2.3 Brief event history

Since its beginnings in 1906, the Reial Automòbil Club de Catalunya (RACC) has been behind the organisation of the best car and motorcycle events in the country.

In 1916, the RACC promoted the first Volta Catalunya, the forerunner of the Rally Catalunya, which would appear in 1957.

In 1965, and for nine years, it was replaced by the Rally Barcelona-Andorra.

In 1988 the two most important rallies in the country which score for the European Championship, the Rally Catalunya and the Rally Costa Brava, came together with a view to becoming a rally that would score for the World Championship.

Finally, in 1991, the FIA included the Rally Catalunya-Costa Brava in the World Championship Calendar.

The high organisation and sports level the event has achieved is reflected by the two prizes obtained in 1996 and 1997, when it was elected the Best Rally of the Year by the World Rally Team Association (WRTA), and was also considered the Best Event of the World Championship by the World Rally Press Association (WRPA) in 1997.

In 2005 the rally changes its nerve centre and moves to the Costa Daurada. Stages already used in previous editions of the rally are recovered from the years when one leg of the rally was staged on the roads of Tarragona. Salou and PortAventura will host the HQ and the Rally Service Park.

Five months later, in march 2006, the rally was celebrated again, moved from October to March.

Do to FIA calendar reasons, edition 2007 moves again to Autumn.

4. ENTRY DETAILS

- Closing date for entries: **Thursday 30th August 2007, at 14.00hrs**

Details concerning the co-driver must be lodged prior to *Friday, 7th September 2007*.

- The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:
 - The total entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority
 - Photocopies of the competitor and drivers licences as well as photocopies of the drivers' passport or Identity card
 - One passport photo for each member of the crew
 - Photocopy of the page of the car homologation form for the entered car where are indicated number, group and cylinder

For foreign competitors, the entry form must be stamped by the competitors' National Sporting Authority (International Sporting Code Art. 17 and 70), or enclose an authorisation letter from their National Sporting Authority giving permission to participate in the 43 RallyRACC Catalunya-COSTA DAURADA 2007.

If the entry form application is sent by fax, the original must reach the Organiser at the latest one week after the close of entries.

4.1 Titles for which the rally counts

- 2007 FIA World Rally Championship for Drivers and Co-drivers
- 2007 FIA World Rally Championship for Manufacturers
- 2007 FIA Junior Rally Championship for Drivers

The rally also counts for the 2007 Fiesta Sporting Trophy

4.2 Criteria for acceptance of entries

The maximum number of starters will be **90 cars**.

The Organisers selection will be the following:

- 1/ FIA first priority drivers
- 2/ FIA second priority drivers
- 3/ FIA third priority drivers (Drivers entering FIA Junior Championship)
- 4/ Drivers entered by an official team or make
- 5/ R.F.E. de A. (Spanish Federation) priority drivers
- 6/ Drivers entering 2007 Fiesta Sporting Trophy

No entry can be guaranteed before the entries closing date. Organisers will inform the crews which entry form has been not accepted after this date.

4.3 Eligible cars

All vehicles must comply with the provisions of Appendix J.

4.8 Auxiliary Plates

Other team vehicles must be identified by means of “Auxiliary” plates, which allow to access to the Auxiliary parks adjacent to service parks.

Auxiliary plates must be affixed on the top of the front windscreen.

5. SERVICE PARK - PortAventura

5.1 Location

As in 2006 edition, the large asphalted car park area of the PortAventura Theme Park has been chosen to host the Rally Service Park. It is located only 1.60 km from Salou.

This park will be the only service park used during the rally

Location coordinates (service park heliport) N 41° 05.548'
E 001° 09.881'

WRC manufacturers and teams, and the Junior WRC participants will have the space recommended by the FIA. The rest of the competitors will have an area of 10mx10m.

5.2 Access to the Service Park

WRC Manufacturers service vehicles will be allowed to enter the Service park area **from Sunday 30 September, 08.00 hrs.**

Other teams will be able to access to the Service Park **from 08.00 hrs. on Monday 1st October 2007.**

Should any team need to access the park before this date or should they arrive at night, when the normal access is closed, please contact the Service Park Responsible, Arturo Fernández de la Puente, by e-mail: servicepark@racc.es or calling +34 690 607 544.

From Sunday 30 September to Sunday 7th October the park will have a security service. Surveillance will be at night from Sunday 30th September to Wednesday 3rd October. From Thursday 4th October there will be night and day surveillance service. Teams needing exclusive security service for their service area must request it. (Please use the Service park facilities form available in internet).

Only duly accredited vehicles with the plates provided by the organisation will be allowed to access the Service Park and corresponding vehicle parking areas.

- **SERVICE** plates: access to the team's service area
- **AUXILIARY MANUFACTURER** plates: with these plates every manufacturer will be able to access a vehicle parking area located behind their service area.
- **AUXILIARY** plates: access to the vehicle parking area located a few metres from the service area.
- **VIP, ORGANISATION and MEDIA** plates: access to the vehicle parking area located a few metres from the service area.

The plates will be provided during the administrative checks, according to Art. 4.5 of Rally Guide 1.

Service vehicles arriving at the Service Park on Sunday 30th September or Monday 1st October in the morning, i.e. before the teams have been at the administrative checks to get the corresponding documents and necessary vehicle plates, will be able to access the Park without a plate. However, from Wednesday 3rd October at 12.00 a.m. **all vehicles** will have to be duly fitted with the corresponding plates. From that moment on there will be an exhaustive control in order to guarantee that all vehicles parked or trying to access the Service Park carry the necessary plate.

5.3 Available services

- The following services will be supplied on different locations within the park:
 - General lighting in the whole Service Park
 - Chemical toilets for public use
 - Waste containers
 - Used oil tanks
 - General security in the whole Service Park

- The following additional services may be provided to the teams at their service area on request. The cost of these services will be informed on reservation. Teams requiring these services are requested to complete the Service park facilities form. The form is available on the rally website www.rallyracc.com
 - Chemical toilet for the team's private use
 - Water
 - Power
 - Motorhome chemical toilet cleaning
 - Drums and emptying of motorhome liquid waste
 - Exclusive security service for the team
 - Fork-lift truck
 - Mobile office
 - Scooter hiring

Service park Facilities form must be received before 6th September 2007

5.4 Space requests

Teams that, due to reasons of logistics, need to be close together or have any special request must send their requests per e-mail to servicepark@racc.es. The Organiser will make all reasonable efforts in order to satisfy the needs of all teams. The request must be received by **15th July 2007**. No further changes will be accepted after this date, once the layout of the Service Park has been declared as definitive.

5.5 Telephone lines request

Requests for telephone lines to be used in the Media Centre at HQ, Manufacturers press room and Service park can be made through your respective PTT, or directly to RACC.

PTT

In case that you make the request to your PTT, check with them the deadline to ensure that the request from your PTT to Telefónica arrives on time. Neither Telefónica nor RACC can guarantee your lines during RallyRACC if your request comes through your PTT. Please check with them the minimum deadline to guarantee your lines in Salou.

RACC / Telefónica

You can send your request of lines directly to RallyRACC. RACC will send your request directly to Telefónica S.A. This special agreement between Telefónica and RACC can ensure that all requests received by RACC before 3rd September will be guaranteed.

Should you decide to contract your lines through RACC, please send us the application form before 3rd September 2007.

- 3 different reconnaissance stickers will be distributed to the Teams, in order to specify the SS to begin the recee each day. Drivers will be divided in 3 groups:
 - Yellow sticker: FIA priority 1 & 2
 - Red sticker: FIA priority 3
 - Blue sticker: Non seeded drivers
- Reconnaissance cars have to be covered by insurance as required by the law, no responsibility being imputable to the Organisers.
- Crews are authorised to **drive a maximum of 2 times** through each special stage, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the Road Traffic Laws in Spain. **In no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction to the race on the special stages.**
- The presence of a driver and/or his co-driver on a special stage, in any way whatsoever, is considered as reconnaissance.
- Organisers will supply at the rally office a reconnaissance vehicle **identification sticker and a time card** valid for up to 2 passages over each special stage.
- Reconnaissances sticker must be affixed during reconnaissances on the **top right of the front windscreen.**
- Rally Officials will supervise special Stages and competitors must follow their instructions.
- During reconnaissances crews must stop at the start of each stage, which will be duly signposted. Rally Officials will stamp the reconnaissances time card in order to record every run on each special stage.
- Drivers nominated by FIA will be required to carry a GPS tracker unit in their cars. Details of the fitting location for these devices as well as the locations where the data will be downloaded each evening will be included on a bulletin.

7. SHAKEDOWN
