## 1.1 ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The organiser of WRC Delfi Rally Estonia 2026 promotes environmental awareness and makes every effort possible to ensure that the event causes as little ecological stress for environment as possible. In 2022, we achieved the 3-Star Level of the FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme and we are committed to maintaining this status moving forward.

WRC Delfi Rally Estonia takes responsibility about climate change and carbon footprint in our field, calculates carbon footprint and continues offsetting emissions via compensation – planting trees. Our goal is to reduce the environmental impact by monitoring performance indicators and taking remedies in the main impact areas. Partners will be involved to fulfilling our vision through procurement policy, communication and training. Relevant stakeholders have been identified and we cooperate to achieve the goal.

Regarding the FIA Environmental Programme, evaluating and reducing the environmental impact of motorsport is playing an integral role. Based on the FIA's recommendations the event organisation has improved the training of marshals, formal documentation and monitoring of the environmental performance. We have improved the monitoring of the event carbon footprint and waste management system and want to be a good example in terms of environmental issues nationally as well as internationally.

WRC Delfi Rally Estonia considers important to participate in discussions of sustainable development together with scientists, other organisations and public. For that purpose we have joined the Rohetiiger (Green Tiger) programme as a founding member. Rohetiiger is a cooperation platform with an objective to become a representative organisation in sustainable development discussions, to lay down the foundation to balanced economy and to perform a green leap in Estonian society.



Key elements for WRC Delfi Rally Estonia 2026 will be to put effort into increasing the environmental awareness not only in the members of organisation and stakeholders but also among spectators, partners and teams. Environmental issues, such as selecting eco-friendly products and local services and reducing emissions are taken into consideration and uniquely identified with each partner company.

In order to promote environmental sustainability and enhance responsibility we aim to implement the following activities and ask our partners to follow them as well:

- Promote environmental awareness in all our channels and communication.
- Comply with all relevant laws and regulations, including environmental requirements and FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme.
- Require environmental responsibility from stakeholders, cooperative partners and suppliers
- Pay close attention to cooperating with all landowners, residents and road owners.
- Set environmental objectives and targets, and measure them.
- Concentrate on energy efficient and sustainable solutions, for example using renewable energy sources when possible.
- Reduce the number of documents printed on paper, preferring digital formats and printing only the documents required by the FIA.
- Reduce carbon emissions - use hybrid or electric cars as most of the organisational vehicles, hold online meetings.
- Search for ways to optimise transportations and logistics to decrease emissions as much as possible: carpooling, public transportation.
- Make a thorough plan for emergency situations and implement it actively.

## 1.2 HISTORY OF RALLY ESTONIA

The idea to organise a new rally was born 17 years ago when Silver Kütt, a co-driver with the experience of participating in seven WRC rallies, presented his idea to his good friend, former WRC driver Urmo Aava. After sharing the idea with “marketing mastermind” Tarmo Hõbe, who named the new rally “Rally Estonia”, the first steps were taken.

The first Rally Estonia took place in 2010 and the inaugural winner of the rally was local hero Markko Märtin, who won five World Championship rallies during his WRC career. The first two-time champion of the event was Mads Østberg, the winner of the 2012 WRC Rally Portugal, who was fastest at Rally Estonia in 2011 and 2012.

The high level of competition, with drivers such as Märtin, Østberg and members of the Latvala family participating, raised the bar high for the organisers to maintain. From 2014 until 2016 Rally Estonia was part of the European Rally Championship (ERC), and in 2014 it was voted the best ERC rally of the year.

In 2019 Rally Estonia hosted the first-ever WRC Promotional Rally. In June 2020, Tarmo Hõbe received a call from WRC Promoter CEO Oliver Ciesla offering Rally Estonia the opportunity to organise the first-ever World Championship event in Estonia.

Estonia became the 33rd country in WRC history to host a WRC event. After a half-year break in the WRC calendar due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the first official WRC Rally Estonia – and the 600th event in WRC history – was held from 4–6 September 2020. The first winners of WRC Rally Estonia were the local heroes and 2019 World Champions Ott Tänak and Martin Järveoja.

On 11 January 2021 the Rally Estonia organising team won the ASAHI KASEI TEAM SPIRIT AWARD, and two days later the Rally Estonia organisers and the WRC Promoter announced that Rally Estonia would remain in the WRC calendar for 2021 and 2022. In 2020 Rally Estonia celebrated its 10th anniversary, and in 2021 Estonian auto and motorsport celebrated 100 years.

In 2021 Kalle Rovanperä and his co-driver Jonne Halttunen took the first win of their WRC career at Rally Estonia. With this achievement Rovanperä made WRC history by becoming the youngest WRC rally winner of all time at the age of 20 years and 289 days.

In 2022 Rovanperä and Halttunen repeated their success from the previous year and became double winners of WRC Rally Estonia. Meanwhile, 22-year-old Robert Virves set a new record for the most Special Stage wins in the Junior WRC category at a single rally event. The Estonian won 17 stages – one more than the previous record holder, World Champion Sébastien Ogier.

Rally Estonia 2023 was expected to be a battle of champions – Rovanperä vs Tänak. However, when the local heroes Tänak and Järveoja suffered a pre-event engine failure that resulted in a five-minute time penalty, it was Rovanperä and Halttunen who completed a hat-trick of victories in Estonia. For Hyundai Motorsport it was the third double podium in four years. While Rovanperä secured his third consecutive win overall, Andreas Mikkelsen also achieved a hat-trick of his own, remaining unbeaten in WRC2 for the third rally in a row.

In 2024 Rally Estonia welcomed FIA European Rally Championship (ERC) competitors after a seven-year break. The fourth event of the season turned into a thrilling battle between two young Estonian talents, Georg Linnamäe and Robert Virves, both chasing their first overall ERC victory.

Heading into the final stage – a 21.31 km stretch – Virves and his co-driver Craig Drew held a 9.3-second lead. However, Linnamäe and his co-driver James Morgan threw caution to the wind, pushing to the limit in slippery and wet conditions. Their incredible final-stage effort secured an 11.5-second stage win and handed them the overall victory by just 2.2 seconds.

Estonian drivers dominated the event, securing a double podium in the overall classification. The ERC3 class also saw an all-Estonian podium, led by the 2024 Junior WRC Champions Romet Jürgenson and Siim Oja. Meanwhile, in the Junior ERC category, 17-year-old Jaspar Vaher and his co-driver Sander Pruul claimed victory on home soil, winning nine out of 14 stages.

In 2025 Rally Estonia welcomed back World Rally Championship drivers, co-drivers and teams. For the first time in Rally Estonia history, the PowerStage and podium ceremony took place in Kääriku. It was a debut drive in the Toyota GR Yaris Rally1 car for Oliver Solberg and Elliott Edmondson – and what an amazing drive it was. The young Swede took the lead of the rally after stage two and never looked back, becoming the third youngest WRC event winner at the age of 23 years and 300 days.

In the WRC2 class Robert Virves and Georg Linnamäe continued the battle that had started the year before. Despite not feeling well on Friday, Virves won six stages out of seven and built a healthy lead. After four demanding days on the fast roads of Southern Estonia, it was Robert Virves and his co-driver Jakko Viilo who took the win on home soil, finishing 18.4 seconds ahead of Linnamäe and Morgan. This was the first WRC2 class victory for an Estonian crew after an 11-year break and the first ever WRC2 overall win for Virves and Viilo.

The 2024 Junior WRC Champions Romet Jürgenson and Siim Oja made their fifth start of the season and took their first ever WRC2 stage win on Stage 5. They finished the rally in fifth place.

## 5. SERVICE PARK

### 5.1. LOCATION AND SERVICE SPACE

The Service Park is located at Raadi airfield, Tartu.

GPS coordinates: N 58° 23.821 E 026° 45.110

Surface: concrete

Manufacturers and other championship competitors will be allocated a designated space in accordance with 2026 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

Other legal and private competitors will be allocated an area of 12 m x 10 m.

In agreement with the Organiser, competitors may order additional service space with the price of 25 EUR/m<sup>2</sup> + 24% VAT, in case there is still additional space available in the Service Park.

If a competitor has multiple competition cars to be located together in Service Park, the application for consecutive Service Areas must reach the Organiser by Tuesday, 16 June.

After the entry closing date, the layout of Service Park displaying service space designated to each competitor will be published on Official Notice Board.

NB! For all competitors the driving way and access to each individual service space is on the rear side of the allocated areas. The view to the service space should not be blocked to the spectators in the front side of the service space.

### 5.2. ACCESS TO SERVICE PARK

NB! Only vehicles with Team and Auxiliary plates issued by the Organiser are allowed to access the Service Park. An access map for trucks and team vehicles will be published with Rally Guide 2. The vehicles must be clearly identified by designated sticker plates affixed on the windscreen. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.

Auxiliary plates will be issued according to the entry packages.

➤ **Parking in the Service Park**

A designated parking area inside the Service Park will be set up behind the teams' service spaces, if there is space available. Only cars carrying Team and Auxiliary plates are allowed to park in this area.

➤ **Trailer Parking**

It is possible to park trailers at the end of the Service Park in the designated area.

➤ **Auxiliary Parking**

An additional parking for cars with Auxiliary and Recce plates is located near the Service Area.

## 5.4. RESTRICTIONS IN SERVICE PARK

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the concrete surface at the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and other items that need to be fastened.

Teams and competitors are responsible for the occurrence of no leakage of fuel, waste water (including water from washing car parts) and other liquids on the ground. Any detected fuel leakage may force the teams to dismantle their units and tents during the rally.

Waste will be collected from behind the service bays each night. Please leave your garbage bags at the back of your area to be removed.

## 5.6. ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- All competitors are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars.
- During the rally a car wash facility will be available near the Service Park. Washing cars within the Service Park is prohibited at any time. Spare parts must be cleaned in designated spare part washing containers.
- Before the rally the closest car wash is located at N 58° 23.940 E 026° 44.225.
- After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition.
- All waste material must be disposed of in the facilities provided at the Service Park.

- A special container for hazardous waste will be available near the Service Park.
- The waste must be sorted and placed in the designated containers. The organiser will send detailed information about this closer to the event.
- Two fire extinguishers minimum 6 kg must be present at each service zone.

- Competitors coming from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment with the purpose to participate in WRC Delfi Rally Estonia.

#### CLIMATE AND WEATHER

The weather in Estonia is largely dictated by its closeness to the Baltic Sea.

In the summer the skies are blue and temperatures can reach 30° C. The summer average is a very pleasant 16.4° C. The weather forecast in Estonia is available via [weather.ee](http://weather.ee).

#### TRAFFIC

- Estonia has right-hand traffic and an extensive road system, the quality of which varies.
- Visitors need driving license, provided it is valid for the class of vehicle they wish to drive.
- The maximum speed limit is 90 km/h, in residential areas 50km/h, unless otherwise indicated. In the summer, the speed limit is 110km/h on some highways. A driver who has exceeded the speed limit can be punished with a financial penalty, an arrest, suspension of the right to drive or vehicle confiscation.
- Estonian highways tend to be narrow, therefore it's important to pay attention to the speed limits and to pay extra attention when overtaking. Speed cameras are common in Estonia and speeding is rarely tolerated.
- The use of front and rear seat belts is compulsory.

- The blood/alcohol limit in Estonia is 0,2 milligrams of alcohol per litre of blood. Driving while under the influence of drugs and alcohol is prohibited and strict penalties are in place for anyone caught doing so.
- It is illegal for drivers to use a mobile phone without a hands-free device and holding a telephone in hand while the vehicle is moving.
- Headlights must be on at all times while driving.
- When moving on the road in poor visibility or at night-time, a pedestrian must use a reflector or a light source.

## OTHER INFORMATION

- Water: Tap water is safe for drinking.
- Power: 230 V (volts).
- Plugs and sockets are of a two-pin design.
- Smoking is not permitted by law in enclosed public places and workplaces.
