All competitors (FIA ERC registered, FIA ERC non registered and Czech Rally Championship) of Barum Czech Rally Zlín must complete also the Czech version of entry form available on the website: <https://www.czechrally.com> in section competitors, they shall also fill the form with the details concerning the Service Park (additional space and other requests for the service area as the electricity, team members, etc.). All competitors taking part in a Championship event (ERC starting field) must ensure that their drivers and co-drivers sign the Driver's Declarations and Undertakings form as attached in RRSR Appendix XIV. This form is available at <https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117> (RELATED DOCUMENTS section). Please print, fill in and sign the Driver's Declaration. The completed and signed Driver's Declaration must be handed to the organiser at the administrative checks.

The competitor of any car which carries an on-board camera must have the prior agreement of the Promoter. The fixings of the camera and camera recorder must comply with the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix J, Art.253.2.

Competitors wishing to use an on-board camera must apply via the Accreditation Portal at the latest by Monday, 10 August 2026. Any requests presented after this date will not be considered and the competitor will not be authorized to install an OBC on their car.

Acceptance of Entry form

An entry application will be accepted only if both entry forms will be filled and accompanied by the total entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's ASN. The organizer has the right to refuse entry of a driver except FIA and ERC registered drivers.

4.6 Refunds

Entry fees will be fully refunded:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- in the case of the rally not taking place.
- In the case of force majeure for the competitor, after investigation by the Stewards.

The organisers may partially refund the entry fee to those entrants who, for reasons of „force majeure” (duly certified by their ASN), were unable to start in the rally and excused themselves before the start of the administrative checks. The crews who do not excuse themselves will be announced to ASN and the entry fee will not be reimbursed.

5. INSURANCE

5.1 Insurance Coverage for the Organizer

5.1.1 The Autoklub of the Czech Republic (ACCR) has made the insurance contract with Allianz pojišťovna, a. s. through the PLATINUM Consulting, s. r. o. company, a framework agreement no. C550012623, organizer's liability insurance covering damage caused to the third party during the competition up to 2 000 000 EUR per incident.

5.1.2 The part of the insurance agreement is the coverage for cars against the damage caused to third party up to 2 000 000 EUR per participant. However, the damage caused by drivers among themselves is not covered by this contract.

The organizer binds self to arrange this insurance contract for all competitors except those, who will show the long-term liability insurance covering damages caused on closed route.

5.1.3 The insurance for organizers and participants is made with an integral excess of 5 000 CZK. It means that damage up to 5 000 CZK won't be refunded and damage over 5 000 CZK will be covered without the complicity of insured.

5.1.4 All crews at administrative check have to hand in the valid International Green Card for their car. Without this card the crew won't be permitted to start.

5.2 Insurance Coverage for the competitors and crews

All the drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative check. The insurance of foreign crews has to cover the costs of possible medical treatment in the Czech Republic. Insurance cover must start from Free Practice / Shakedown until Parc Fermé after the finish of the rally.

5.3 Damage Reporting

The crews are obliged to notify the organizer about the damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty stands for summoning the competitor and involved crew to a disciplinary committee.

5.4 Insurance Coverage Exclusions

Auxiliary vehicles, cars dedicated to reconnaissance rides and vehicles with special labels issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Compulsory advertising

A - starting numbers: Barum

B - rally plates: Barum

C - rear window panel: Barum

6.2 Optional advertising proposed by organiser

The organiser reserves following places which must remain free:

D - panel 67 x 20 cm under the side door starting number: Zlín, MOL, NSA, ACCR, Zlínský kraj, VisitCzechia

E - panel 67 x 20 cm under the side door starting number: Zlín, MOL, NSA, ACCR, Zlínský kraj, VisitCzechia

ERC - ERC advertising stickers (front windscreen, rear windscreen, door strip)

Placement of advertisings proposed by organiser is given in Appendix 4 of these supplementary regulations.

6.3 Loss or removal of advertising

If there is ascertained at any point during the rally that an advertising sticker (or any other type of advertisement) supplied by the organiser is missing from a car then the crew shall be reported to the Stewards.

6.4 Competition numbers and rally plates

Competition numbers and rally plates according to the Article 28 of FIA RRSR supplied by the organiser must appear on both front doors of the car during the whole rally. If it is ascertained at any time during the rally that:

- a competition number or one rally plate is missing, will be reported to the Stewards
- both competition numbers on front doors or both rally plates are missing; this will be reported to the Stewards.

7. TYRES

7.1 Tyres specified for use during the rally

At all times during the event in the Czech Republic, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm. All tyres used during the rally must be in conformity with RRSR Art. 13 and with Appendix V.

7.1.1 Tyres for all ERC-priority competitors

Tyres must be supplied by an FIA-nominated tyre company. A list of nominated tyre manufacturers for the 2026 FIA European Rally Championship is published on <https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117> However, competitors are reminded to comply with:

- 2026 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Art. 13.1.4; Each tyre must have barcode numbers supplied by the 2026 FIA-approved barcode supplier.
- 2026 FIA European Rally Championship Regulations, Art. 13.3.1. Competitors must declare at administrative checks which nominated tyre supplier they will use for the whole rally.
- Tyres of ERC1 competitors must be included in list of barcodes which will be provided to the FIA Technical Delegate by tyre manufacturer before the end of each pre-rally scrutineering.

7.3.2 Quantities of tyres for Junior

The maximum quantity for Junior ERC drivers for whole event is 12 to be chosen from the list above.

7.4 Tyre marking

7.4.1 Tyre marking for the tyres that will be used during the Qualifying will be placed between the TCQS and START QS.

7.4.2 Tyre marking for the tyres will be organised before SSS 1 Zlín and at Service Parks OUT (after TC1D, 4C, 7G and 10C), as shown in the Road Book.

7.5 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

Only road-homologated series production tyres for asphalt are allowed.

8. FUEL, REFUELLING

8.1 Fuel

Fuel must be in compliance with FIA 2026 Appendix J, 266.

8.2 Refuelling

Crews may refuel only in the designated refuelling areas mentioned in the road book, see below:

- Exit of Service area Otrokovice on 14.8. from 8:00 to 16:00
- Exit of Service area Otrokovice on 15.-16.8. according to road book and itinerary of the rally
- Remote Refuel Tlumačov (15.8.) and Slušovice (16.8.) according to road book and itinerary of the rally

8.2.1 FIA Junior ERC Refuelling

FIA Junior ERC competitors are allowed to use ONLY fuel 100 octane from the **ORLEN** Petrol station, Vizovická 375, Příluky, 760 01 Zlín (GPS: 49°13'14.76"N 17°42'28.5"E).

Service crews are allowed to fill this fuel in their canisters, and refuel Junior ERC cars in designated Refuel areas and Remote Refuelling areas.

8.3 Refuelling procedure

In order to access the Refuelling area, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling.

Organiser will provide in all refuelling zones refuelling mat to protect the ground.

8.4 Fuel for ERC1 competitors

All ERC1 priority drivers must use fuel sold by the FIA-appointed supplier ETS Racing Fuels.

No later than the closing date for entries for each rally, competitors must order their fuel on the supplier's website: <https://www.myetstorace.com/championships/>

Competitors are responsible for ordering the sufficient quantity for the entire event and for settling directly with the supplier, or supplier's agent, all matters relating to supply and payment. Unused fuel can be either refunded or collected at the end of the rally.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Reconnaissance registration

Before the beginning of reconnaissance each crew announces a factory make and a registration plate number of its reconnaissance car and present the driving licence. The crew receives identification for its car (starting number) and monitoring GPS unit. GPS unit must be in a Recce car during whole time while making Reconnaissance, also in liaisons. Starting number must be affixed in right upper part of the windscreen during reconnaissance at all the times. Any change of the car must be announced to the organiser in time. **GPS unit must be returned to the organiser in the end of Reconnaissance of SSS 1 Zlín – Stop control.** Time of each Crew for the reconnaissance of SSS 1 will be in time card over given when collecting the road books for Recce. Crew can enter the area before SSS Zlín earliest 20 minutes before their scheduled time. Earlier arrival to the start of SSS 1 recce will be penalised by CoC by 200 Eur.

9.2 Reconnaissance schedule is available in Appendix 2 SR.

9.3 Reconnaissance rules

The crews are obliged to follow general traffic regulations that will be controlled. Speed limit is 90km/h unless lower speed is indicated by traffic signs.

9.3.1 Reconnaissance will be organised in compliance with art. 35 of the FIA RRSR and only series production cars conforming to art. 35.1 of FIA RRSR can be used.

9.3.2. As from the publication of the rally Supplementary Regulations, any driver, or his co-driver, or any other team member who has entered or intends to enter Barum Czech Rally Zlín and who wishes to drive on any road which is used as a special stage in that rally, may only do so after he has obtained the organiser's written permission. Drivers, who for whatever reason enter the area used for the Barum Czech

Rally Zlín during that period, must promptly inform the Clerk of the Course (J. Regner, tel.: +420 577 432 004).

9.3.3 Reconnaissance is restricted in **2 passes** in the same special stage. On the SSS 1 - SSS Zlín only 1 passage (3 laps) is allowed. Crews are forbidden to drive in the opposite direction of the special stages, except of route areas specified in the reconnaissance road book. On SS 4/7 Bunč, there is allowed to drive 370 metres in rally direction to reach again the start of special stage as specified in the reconnaissance road book. When driving SS 8/11 Pindula, it is not allowed to drive through the villages Pohořelice and Oldřichovice (part of SS 2/5 Pohořelice) and when driving to SS 9/12 Semetín, it is not allowed to drive through the village Držková (part of SS 3/6 Troják), see information in the reconnaissance road book. Following the Recce RB is compulsory.

Control will be done by GPS tracking and rally officials, who will observe and control Reconnaissance on place.

9.3.4 The progress of the reconnaissance will be monitored via GPS system, by the Czech police and other rally officials. The maximum speed limitations during reconnaissance follow the Czech traffic regulations. Breaking the rules and mainly exceeding the speed limits will be controlled and fined by the Czech police according to standard procedures. Evaluation the GPS data is within the competence of Clerk of the Course. If there will be found that the reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with working tracking system, the crew will be reported to the stewards.

9.3.5 Driving conduct

Competitors must follow Art. 34 of FIA RRSR

Illegal reconnaissance performed out of the time schedule or performing more passages than permitted will be reported to the stewards.

Speeding during reconnaissance and during the rally will incur a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows:

Per km per hour over the speed limit: **€ 25**

- Other traffic infringements during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the Stewards.
- The amount of the fines will be unaltered by any fine imposed by the police.
- The fine will be doubled in case of a second offence committed during reconnaissance in the same rally.

Penalties for infringements during the competition element of the rally:

a) First infringement:

- Speeding: A fine of €25 per km over the speed limit, applied by the clerk of the course,
- Other than speeding: A penalty will be applied by the Stewards.

b) Second infringement:

- Speeding: A fine of €50 per km over the speed limit, applied by the clerk of the course,
- Other than speeding: A penalty will be applied by the Stewards.

c) Third infringement: A 5-minute time penalty applied by the clerk of the course.

d) Fourth infringement: Disqualification applied only by the Stewards.

9.3.6 Any testing from Wednesday 12. 8.2026 in Zlín region (Zlínský kraj) is prohibited for Barum Czech Rally Zlín entrants. Testing is restricted according to RRSR V1 Art. 68.4

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. Documents to be presented

It is mandatory to send all requested documents in advance to email entry@czechrally.com.

Crews are obliged to make administrative check before their time for scrutineering.

Documents to be sent:

- Competitor and drivers' licences
- Valid Driving licences
- Complete Name list form of all accompanying Team staff including driver and co-driver
- ASN authorisation (mandatory for all foreign competitors)
- Driver's declaration and undertakings forms, signed by the driver and the co-driver
- Car insurance cover certificate and car insurance registration papers (green card)
- First page of homologation sheet
- Authorization of the car owner in case he is not one of the drivers
- Safety E-learning – valid certificate of driver and co-driver

Documents to be checked on administrative checking:

- Competitor and drivers' licences
- Valid Driving licences will be checked when collecting reconnaissance material
- Signed entry form (competitor and crew members)

Notwithstanding the 2026 FIA-RRSR, Art. 30.1, drivers and co-drivers are not required to report personally to the Administrative Checks. Each Competitor shall nominate in advance to the Organiser one authorised representative to complete the Administrative Checks

Each competitor must report to the Administrative Checks at their individually scheduled time, which will be published in the bulletin on the DNB. A delay to the Administrative Checks of up to 30 minutes will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course with a fine 150 Euro. A delay exceeding 30 minutes will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course with a fine 500 Euro.

11. SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

11.1 Scrutineering

Place: Otrokovice (Building at the place of Service Park Exit)

Date: 13. 8. 2026 Time: 13:30 - 22:30

The time for scrutineering will be published as Bulletin on official website/DNB of the rally. Any delay or early arrival at scrutineering will be penalised by 40 € for each 5 minutes. If the delay exceeds 30 min the crew will be reported to the Stewards.

The team must bring also technical card confirmed from administrative check.

11.2 Marking and sealing

According to the FIA 2026 ERC Sporting Regulations:

- All FIA and ERC priority drivers must seal their transmissions and spares.
- All cars must have engine block marked.
- All cars equipped with turbocharger and their spares must be marked.

After pre-rally scrutineering, any change of sealed component must be notified by the competitor to the following e-mail: erc-technical@fia.com. This notification must be received prior to the change of part.

11.3 Mud Flaps

Fitting and use of mud flaps, comply with Art. 252.7.7 of FIA Appendix J, is permitted but not compulsory.

11.4 Windows / Nets

According to Appendix J Art. 253.11, the use of silvered or tinted films is authorized, on the rear side windows, on the rear window and the sunroof. Silvered or tinted films fitted on rear side windows must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle of 70 mm in diameter.

11.5 Driver's Safety Equipment

Competitors must present all the items of protective clothing, which will be used including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR system, formerly called HANS) Compliance will be checked with Appendix L Chapter III and with technical regulations. See Appendix 5 of these Supplementary regulations.

11.6 National Regulations

All vehicles must comply with art. 4.3.2 of these Supplementary Regulations

11.6.1 Outside noise level of cars

All cars must be equipped with the stable exhaust silencer. The outside noise level measured by stationary method may not exceed 96 dB/A for all cars with the margin of error plus 2 dB/A. The noise level will be measured at 3500 revs/min. in petrol engine cars and at 2500 revs/min. in diesel engine cars according to EHK Regulations 51.02.

Noise level will be measured during scrutineering and eventually at any point during the rally. Any exceeding of noise limit during scrutineering results in start refusal, any exceeding of noise limit in the course of the rally will be reported to the Stewards who may apply sanctions according to the art. 12 of the FIA International Sporting Code.

11.6.2 Catalytic converters

All vehicles must be obligatory equipped by homologated catalytic converter.

For missing, incomplete, or ineffective catalytic converters identified during scrutineering, the crew shall be refused a start. A car with a missing or incomplete catalytic converter during rally shall be reported to the Stewards, who may impose penalty in accordance with art. 12 of the FIA International Sporting Code.

11.6.3 Car lighting

In liaison road sections between special stages, it is possible to use car lighting only through the original fitted and auxiliary headlamps with EHK (“E”) homologation. Headlamps without homologation cannot be used during connection road sections. Complying with this provision will be checked by judges of fact. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may impose sanctions complying art. 12 of the FIA International Sporting Code.

11.7 Obligatory monitoring device (GPS)

11.7.1 The GPS tracking system will be rented to the competitors. Eventual destruction, non-return or damage of the unit has to be paid for by the competitor to the provider.

Competitors are required to either rent or purchase a SAS RallySafe ERC-spec fitting kit. A purchased kit can be permanently installed in the vehicle for all future events. The rental kit can be used for one single event, paid and collected at the FIA Safety Tracking Device collection on the event, and to be returned with the tracker at the completion of the event.

A LED Repeater, provided by SAS as part of the usual kit (including wiring and mounting plate), will be mandatory in all competing cars and must be installed before scrutineering in the driver’s direct line of sight, in accordance with the user guides supplied by SAS. The LED Repeater repeats key safety messages from the tracking system (e.g. Red Flag, SOS/Hazard/Road Blocked, Push-to-Pass, Flying Finish), allowing the driver to keep eyes on the road while still receiving critical information. It is also intended to attract the crew’s attention to consult the tracking screen for more detailed information. It does not replace flags, boards or marshals, but is an additional visual aid to help crews react quickly and consistently for their own safety and the safety of others.

All further details are given in Appendix 6 of the SR and will be published on www.czechrally.com

11.7.2 Each car in the rally must be equipped with the GPS monitoring unit before the scrutineering.

11.7.3 The competitors will receive the GPS parts from administrator of GPS devices together when road books are collected, and they must install them in their cars in compliance with the given installation manual before scrutineering.

11.7.4 Competition cars not equipped with the monitoring device GPS will not be allowed to start.

11.7.5 Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competition car or any device that fails to record a trace due to external interference will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

11.7.6 Dismantling of the GPS SAS monitoring system

One mechanic is allowed to help the crew with unmounting the monitoring device GPS in the area between TC 13C and Parc Fermé, or in Parc Fermé, under the supervision of a Scrutineer.

11.7.7 Operation during events on SS is described in Appendix 6 of the SR.

12.1 Start procedure and order

12.1.1 Start of the rally

12.1.2 Ceremonial start

The competing cars are summoned to enter holding area before ceremonial start not earlier than **20 minutes** before individual starting time. Crews must wear racing overalls and attend the ceremonial start with their competition cars. If any crew is unable to participate in the ceremonial start because of technical problems with their car, they will be permitted to start into the Leg 1 at TC 1 in its allocated start time on condition of notification to the Clerk of the Course and passing the obligatory re-scrutineering checks. The concerned crew must attend the ceremonial start wearing overalls at their due time anyway.

12.1.3 Start of the rally

The crews will start in reversed starting order in 1 minute interval (from the highest to the lowest starting numbers) according to the starting list posted on the DNB (First will start Czech Rally Championship, followed by ERC). Parc Fermé before the start at TC 1 will not be organised. The crews will arrive to TC 1 according to the detailed map in the road book.

Tyre marking zone will be located after TC 1.

12.1.4 Restart after retirement

Any crew which has failed to complete Leg 1 may be assumed to re-start the rally from the start of the next Leg, unless they confirm otherwise in writing to the clerk of the course. For new start the condition according to the art. 54 and 55 FIA RRSR must be followed. If the car retired due to an accident, before any repair, the vehicles may be brought directly to their service area and wait under Parc Fermé condition until the FIA Technical Delegate gives authorisation to repair it. The car must return to the overnight Parc Fermé prior to the next Leg no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start of Leg 2.

Penalties for retired Crews in Leg 1

For all crews which retire a time penalty will be applied according to the art. 54 FIA RRSR. This time penalty will be 10 minutes for every stage missed in Leg 1. This time penalty will be added to the fastest time of the car's class for each missed stage, which shall include the special stage on which the crew has retired.

Should retirement occur after the last special stage before an overnight regroup, the crew will nonetheless be deemed to have missed that last special stage.

For super special stage SSS 1 Zlín see the article 12.4.2 of SR.

12.1.5 Start of special stages

The start to all special stages except SSS 1 will be given by an electronic digital countdown system, counting down by seconds and clearly visible to the crew from the start position and electronically coupled to a start line detection device that records any situation where a car leaves the start line ahead of the correct signal. This start line detection device is 50 cm after the start line in the height of 50 (+/- 5) cm. The car must be placed in such a way that its foremost part is on the level of the start line.

Timekeeper gives the time card to the crew as late as in the minute of starting procedure.

Light signals combined with digital countdown system will be used:

Countdown:

5 seconds to GO: 1 red line above the time

4 seconds to GO: 2 red lines above the time

3 seconds to GO: 3 red lines above the time

2 seconds to GO: 4 red lines above the time

1 seconds to GO: 5 red lines above the time

0 seconds - START: all red lines above the time are replaced by one big green line

after "start": 20 seconds after start is displayed one big green line above the time



In case of electronic digital countdown system breakdown, the car will be started on the instruction given by the timekeeper

12.2 Finish procedure

The competition part of the rally ends in the Time Control at the entrance to the Parc Fermé (TC 13C). First three crews of the rally will be awarded, other prizes according to the art. 66.2 will be given on the finish ramp. After the ceremonial, crews will get the time card and they are obliged to go straight to the ParcFermé (Zlín, next to Rally HQ).

Attention: Crews that are not interested to pass the finishing ramp, obtain the winning cups and metal medals of Barum Czech Rally Zlín (all the participants of the rally obtain medal for finishing the rally), are allowed to drive from TC 13A straight to TC 13B according to the road book and then continue to TC 13C Parc Fermé.

12.3 Permitted early check-in

Early arrival without penalty is permitted only at TC TZ (Otrokovice), TC 1A (Parc FerméZlín), TC 7C (Flexi Service out), TC 7D (Parc FerméZlín), TC 13A (Street Bartošova), TC 13B (City square) and 13C (Parc Fermé).

12.4 Special stages

12.4.1 Shakedown / Free Practice / Qualifying stage (14.8.202609:00 – 14:00)

Only competitors, who passed administrative check and scrutineering, can automatically participate in Shakedown (no registration needed), Free practice and Qualifying stage. Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to their cars. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal SS.

For the shakedown only, If there is a person, by exception, not rally participant, this person must have an approval from the Clerk of the Course and this person must together with the competitor declare and sign a disclaimer of responsibility – the form will be available at the administrative check and the shakedown start. The crew whose car breaks down during the shakedown / Free Practice / QS shall nevertheless attend the ceremonial start in comply with article 12.1.2. SR

Tyre marking zone will be located between the TC QS and the Start QS.

Only tyres on rally car for Qualifying stage will be marked (spare wheel will not be marked).

Tyres for Free practice and Shakedown are not counted for the overall quantity.

Winner presentation after QS

Fastest crew will be stopped and held after the Stop line in the special dedicated area until a faster crew arrives or the QS finishes. Winner presentation will be held after QS has finished. No penalties for being late at TC TZ due to being delayed after the Stop line will be applied by the Clerk of the Course.

Priority ERC 1 drivers are allowed to participate in shakedown after QS.

12.4.2 Circuit special stages: SSS 1 - SSS Zlín (14. 8. 2026)

The crews will start in reversed starting order in 1 minute interval (from the highest to the lowest starting numbers) according to the starting list posted on the DNB (First will start Czech Rally Championship, after ERC).

The crews will arrive to the SSS starting area according to the detailed map in the road book. SSS 1 will be organized with details given in rally time schedule, in the road book and in the time card. Time results will be counted to the overall classification including eventually penalty that will be given according to regulations for special stages.

Start of the SSS 1 will be flying, it means the crew starts to the special stage on green signal light (or other wave given by the start marshal) and the exact flying starting time will be recorded by the start detection device placed 1 m after the start line. Finish photocell is placed in circuit part of SSS 1 Zlín. Exact placement described in road book.

If the start will be done in expected starting interval (approx. 1 minute), timekeeper will show a board with number 5 approx. 5 seconds before green light appears on a semaphore. In case of longer delay than

expected, timekeeper will show the board with a sign STOP and then show again the board with number 5 approx. 5 seconds before green light appears on the semaphore. Start at the red light is prohibited! Crews that will not finish SSS or retire during Section 1, crews which will do less than required number of laps or whose SSS time is worse than 12 minutes will receive an allocated SSS time of 12 minutes. The retired crews can restart into the Section 2 under the condition of Art. 12.1.4 of SR and that the car is placed to the Parc Fermé 1 hour before.

12.4.3 SS 4/7 Bunč (15. 8. 2026)

In case of surface damage on the mineral section of SS 4/7 Bunč, the surface may be mechanically repaired between passages. Crews will be informed by the CoC Communication.

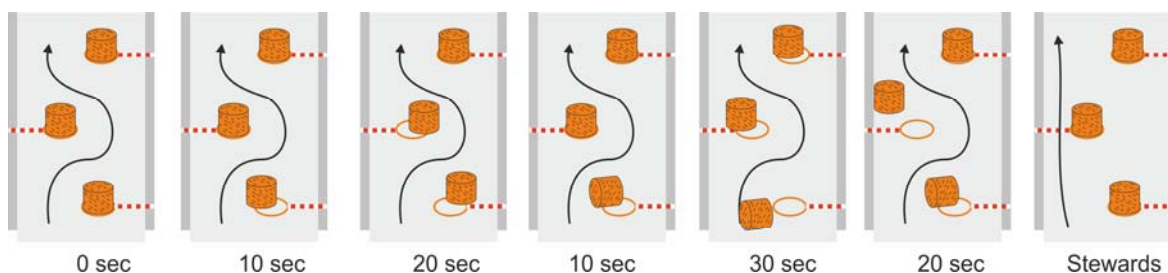
12.4.4 Chicanes

Due to safety reasons, barriers will be positioned on the rally route. The judges of fact will be appointed for each chicane to report any incorrect passing. The judges of fact will be published in a Bulletin on the Official notice board in compliance with the art. 11.16 of ISC. Chicanes will be formed with straw bales. Any incorrect passing of a chicane will be recorded by the judge of the fact on the control sheet and reported to the Clerk of the Course, who will penalize the crew.

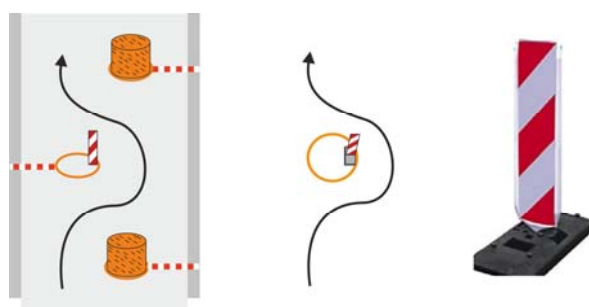
Penalties:

- overturning or moving one element of the chicane outside the base or if the car touches the straw bale so that the judge of the fact or marshal needs to touch it to get it back to position. It is incorrect passing. **10 seconds** for each
- bypassing, going around or skipping a chicane **will be reported to the Stewards**

Moving part of the chicane is understood to be the state when the bale moves from its painted base (circle). Overturning the bale is considered to be moving outside of the base.



Traffic sign "Z4" will be used as spare part of the chicane in case of destroying the strawbale.



12.5 Service Parks

12.5.1 Location and organisation of service parks

* On Wednesday, only service cars (vans and trucks) with correct sticker issued in administrative checking can enter to a part of service area (Continental Barum testing track) only for parking the truck in the designated place for the team. It is forbidden to do any work (unloading cars, building tents, work on the cars). Any infringement will be penalised by penalty 300 € by Clerk of the Course.

A limitation for servicing, refuelling and changes of mechanical parts is introduced in Art. 56 of FIA RRSR. Service parks A, B, C, D, E can be entered only with Service car (SERVICE). Auxiliary vehicles are not allowed to enter the Service Park. Further details concerning the entrance of service and auxiliary vehicles are given in the Service Road Book.

Allocation of working areas

Competitors will be allotted by the organizers their working areas inside the service park as follows:

- to each team registered in FIA ERC1 will be allotted an area of 150 m² for one car team and 200 m² for two car team or shared among its team. 50 square meters for each additional car.
- to each team registered in FIA ERC3 will be allotted an area of 100 m² for one car team and 50 square meters for each additional car.
- to each team registered in FIA ERC4 and Junior ERC will be allotted an area of 90 m² for one car team and 50 square meters for each additional car.
- to other drivers will be allotted an area of 80 m²

Additional space can be ordered for a price of 35 € per 1 m²

Connection to electricity in the service area Otrokovice can be arranged only after preliminary agreement

Driving in Service Park

During the service time between the first rally car enters and the last car leaves the service park, it is strictly forbidden for all service vehicles to enter or drive inside the service park. Every infringement will be reported to the Stewards. Service Park is one-way both for rally cars as well as the service and auxiliary vehicles. Maximum speed inside the service park is limited by 30 km/h.

12.5.2 Flexi service (Service C, 15 August 2026)

ATTENTION: The competing car may be driven by an authorised representative of the competitor from the parc fermé to the Flexi service and to the Final Parc fermé in Zlín, respecting all the formalities of time card presentation and related penalties.

For the operation of 45' flexi-servicing, crews will enter the Regroup (Parc Fermé). Crews may then either enter the service park or leave their car in the Regroup (Parc Fermé). The competing car may be driven by crew or authorised representative and only once from the Regroup (Parc Fermé) to the service park and to the Overnight Parc Fermé. The competition vehicle may leave the service park (TC7C) before the 45 minutes have elapsed and check-in early in TC7D (Overnight Parc Fermé).

All cars except re-starting cars have to be in the overnight Parc Fermé no later than at 23:00.

12.5.3 Catering in service area

If your team or any other company would like to have a catering for their guests in service area, it must be settled with organiser before starting administrative checking. In other cases organisers can forbid this catering. Exception is food-supply for crews and mechanics. Regarding the waste disposal organiser can

levy a charge for costs. Selling food and drinks in service area without permission of organisers is strictly forbidden.

12.5.4 Shows and exhibitions in service area

If any team or company would like to organise shows or exhibitions for their guests in service area, they must ask organisers for permission before administrative check. All shows and exhibitions in service area without permission of organisers are strictly forbidden.

12.6 Entrance to the regrouping area and Parc Fermé

12.6.1 Safety GPS tracking technicians are allowed to enter the regrouping area and Parc Fermé to maintain or repair the GPS tracking systems installed in the rally cars. They have to be accompanied by scrutineer and at least one representative of the team.

12.6.2 TV Crews are allowed to enter the regrouping area and Parc Fermé to maintain the camera systems installed in the rally cars or to exchange the data recording media. They have to be accompanied by scrutineer and at least one representative of the team.

12.7 Official time used during the rally

Official time throughout the rally is that of the GPS. The time zone is the Central European Summer Time (CEST) (UTC +2).

12.8. ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE SAFETY CAMERA (AISC)

In 2026 European Rally Championship season FIA will use AI Safety Cameras to improve the safety of active stage. It is mandatory to carry the camera system by the crews nominated by FIA and published by Bulletin. The teams of the nominated crews will be invited to a meeting in which the operation of the system will be explained and shown. The invitations to the meeting will be individually send to the teams. If necessary, the system can be installed during the event in any other car than originally nominated. In such case team of the crew concerned will be contacted and the function of the AISC will be introduced.

12.9. MEDIA ZONES

In each Regrouping, the Media Zone will be constructed featuring signage and clear entry and exit points for cars and access points for personnel, which will be controlled by marshals. Access will be restricted to those holding the correct pass. Only these pass holders will be given access to the Media Zone:

- ERC pass
- Barum Czech Rally Zlín Photo/TV pass
- Barum Czech Rally Zlín Media pass
- ERC Media Pass
- ERC Media Zone pass / competitor
- ERC Media Zone pass / tyre supplier

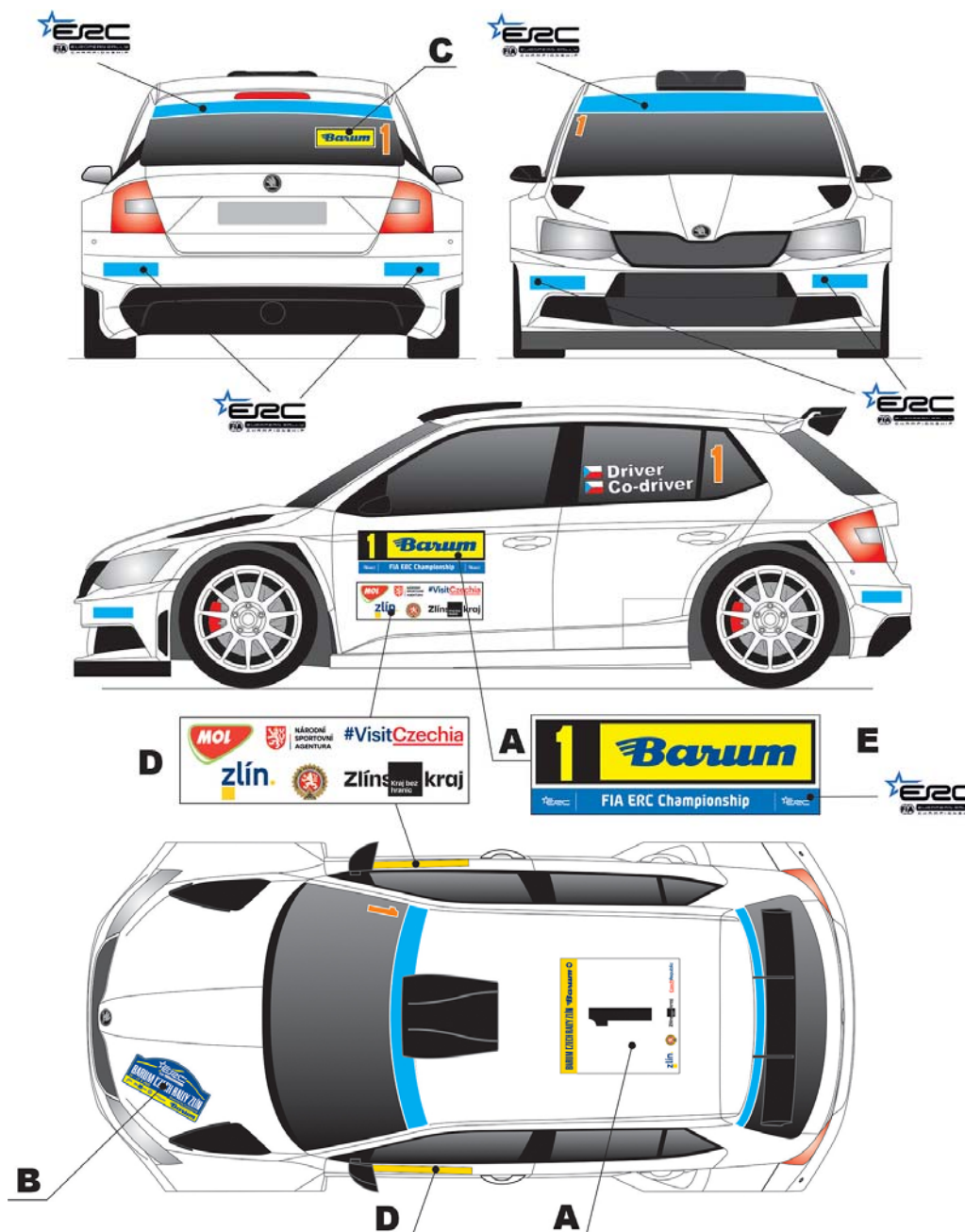

Appendix 5

Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

8859-2015	(Technical List N°49),
8859-2024 or 8859-2024-APB	(Technical List N°107),
8860-2010	(Technical List N°33), or
8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP	(Technical List N°69)

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List N° 74).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also the 2026 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.

If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

- i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,
- ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and
- iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.

Appendix 6

Monitoring GPS system SAS

All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering.

Any competitor who wishes can purchase a SAS RallySafe WRC/ERC-spec fitting kit, which can be permanently installed in the vehicle for all future events. The SAS RallySafe WRC/ERC-spec fitting comprises all necessary antennas, mounting and wiring components to be pre-installed in the vehicle, prior to the supply of the FIA Safety Tracking Device at the event. SAS RallySafe WRC-spec fitting kit can be purchased via the RallySafe shop (<https://statusas.com/wrc-kit>) and shipped to the competitor prior to the event, or collected at the event, or alternatively purchased onsite when collecting the FIA Safety Tracking Device at the event. The price of the kit is 150.00€, excluding shipping and handling fees.

Any competitor that wishes to rent a SAS RallySafe WRC-spec fitting kit, has an option to rent a kit for the single event for the cost of 50.00€, paid and collected at the FIA Safety Tracking Device collection window on the event, and to be returned with the tracker at the completion of the event.

Systems may be collected either by the crew or a representative, while collecting documents for Reconnaissance on Wednesday. No deposit will be collected for the rally safety tracking equipment, but all the damage caused will be invoiced afterwards.

Dismantling of the GPS SAS monitoring system

One mechanic is allowed to help the crew with unmounting the monitoring device GPS in the area between TC 13C and entrance to parc ferme, or in Parc Fermé, under the supervision of a Scrutineer.

The FIA Safety Emergency Console System devices must be removed in the final Parc Fermé and returned to the SAS tent in PF no later than 20:00 h on Sunday 16.8.2026 to the representative of STATUS AWARENESS SYSTEM (SAS).
