8.1 General conditions

Fuel shall comply with the provisions of Article 9 of Appendix J, Article 252 of the FIA International Sporting Code. The maximum content of lead permitted in Malaysia is 0.013g/litre for retail petrol with no maximum for AVGAS.

8.2 FIA fuel

The use of FIA fuel is permitted but will not be made available by the Organiser.

8.3 AVGAS

Application will be made to the FIA for the use of AVGAS.

8.4 Distribution during the rally

During the event, refuelling may be carried out only in the refuel zones designated by the organisers in the road book.

The organiser will establish remote refuelling zones. Such zones and the cars authorised to use them will be duly specified in the road book and marked in accordance with Article 12.6 of the 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions8.1

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Procedure for registration

Before starting reconnaissance, all crews must supply the Organisers with full details of the reconnaissance car. Each crew will then be issued with two vehicle identification cards, which must be displayed on the front windscreen in the top corner on the co-drivers side, and on the co-driver's rear side window during reconnaissance, Reconnaissance Card and Reconnaissance Instructions. The card must be shown to and endorsed by an official at the start of each stage during reconnaissance.

9.2 Schedule

Reconnaissance details will be published in Rally Guide 2.

9.3 Specific restrictions

- 9.3.1 For all competitors reconnaissance will be carried out fully in accordance with the FIA 2007 Rally General Prescriptions with a maximum of 2 passes over each stage in accordance with the Reconnaissance Schedule given in Article 9.2.
- 9.3.2 Reconnaissance outside the schedule is **PROHIBITED**.
- 9.3.3 Reconnaissance will be conducted in convoy strictly in accordance with the published schedule. No late entry into a stage for reconnaissance will be permitted. During special stages crews must remain within the convoy.
- 9.3.4 A speed limit of 80km/h will be in force during reconnaissance of special stages. Failure to comply may result in a penalty to be applied by the Stewards.
- 9.3.5 Crews are only permitted to enter a special stage from the start point shown in the Road Book and may not under any circumstance drive in a direction opposite to that of the rally unless instructed by an official of the event.

19. PROTESTS

19.1 Protest Fees

All protests must be lodged in accordance with the stipulations of the Code.

All protests must be lodged in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course together with the sum of RM2,000.00, which shall not be returned if the protest is judged unfounded.

If the protest requires the dismantling and the reassembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit:

- 19.1.1 For a protest involving a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.) RM1,500.00
- 19.1.2 For a protest involving the whole car RM4,000.00. The expenses incurred for the work and transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.
- 19.1.3 If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned to them.

19.2 Appeals

APPENDIX 1 - ACCIDENT & SAFETY PROCEDURE

- 1. All competitors must be fully conversant with FIA Rally General Prescriptions Article 19.19 (competitor safety) and Appendix IV Article 3.4 Road Book.
- 2. When a Red **S.O.S.** is displayed it is <u>MANDATORY</u> to stop and assist the crew requiring help. You are responsible to help the injured and make sure that safety services are mobilized as quickly as possible.
- 3. The first crew to arrive at the scene of an accident must stop and inform the next car of all the details.
- 4. The next car must take the following information to the NEXT radio post which may be the finish control:
 - Competition number of the crew involved
 - If any crew member or spectator are trapped in or outside the car
 - Location of the accident, i.e. the closest road book junction or kilometre post
 - Any other vital information, i.e. fire, water.
- 5. The following cars must stop if the Red **S.O.S.** is displayed.
- 6. All competitors stopped in a stage must place their Red Triangle at least 50m before where the car is stopped even if the car is clear of the road.
- 7. The event **emergency** telephone number is +6012 30 949 01
- 8. If you retire, you must inform the organisers at +6012 21 232 60 (Mr. Jagjeet Singh CRO 1)
- 9. All competitors retiring from the event are obliged to hand in their time card to the nearest control point as soon as possible.


