art. 3), the competitors must notify their fuel requirements to the sole supplier as nominated by the FIA. More information on the nominated fuel supplier will be given in the Supplementary Regulations of the rally, at the latest.

7.4 Dispensing of FIA Fuel

For sporting, environmental and safety reasons, during the rally the fuel must be dispensed from a single source. Thus, all cars driven by a priority driver must use this centralised refuel service. The price of the fuel, including the refuel services at the site of the event, will be given in the Supplementary Regulations of the rally, at the latest.

8.Import of Vehicles & Spare Parts

Freight forwarding procedures and policies:

8.1 Incoterm for the Vendors

The vendor must identify the shipping inventory before the start of the shipping process and share the information with the logistics team to take prompt action for the shipping operations. Below are the common incoterms used for our logistics operations:

- EXW
- FOB Origin
- DAP
- DDP

All shipments must be ready to be shipped before 1 month of the event starting:

Vendors need to be sure that all the shipments need to be ready for transportation at least one month prior to the event starting, this will facilitate the logistics and clearance process.

8.5 Vendor Shipping Schedule and Documents

Vendors must share the shipping schedule and all the export documents (BL, PL, INV, COO,) with SMC Sporting logistics team before the shipment loading.

Vendor Logistics Contact Person

The Vendor must introduce his logistics agent to the SMC sporting logistics team before shipment loading to ensure smooth operation and better communication to clear the shipment as soon as it reaches KSA borders.

Shipping Schedule, Pre-alert & Tracker

The Vendor must share with SMC sporting logistics team pre-alert and Tracker of the actual departure date and actual arrival date of the shipment to be ready for the clearance process. If the vendor faces some shipping complications, they must inform the SMC sporting logistics team and share the new shipping schedule with the new shipping details.

SMC Shipping Form

The vendor must fill the shipping form before loading the cargo and share it with the shipment export documents. SMC sporting logistics team will proceed with issuing Saber certificate and broker authorization.

SABER Registration Shipments

- **Product Identification:** The freight forwarding company or broker needs to accurately identify the products being shipped.
- **HS Code Assignment:** Based on the identified products, the appropriate HS codes should be assigned. These codes are used to classify the products according to their nature and characteristics.
- **SABER Compliance:** If the products require compliance with Saudi standards through the SABER program, the freight forwarding company or broker would need to make sure that the assigned HS codes align with the relevant Saudi standards for those products.
- **Documentation:** The HS codes and any additional information required for SABER compliance should be documented in the table or form specified.
- **Submission:** The completed table or form should be submitted through the SMC logistics Email to ensure the registration process is done.

Special Permits and Approvals

Any special permits and approvals required, must be requested before shipment departure. The SMC sporting logistics team will reach the concerned party to get the necessary approvals.

- SASO (Saudi standards metrology and quality organization) for SABER exemptions.
- SFDA (Saudi Food and Drug Authority) for live food and first aid and all related communities.
- CITC- CST (Communication. Space & technology Commission) for Radio and communication devices and all related communities.
- MOE (Ministry of Energy) for oil and fuel.
- MOI (Ministry of interior) for fireworks.
- MEWA- (Ministry of environment Water & Agriculture) for plants and live foods.
- GACA – (General Authority of Civil Aviation) for Drones.
- MC- (Ministry of Commerce) for isobar approval.

8.6 Import Bayan

The vendor's custom broker must submit the initial bayan to customs 48 hours before shipment arrival or as soon as the manifest is updated.

8.7 Custom Duties

- **Permanent Shipments:** According to the agreed shipping terms, the vendor or SMC must pay the customs duty fees and tax for the permanent shipments after the inspection to release them.
- All permanent imports are subject to duties and taxes unless an exemption or concession applies.
- **Temporary shipments:** Vendor must sign an undertaking letter before we proceed with customs clearance, mentioning that they will be responsible to follow-up and track their shipment on site and they will make sure to re-export the shipment after the event. If the temporary shipment was not re-exported after the time period agreed, the vendor will take the responsibility and will pay the duty and VAT to the Saudi customs.
- After signing the undertaking letter by the vendor, SMC sporting logistics will provide a letter SANADI signed by MOS to the vendor to be shared with Saudi customs to ensure that the shipment will be temporarily imported and re-exported after the event.

8.8 Final Declaration: Import & Export

- Final import bayan to be shared by the vendor with SMC sporting logistics once the shipment cleared and ready to deliver.
- Final re-export bayan to be shared by the vendor with SMC sporting logistics once the shipment cleared and ready to be loaded on board. If the customs agent encounters any issues, vendor must inform SMC sporting logistics immediately.
- SMC sporting logistics will provide a re-export letter to the vendor customs agent once they share with us the pre-export bayan. Only then they can proceed with the clearance process; otherwise, the shipment will be blocked in KSA customs.

8.9 Closure Reports

Vendor to provide the closure report contains all shipments references (import & export) , bayan copies, shipments documents and final tracker sheet before processing COC`s.

9. Helicopters & UAVs

9.1 Use of Helicopters

Helicopters are only permitted at the event with the approval of the Rally Sporting Director (see Event Contacts) No UAVs (unmanned aerial vehicles) are permitted.

11. Driving Licence in Saudi Arabia

General Driving Regulations in Saudi Arabia:

All WRC Rally Saudi Arabia 2025 participants including teams, media personnel, support staff and international fans are advised to familiarize themselves with local driving regulations to ensure safe and lawful transit during their stay.

1. Governing Authority

Driving regulations in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia are overseen by the Public Security Department under the Ministry of Interior.

2. Legal Driving Age

The minimum legal driving age in Saudi Arabia is 18 years.

3. Foreign Driver Licensing

Visitors may drive in the Kingdom under the following conditions:

- Holders of a valid International Driving Permit (IDP), or
- Holders of a driving license from approved countries, including Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) nations, the European Union, United Kingdom, United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand.

Such licenses are valid for use in Saudi Arabia for up to one year from the date of entry. Please ensure all drivers carry their license, IDP (if applicable), and valid passport or residency documentation when driving.

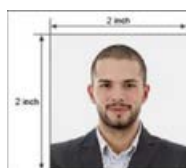
12.1 Visa Guidelines

- Tourist visas will not be accepted for work purposes. All participants must apply for a Work Visa through Saudi Motorsport Company (SMC) to obtain the appropriate status.
- Only single-entry Work Visas will be issued. These visas are strictly limited to WRC- related activities and cannot be used for any other work assignments. Multiple-entry visas will not be granted.
- Each team, media outlet, and TV crew must submit a duly completed Visa Application Form, along with the following documents:

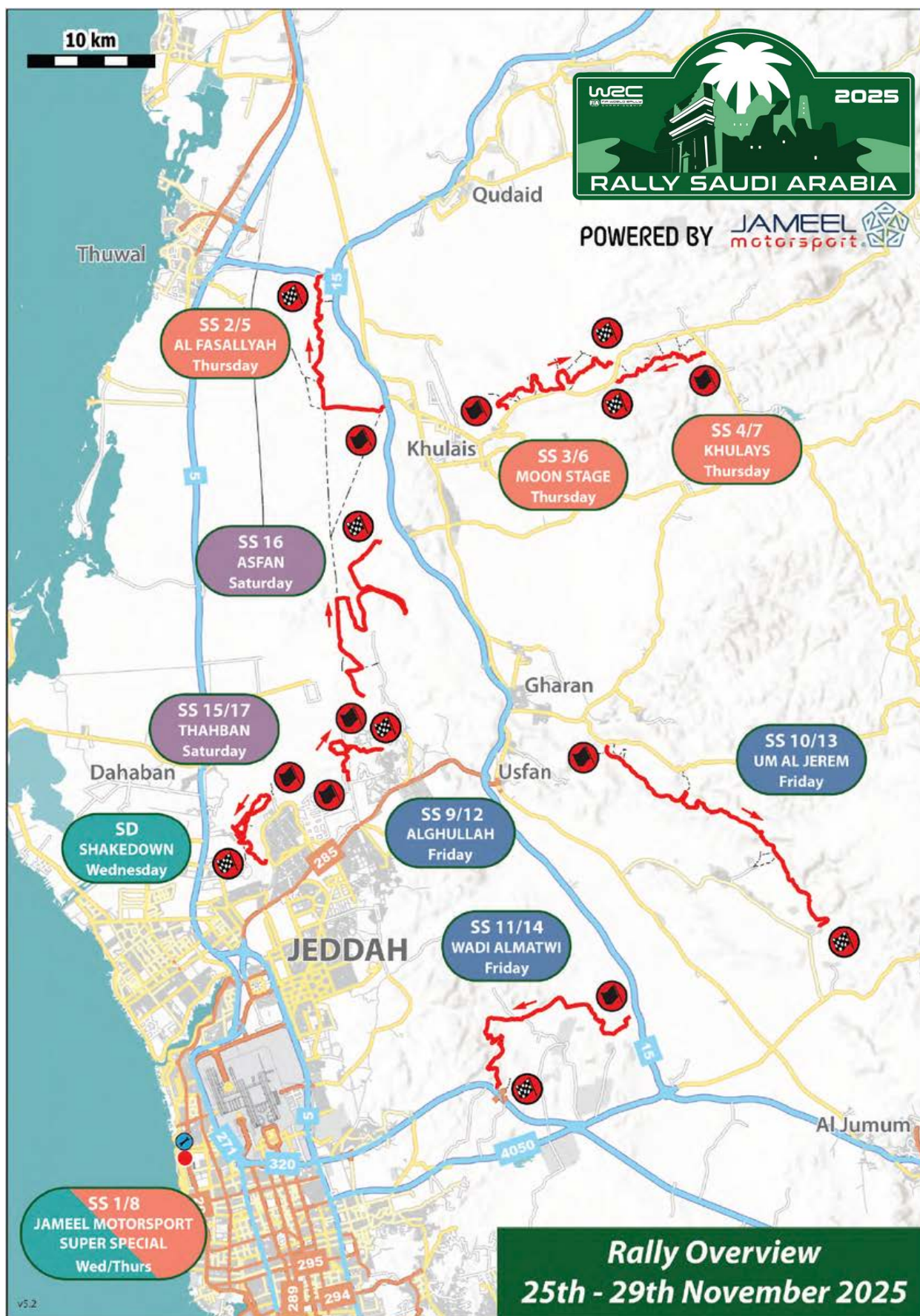

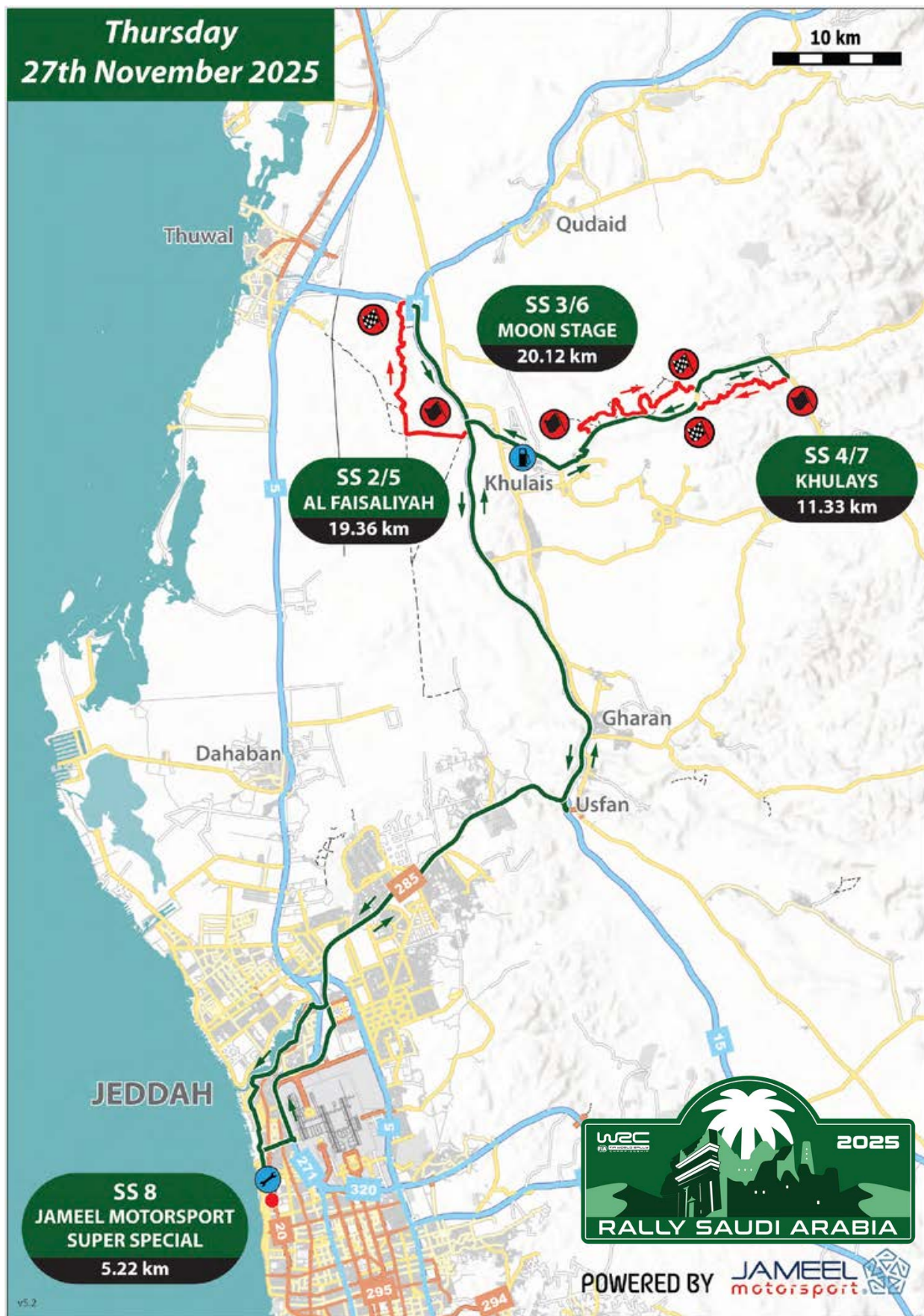

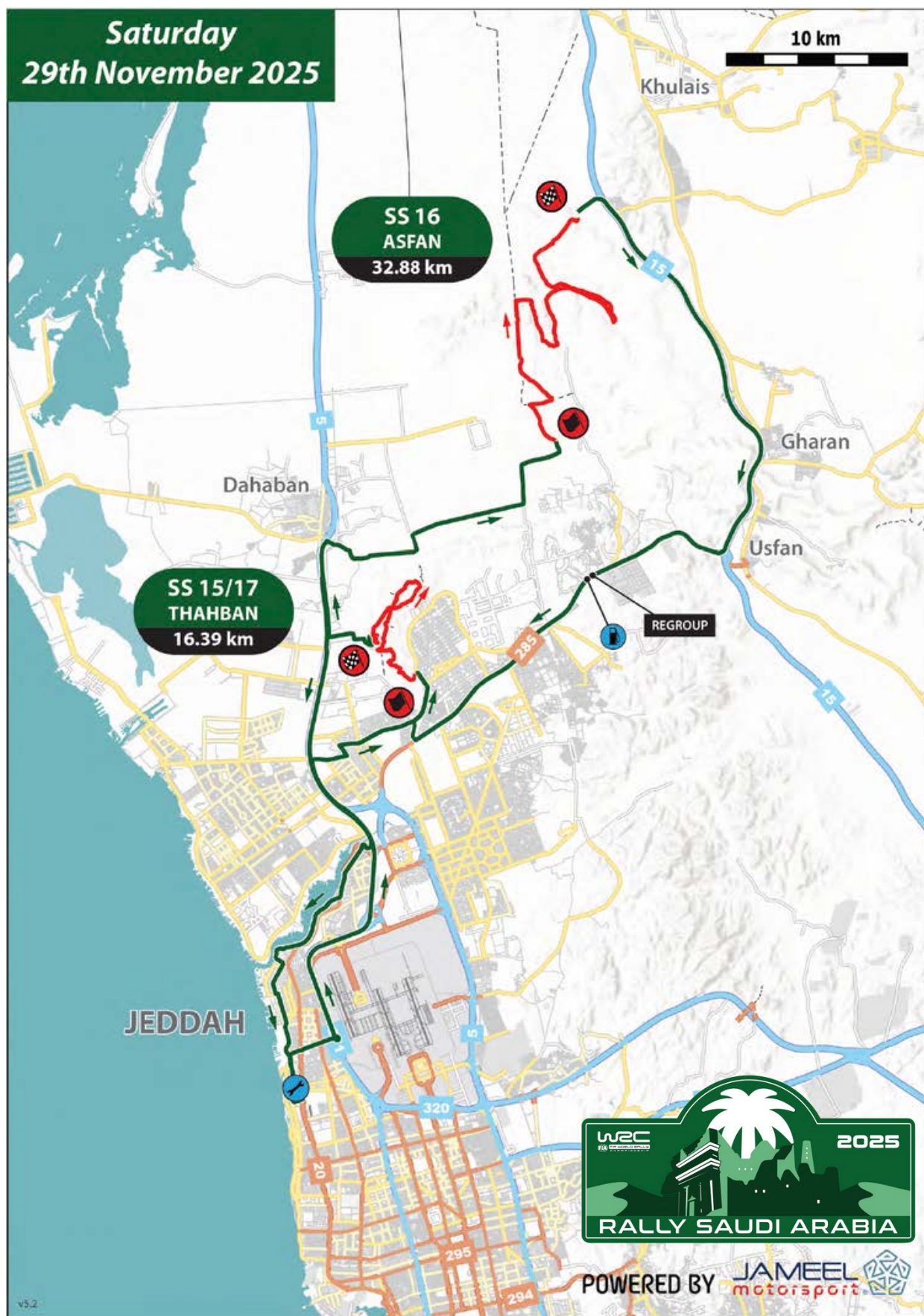

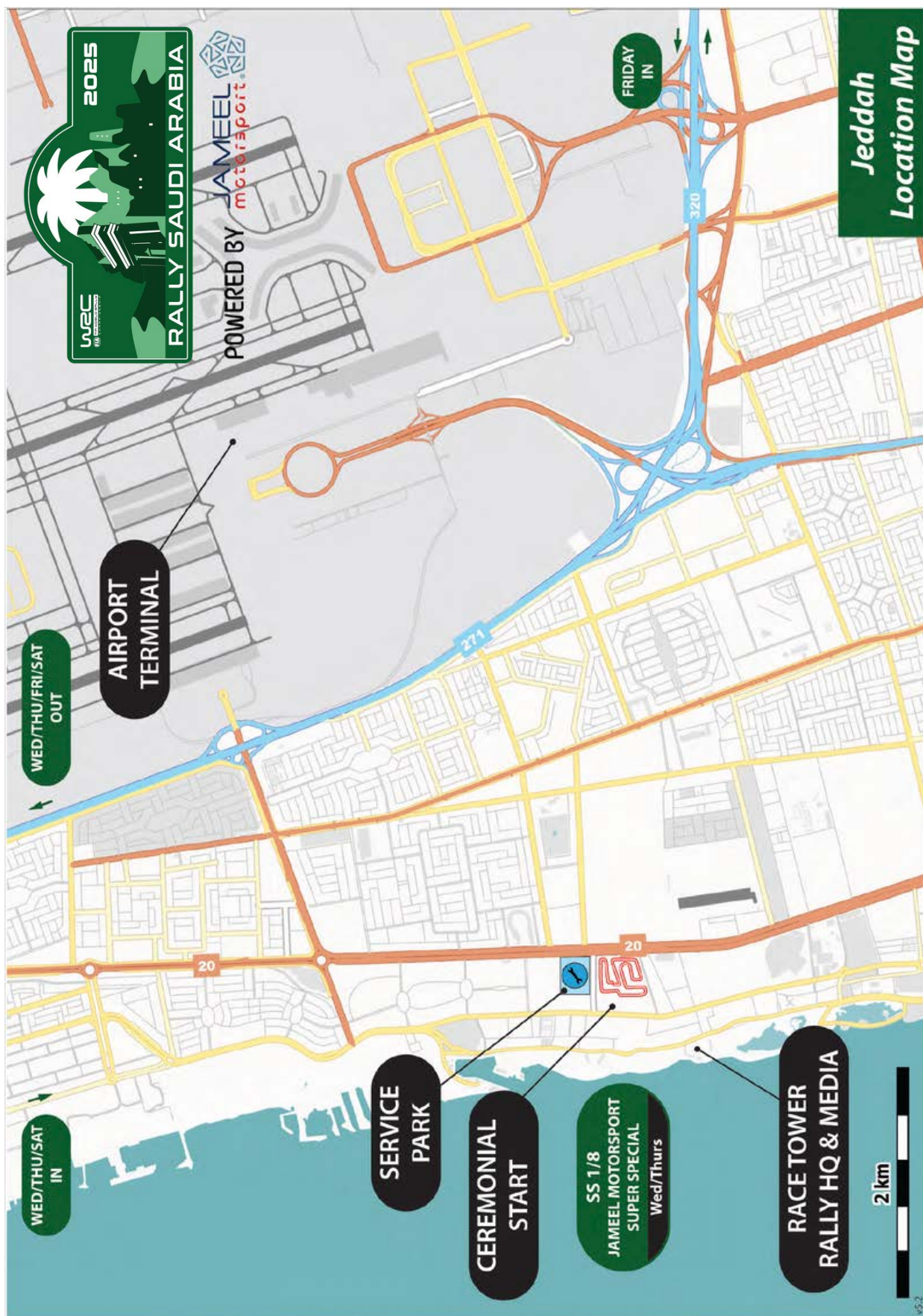
