# 7. Entry forms - Entries

7.1. The entry form should be at the Secretariat at:

Any holder of a valid international or EU rally licence wishing to take part in the **Proflex – Merwede Rally** must send in the entry form, duly completed and signed, to:

Details concerning the co-driver can be sent in until document control.

- 7.2. The number of competitors is fixed at 120.
- 7.3. This event has been entered on the NEAFP-list of the FIA. Foreign competitors of which both drivers have a valid international or EU licence can be admitted to the event.

#### 8. Entry fees – Insurance

- 8.1. Entry fee with organisers' advertising : € 595,- incl. VAT
- 8.2. Entry fee without organisers' advertising : € 995,- incl. VAT
  8.3. The entry fee should be paid by sending the entry form together with Bank Cheque in favour of the Stichting Autosport Promotie Nederland in Nieuwendijk or by including the entry fee in cash (register!). An invoice for the entry fee inc. VAT is available upon request.

The entry will only be accepted when it is sent in accompany of the total amount of entry fee or a voucher of the payment.

- 8.4. Entry fees will be refunded:
  - 100 % if the entry has not been accepted;
  - In all other cases the organising committee will decide upon refunds.
- 8.5. In the individual entry fee the premium for the insurance of liability of competitors and drivers is included. Summary:
  - The organiser has taken measures for insurance of the entrant and drivers for damages against third parties when driving the special stages of the rally.
  - The indemnity provided under this special insurance is maximum €2.500.000,- covering any incident or occurrence.
  - The own-risk is € 1000,- per incident or occurrence.
- 8.6. Before the start of the event the entrant and both members of the team are obliged to sign a form to safeguard the organiser and KNAF for

liability of damages caused by the entrant and/or both members of the team.

#### 9. Advertising

- 9.1. The obligatory organisers' advertising on the rally plates and door panels: **Proflex Merwede**
- 9.2. The extra organisers' advertising: will be announced in a bulletin.

  This extra advertising has to be fixed on the white door panels underneath the door panels with competition numbers according to the scheme (to be published in a Bulletin).

#### 10. Helmets and equipment

The crash helmets and clothing are to be examined at the technical scrutineering.

NOTE: Personal equipment (clothing, underwear, helmets) should meet FIA-specifications.

# 11. Rally plates and door numbers

- 11.1. The organiser will supply every competitor with 2 rally plates.
- 11.2. The organiser will supply every competitor with 2 door panels with competition numbers and 3 stickers for window stickers for rear side windows and back window.
- 11.3. If at any time during the event it is noticed that:
  - one door number or rally plate is missing, a cash penalty of €50,will be imposed.
  - both door numbers and rally plates are missing at the same time will result in exclusion of the event.

#### 12. Reconnaissance

12.1. The organiser offers the opportunity to potential competitors to the reconnaissance of the Special Stages. Reconnaissance of the Special Stages (SS 1,2,3,4) is only allowed on:

Friday April 27th 2007 : from 14.30 hrs - 19.30 hrs Saturday April 28th 2007 : from 07.15 hrs - 10.00 hrs.

- # Reconnaissance with the competition car is allowed.
- 12.2. It is strictly forbidden to drive (with any vehicle) on the roads to be used as Special Stage before Friday April 27th 2007 14.30 hrs.

  The organiser will carry out intensive controls on these roads.

12.3. During reconnaissance, competitors must adhere strictly to the traffic rules. Due to imposed permit legislation rules, maximum driving speed on special stages during reconnaissance is 60 km/hour! The organiser can use speed traps.

During reconnaissance the number as handed out should be located on the front screen.

During reconnaissance reverse driving at the special stages is not allowed and will be punished with a cash penalty of €50,-

- 12.4. Infringement of the above mentioned rules will be penalised as follows:
  - 1st infringement : 2 minutes time penalty (competition time) ;
  - 2nd infringement: not allowed to the start, respectively exclusion.
    In this case the entry fee will not be refunded.

The decision of the organising committee or the Clerk of the Course will be decisive. Such decision can be taken independently of the fact whether or not sanctions are laid upon by police or officials and independent of the result of such action. No right exists on lodging a protest or appeal against such decision and the entry fee will not be refunded.

#### 13. Fuel

Fuel must comply to the FIA specifications, as described in Annexe J of the International Sporting Code, in this case the maximum content of lead for leaded fuel in the Netherlands is not to exceed 0,15 gr/l.

# 14. Scrutineering before the start

Any team taking part in the event must report at scrutineering with its full team, car, helmets and fireproof clothing including underwear.

- # Scrutineering before the start includes the following:
  - A. Document control
  - B. Control on advertising
  - C. Noise control
  - D. Scrutineering

## NOTE: Above mentioned sequence will be kept.

The time to report for A en B/C/D on Friday April 27th will be noted in the entry confirmation letter.

Document control (A) from 13.30 - 17.00 hrs and scrutineering (B/C/D) from 14.00 - 18.00 hrs.

#### 15. Start

- 15.1. During the entire rally the time of KPN Telecom (0900-8002) will be valid as the official rally time.
- 15.2. The cars admitted to the start will be started every minute from 11.01 hrs on Saturday April 28th 2007, from the starting area at the Grote Markt in Hulst.

#### 16. Deviating regulations

- 16.1 Reconnaissance with the competition car is permitted. This article replaces SRR art. 14.2.
- 16.2 Summary of punishments
  - 12.3: reverse driving at the special stages during reconnaissance: cash penalty € 50.-
- 16.3 In case of any dispute concerning the interpretation of the present regulations, only the Dutch text will be binding.

#### 17. Protests

All protests must be lodged in writing and handed over the Clerk of the Course, together with the amount of €125, -- For appeals: see "guidelines for appealing" in the ASJ All protests must be lodged in writing and handed over the Clerk of the Course, together with the amount of €125, -- For appeals: see "guidelines for appealing" in the ASJ.

#### 18. Classifications

During the **Proflex – Merwede Rally** the classifications are being published on the official notice board.

#### 19. Prizes and Cups

The following prizes and cups will be presented:

- cups for the first 3 competitors in the overall classification;
- cups for the first 3 competitors in Formula 2;
- cups for the first competitor in Super 1600;
- cups for the first competitor in each Group;
- cups for the first 3 competitors in the Chevrolet Kalos Challenge;
- there will be one set of cups for every 5 competitors in a class with a minimum of 1 set of cups in every class.

Any prizes in kind and the criteria to award them will be published on the Notice Board.

Prize winning competitors, of which not at least one of the drivers is present during the prize giving, will loose their rights on all prizes, cups as well as prizes in kind. These prizes fall to the organisation.
