  - Production Cars are divided into the following cubic capacity classes:
  - class N1: u/i 1400 cc
  - class N2: over 1400 u/i 1600 cc
  - class N3: over 1600 u/i 2000 cc
  - class N4: over 2000 cc
- 6.2 Touring Cars (Group A) including World Rally Cars (WRC), homologation papers outdated max. 4 years: Touring Cars are divided into the following cubic capacity classes:
  - class A5: u/i 1400 cc
  - class A6: over 1400 u/i 1600 cc
  - class A7: over 1600 u/i 2000 cc
  - class A8: over 2000 cc
- 6.3 Outdated cars (Group H)

Vehicles in the national group H are admitted. This applies to cars of groups N, A and B, of which the homologation is not outdated for more then 10 years (so for 2007: homologation still valid in 1996). Cars in group B that are not homologated, only four-wheel-drive cars unto 1600 cc and two-wheel-drive cars unto 3000 cc are admitted.

Group H-cars should comply with the homologation papers valid for that type of car and to the regulations of Appendix J of the CSI, valid in the last year of homologation for that particular car, and all additions to this as published in FIA-bulletins and known per December 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. In addition to that for group H-cars only turbo-restrictors are accepted as valid in the last year of homologation.

All cars should be in good condition.

Group H cars should adhere to the actual safety prescriptions of art. 253 of Appendix J of the CSI for the relevant group.

Group H-cars are divided into the following cubic capacity classes:

- class H9: u/i 1400 cc
- class H10: over 1400 u/i 1600 cc
- class H11: over 1600 u/i 2000 cc
- class H12: over 2000 cc
- 6.4. Outdated cars (Group Y)

Vehicles with homologation outdated for more than 10 years (see appendix VI of SRR)) Group Y-cars are divided into the following cubic capacity classes:

- class YR-13: u/l 1400 cc
- class YR-14: over 1400 u/l 1600 cc
- class YR-15: over 1600 u/l 2000 cc
- class YR-16: over 2000 cc
- and also:
- class YS-17: u/l 1400 cc
- class YS-18: over 1400 u/l 1600 cc
- class YS-19: over 1600 u/l 2000 cc
- class YS-20: over 2000 cc

NOTE: All cars should have safety provisions (safety cage, seats, safety belts, fire extinguishing system) meeting FIA-specifications

### 7 ENTRY FORMS - ENTRIES

- 7.1 Closing of the entries: Friday May 19<sup>th</sup> 2007, 24.00 hrs Any holder of a valid international rally licence or EU licence wishing to take part in the 43<sup>nd</sup> Paradigit-ELE Rally must send in the entry form as follows:
  - a. complete the entry form on our website <u>www.paradigit-elerally.nl</u>
  - b. send the completed entry form via Internet
  - c. the entry form must be signed before reconnaissance on Friday June 1<sup>st</sup> 2007 Details concerning the co-driver can be sent in until the document control. The number of competitors is fixed at 90.
- 7.2 This event has been announced to the FIA and is published in the NEAFP-list. Foreign competitors with a EU-licence are admitted to the event.

#### 8 ENTRY FEES - INSURANCE

- 8.1 The entry fee with the organisers' advertising (see art. 10.4): € 600,-Foreign entrants € 300,-
- 8.2 The entry fees without the organisers' advertising:  $\in$  850,-

- two rally-info books
- one service pack holding:
  - one rally-plate "service",
    - including one entry permit for one service car into the central service area
    - one service space, size 50 m<sup>2</sup>, on the central service area
    - two rally-info books
    - roadbook service

Additional items:

- extra service space (50 m<sup>2</sup>) € 100,-
- extra service pack € 75,-

the extra service pack holding:

- admittance of 1 extra service vehicle in the service area
- roadbook service
- one rally plate "service"
- 8.4 Entry fees will be refunded:
  - In full if the entry has not been accepted
  - In all other cases the organising committee will decide refunds.
- 8.5 In the individual entry fee the premium for the insurance of liability of competitors and drivers is included. Summary:
  - The organiser has taken measures for insurance of the entrant and drivers for damages against third parties when driving the special stages of the rally.
  - The indemnity provided under this special insurance is maximum € 2.500.000,- covering any incident or occurrence.
    - The own-risk is € 1000,- per incident or occurrence.
- 8.6 Before the start of the event the entrant and both members of the team are obliged to sign a form to safeguard the organiser and KNAF for liability of damages caused by the entrant and/or both members of the team.

#### 9 ADVERTISING

9.1 The obligatory organisers' advertising on the rally plates and door panels will be: PARADIGIT computers

- 9.2 The extra organisers' advertisings are:
  - METAFA
  - FREIJA
  - HELICHEM
  - BO-RENT

The extra advertising is to be fixed on the white square on both front doors.

9.3 In case of violation of the prescriptions or missing of any part of the obligatory or extra advertising the competitor will not be allowed to start. In case of missing any part of the advertising during the event, the competitor will have to pay a fine of € 50.00.

### 10 HELMETS AND OUTFIT

The crash helmets and clothing are to be examined at the technical scrutineering. *NOTE: Personal equipment (clothing, underwear, helmets) should meet FIA-specifications.* 

### 11 RALLYPLATES AND DOORNUMBERS

- 11.1 The organiser will supply every competitor with 2 rally plates.
- 11.2 The organiser will supply every competitor with 2 competition numbers and 3 window plates with competition numbers.

If at any time during the event it is noticed that:

- one door number or rally plate is missing, a cash penalty of € 50.00 will be imposed.

- both door numbers and rally plates are missing at the same time will result in exclusion of the event. All competing cars must be equipped with a horizontal white square on each front door of the following dimensions: 50 x 52 cm as background for the organisers' advertising.

### 12 RECONNAISSANCE

- 12.1 The organiser offers the opportunity to competitors to recce the Special Stages on:
- Friday June 1<sup>st</sup> and Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> 2007, according to a time table which is to be announced in a Bulletin.
  12.2 Except above mentioned dates and timeframes it is not allowed to drive (with whatever vehicle) on roads that will be used as Special Stage. The organiser will supervise these roads extensively.

12.3 During reconnaissance, competitors have to strictly adhere to the traffic rules.

#### The organiser will use speed traps. Reconnaissance is only allowed using a standard car that, in every aspect, satisfies the Dutch Traffic

Reconnaissance is only allowed using a standard car that, in every aspect, satisfies the Dutch Traffic Rules. This car may not be equipped with safety cage or bar.

# \*During reconnaissance opposite driving on the special stages is not allowed and will be punished with a cash penalty of $\in$ 50,-

- 12.4 Infringement of the above mentioned rules will be penalised as follows:
  - 1<sup>št</sup> infringement: 2 minutes time penalty (competition time)
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> infringement: not allowed to the start, respectively exclusion. In this case the entry fee will not be refunded.

The decision of the organising committee or the Clerk of the Course will be decisive.

Such decision can be taken independently of the fact whether or not sanctions are laid upon by police or officials and independent of the result of such action. No right exists on lodging a protest or appeal against such decision and the entry fee will not be refunded.

12.5 The organising committee will not supply pace notes of the Special Stages.

### 13 FUEL

Fuel must comply to the FIA specifications, as described in Annexe J of the International Sporting Code, in this case the maximum content of lead for leaded fuel in the Netherlands is not to exceed 0,15 gr/l.

### 14. SCRUTINEERING BEFORE THE START

Any team taking part in the event must report at scrutineering at Speelhuisplein 2, Helmond with its full team, car, helmets and fireproof clothing including underwear, on Friday June 1<sup>st</sup> 2007, according to a time table which is to be announced in a Bulletin later.

### 15 START

- 15.1 During the entire rally the time of KPN Telecom (0900-8002) will be valid as the official rally time.
- 15.2 The cars admitted to the start will be started every minute from 12.01 hrs on Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup> 2007, on the starting ramp.
- 15.3 Before the start, the organiser will assemble all cars which are admitted to the start, in a parc fermé under the following conditions :

- parc fermé is located near Speelhuisplein, Helmond.

- parc fermé opens on Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup> 2007 at 10.00 hrs.
- the car must be in the waiting park ultimately 60 minutes before the starting time of the competitor.
- a representative of the competitor may collect the car after the rally.

#### 16 **DEVIATING REGULATIONS**

- 16.1 During reconnaissance opposite driving at the special stages is not allowed and will be punished with a cash penalty of € 50,- Addition of SRR article 14.
- 16.2 An absolute maximum driving speed of 20 km/h is valid at the central service areas Helmond and Best. Infringement will be penalised with exclusion. Addition of SRR article 12.2.
- 16.3 In case of dispute concerning the interpretation of the present regulations, only the Dutch text will be binding. According to SRR article 3.3.4.

#### 16.4 Traffic rules

On public roads, throughout the entire event, the team must strictly obey the Dutch traffic laws. Any team not complying with these traffic laws shall be subject to the penalty laid out below:

- 1<sup>st</sup> infringement: a cash penalty of maximum € 250.-, at speed infringements. The organising committee will always apply the maximum cash penalty.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> infringement: a time penalty of 5 minutes;

- 3<sup>rd</sup> infringement: exclusion from the event

According to SRR article 11.1 u/l 11.3.

Note: In case of infringement of traffic rules during reconnaissance penalties will be given as mentioned in these supplementary regulations art. 12.4.
