3. **Entries**

3.1 **Entry procedure**

Those wishing to take part in the 26th Rally Costa Smeralda Sardegna must send the entry form duly completed to the Rally Office (address details in Article 2.4) before the closing of entries, Friday 28th September 2007.

Co-driver details must reach the organiser no later than Wednesday 3rd October 2007.

The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by total amount of the entry fee. If the entry form is sent by fax or by e-mail, the original entry form must reach the organiser not later than one week after the date of entries closing, i.e. on Wednesday 3rd October 2007.

Foreign drivers must hold an authorisation from their ASN or obtain its stamp on the entry form.

3.2 Number of entrants accepted and classes

- 3.2.1 The maximum number of entrants will be 130 divided into:
 - FIA-priority A drivers
 - FIA-priority B drivers
 - ASN-priority drivers
 - non-priority drivers

3.2.2 The classes of cars will be divided as follows:

Production cars (Group N)

- Class NO up to and including 1150cc
- Class **N1** 1151cc up to and including 1400cc
- Class N2 1401cc up to and including 1600cc
- Class **N3** 1601cc up to and including 2000cc
- Class N4 2001cc, including Super 2000 cars

Touring cars (Group A) (World Rally Cars are not authorised)

- Class A0 up to and including 1150cc
- Class A5 1151cc up to and including 1400cc
- 1401cc up to and including 1600cc including Super 1600 cars
- 1601cc up to and including 2000cc

Cars homologated as Kit cars, where the capacity is greater than 1600cc are not accepted. Cars homologated as Kit cars, where the capacity is between 1400 and 1600cc may be

accepted if they comply with Article 255-6.2 of Appendix J. Two-wheel drive cars equipped with a supercharged diesel engine with a nominal cylinder

capacity less than 2000cc are accepted in Groups N and A. For Super 1600 homologated cars, it will be possible to use lapsed "errata" without any penalty.

- **3.3.3** The above sums are doubled if the optional advertising proposed by the organisers is refused.

3.4 Payment

3.4.2 Entry fees cover the following:

- 1 Service (Assistenza) plate (2 plates for legal entrants)
- 1 Road Book
- 1 Information (Service) Book
- participation in the shakedown
- **3.4.3** Requests for extra material (Auxiliary plates, Road Book or Information Book) must reach the organiser before Tuesday 9th October 2007.

3.5 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- should the rally not take place

Organiser may refund 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" duly certified by their ASN, are unable to start in the rally.

This must be applied for in writing containing reasons for claim and bank account details.

4. Insurance

- **4.1** The entry fees include the insurance premium to insure civil liability of competitors against all party risks whilst taking part in the rally and in the shakedown.
- **4.2** The indemnity provided under this special insurance is \in 3.000.000,00, unique for any incident or accident.
- **4.3** This cover will become effective at the start of the rally (T.C. 0). It will cease at the end of the event or at the moment of retirement, exclusion or disqualification. In case of retirement, the cease hour will be considered as being the one of the next time control closing.

- **4.4** Crews participating in the shakedown will be insured under the same policy (including all the itineraries concerning the shakedown as reported in the Information Book, with no limitation of number of passages, with covering from 12.00 am to 5.00 pm on Thursday 11 October 2007).
- 4.5 The organisers decline liability for any accident caused to competitors and competing cars during the whole duration of the event, even in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism etc. Competitors and crew members will have to suffer all consequences (damages, fines and penalties) created by any accident. Organisers also decline any liability for breach of the national laws and regulations.
- 4.6 Vehicles carrying Service and Auxiliary plates and/or any other special plate issued by the organiser are not covered by the event's insurance policy. These vehicles circulate under the sole responsibility of their owners and the organiser bears no responsibility for them.
- 4.7 Vehicles used by competitors during reconnaissance, even if bearing the event's specific sticker, should be insured by their owners. The organiser bears no responsibility for such vehicles.
- **4.8** Crews participating in the rally must have a valid insurance covering them for personal injuries (personal accident insurance including death and disablement).

4.9 Accident reporting

If a driver taking part in the rally is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver concerned must report this to the next radio point as specified in the Road Book and signposted on the route. If he fails to comply with this rule, the Stewards may impose to the responsible crew a penalty which may go as far as exclusion.

4.10 In case of accident in the rally or in the shakedown itinerary, the competitor or his representative must notify it to the Clerk of the course within 24 hours.

5.1 Organisers' advertising

The organisers' advertising on the rally plate and on the door competition numbers is:

5.3 Restrictions

Tobacco and smokers products advertising is forbidden.

5.4 Identification numbers, plates and advertising

The plates of competition numbers, the front official rally plate with starting number, the rear window plate and the optional advertising must be affixed on the rally car (details can be found in Appendix 3) before it is brought to scrutineering and must be visible throughout the whole duration of the rally, according to chapter IX of the 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions.

6. Tyres

6.1 Tyres changes

The changes of the tyres is authorised in all Service Parks of the rally.

6.2 Tyres marking

The marking of the tyres is compulsory for all competitors for the whole running of the rally, following the rules of 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions.

7. Fuel supply and fuel dispense

7.1 Fuel supply

- Throughout the 26° Rally Costa Smeralda (shakedown and competition), all cars shall use solely 7.1.1 fuel supplied by the Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A., which meets the technical requirements fixed by FIA-Appendix J, and by CSAI.
- 7.1.2 Each Competitor must fill in the special order form requesting the quantity of fuel needed for the running of the rally and send it to Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. - Via Pasubio, 30 -36051 Creazzo (VI) tel. +39.0444.232300 - fax +39.0444.232323 - www.wladoil.com. The reservations and acknowledgments of receipt of payment must reach Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. no later than Friday 5^{th} October 2007 at 18.00. In case of failure to collect the fuel, Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. will refund the corresponding amount within 15 days following the date of the running of the rally.

Fuel dispense

- 7.2 7.2.1 The Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. - on Thursday 11 October 2007 from 11.00 am to 03.00 pm - will dispense the fuel needed for the shakedown (in 25-litre cans) at the refuelling area located in the scrutineering of the cars area -Molo Vecchio/Porto Cervo . Afterwards, for the whole competition the fuel will be dispensed exclusively and directly into the tank of the competition cars, inside the refuelling area provided for by the organisers as described in the
- 7.2.2 In order to optimise refuelling operations, during the pre-rally scrutineering a sticker 6 cm in diameter, green for the competitors using Wladogas98Rally03 and yellow for those using Wladogas102Rally03, shall be affixed to the left upper side of the windscreen of the competition
- 7.2.3 Within the refuelling area, competitors must observe the regulations provided for in the 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions and comply with the instructions given by the marshals in charge and by the staff involved in the refuelling operations.

7.3

In case of fuel sampling from the competition cars and subsequent testing, the readings will be compared with those of the fuel samples drawn from the Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. tank lorry from which the cars have been refuelled.

7.4 **Fuel autonomy**

All cars must have a minimum fuel autonomy enabling them to drive at least 130,16 kms, 41,53 kms of which in special stage (1st leg) and 150,40 kms, 33,54 kms of which in special stages (2nd leg).

8. Reconnaissance

8.1 **Running conditions**

Rally course and special stage reconnaissance will be allowed in compliance with the national Road Regulations and only after receiving the Road Book, the reconnaissance card and slips, the

- The reconnaissance card must be in possession of the drivers during the reconnaissance and 8.1.1 must be shown whenever requested by the staff in charge of the controls and by the Police
- 8.1.2 The $\mathbb R$ sticker must be apposed on the upper left part of the windscreen, driver's side.

8.1.3 As these are not to be considered tests but reconnaissance during which the Road Regulations must be observed, reconnaissance cars must have insurance coverage as prescribed by the law. By no means the organisers shall be held responsible if anything should occur.

8.2 Reconnaissance schedule

Reconnaissance can be performed on the following days:

 9^{th} October 2007 special stages of 1^{st} leg from 9.00a.m. to 6.00 p.m. 10^{th} October 2007 special stages of 2^{nd} leg from 9.00a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

8.3 Restrictions

- 8.3.1 A maximum of **3 runs** is allowed for each special stage. By no means the special stages shall be driven in the opposite direction of the prescribed one.
- 8.3.2 Performing reconnaissance out of the schedule will be considered a serious infraction subject to penalty at the Stewards discretion.

8.4 Reconnaissance cars

Route reconnaissance may be performed only with production cars complying with the characteristics as per the General Prescriptions applicable to FIA Rally Championships. CSAI licensed drivers shall use cars conforming to the NS 11 CSAI Prescriptions.

8.5 Controls

8.5.1 The rally Marshals will provide for the control of the special stage course and the competitors will be required to follow their instructions.

Controls will be carried out even before the period scheduled for reconnaissance.

The presence of a driver or co-driver along a special stage is considered, in all circumstances and with any means of transport, a reconnaissance.

8.5.2 During reconnaissance crews are required to stop at the start of each special stage; the rally Marshals in charge will print the reconnaissance sheet in order to check the passage of cars along the special stages.

8.6 Penalties

Any ascertained infringement will be posted on the Official Notice Board and submitted to the Stewards of the meeting during their first meeting for judgement and possible sanction.

Moreover, the Stewards shall also consider enforcing the supplementary penalties prescribed by Article 152 of the International Sporting Code and, according to the degree of the infringement, they shall report the defaulting competitors to the ASN and to the FIA for possible further penalisation.

In all cases, the organiser must communicate to the ASN the names of drivers and/or of codrivers who have committed an infringement, in order to allow the identification of the offenders.

9. Administrative checks

9.1 Documents to be presented

- **9.1.1** The following documents will be checked at administrative checks:
 - competitor / entrant licence
 - driver and co-driver competition licences
 - driver and co-driver driving licences
 - driver and co-driver medical certificates of aptitude
 - authorisation for the drivers by their ASN to take part in the rally, if required
 - rally car registration papers
- information given on the entry form
- **9.1.2** Each crew member must send in advance or hand-in one identity photo.

10. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

10.1 Special regulations

10.1.1 Noise level

The maximum permitted noise level is **98 decibel**. Cars not complying with this rule will not be allowed to start. The noise will be measured with a sonometer placed at a distance of 50 cm. from the exhaust outlet, with an angle of 45 degrees and with the car engine running at 3.800 rpm.

10.1.2 <u>Components sealing - Non-priority drivers</u>

During scrutineering the transmission (fitted and spares) of non-priority drivers' cars will not be sealed, however their turbos (fitted and spares) will be sealed.

For limitation of spare turbochargers see 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions.

10.1.3 Windows

Use of tinted windows is authorised in accordance with Article 253.11 "Windows/nets" of Appendix J of the FIA Sporting Code.

11. Features of the Rally

11.1 Start park

Not foreseen.

11.2 Time card change during the rally

The time card for section 1 will be issued at TC 0 and will be replaced by a new one at:

11.3 Special Stages

11.3.1 Starting procedure

The start of all special stages will be given by means of starting lights:

RED: stand still

- YELLOW: ready to start (- 5")

- GREEN: GO!

Should the electronic timing appliances break down at the start of a special stage, times will be recorded manually as provided by the 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions.

11.3.2 False starts

A false start, made before the start signal has been given, is penalised as follows:

- 1st offence: **10"** - 2nd offence: **1'** - 3rd offence: **3'**

further offences: at the Stewards discretion

These penalties do not prevent the Stewards from imposing heavier penalties if they judge it necessary.

11.3.3 Timing

For special stages, timing will be completed to the tenth of a second.

Should the electronic timing appliances break down at the end of a special stage, times will be recorded manually, as provided by the 2007 FIA Rally General Prescriptions.

11/12/13 October 2007

11.4 Early check-in at the end of a leg

Following the administrative authorities' orders, early check-in at time controls is not allowed.

11.5 Identification of officials

The road officials will be identified by the following distinctive wear:

post chief: red tabard
road marshal: yellow tabard
safety marshal: green tabard

11.6 Violations of traffic laws

For the entire rally, drivers must comply with the traffic Laws.

Drivers failing to do so will be penalised as follows:

a) 1st infringement: cash penalty of € 250,00

b) 2nd infringement: 5' penalty

c) 3rd infringement: at the Stewards discretion

11.7 Parc fermé for each leg

The parc fermé at the end of leg 1 will be placed in Porto Cervo – Molo Vecchio.

11.8 Finish of the rally and the final parc fermé

The finish of the rally will be at TC 13C and the final parc fermé will be placed in Porto Cervo – Molo Vecchio.

11.9 Removal of the cars from the final parc fermé

Cars must be removed from the final parc fermé (Saturday 13 October 2007), once the results become final and the Stewards authorise it to be opened.

Cars must be removed 30 minutes after the official results posting at the latest, after this deadline the organiser will not look after the cars

11.10 Super rally

- **11.10.1** Every crew should not end Leg 1 of the Rally shall be admitted to Leg 2 with their own car.
- **11.10.2** This resolution shall apply to each crew that may be excluded due to overcoming of the maximum time or to crew unable to pass a time control post. It does not apply to any crews excluded due to car not in conformity, or due to traffic rules infringement or as per the Stewards decision.
- **11.10.3** Any car that cannot end a Leg due to the above mentioned cases, may be repaired. Anyway, the car shall be brought to the Night Park Fermé held before start of Leg 2, at least 6 hours before the start of the Leg. The competitor involved, by the means of written communication, must inform the Race Control about its decision to start Leg 2, before the Steward Meeting scheduled at the end of Leg 1
- **11.10.4** The cars must carry the same body and engine block singed at the pre rally scrutineerings.
- **11.10.5** Before starting Leg 2, that car must be verified by the Scrutineers. Such a check shall be carried out 1 hour before the starting of Leg 2, within Park Fermé.
- **11.10.6** The starting order of Leg 2 shall follow the determined order of the Unofficial Partial Classification , set at the end on Leg 1.
- **11.10.7** The Stewards may re-position, at their discretion, those competitors applying the Super rally formula.
- **11.10.8** Score (to be applied exclusively for the Europe Rally FIA Cup and not for the Italian Rally Championship)
 - **a)** The scores provided by art. 14 of the Europe Rally Cup FIA 2007 regulations will be forwarded to the classification of the drivers and co-drivers championship. All crews taking the new start with the Super Rally formula, will not be present in the Final General Classification of the Rally
 - **b)** A score bonus in the championship classification will be attributed as a result of every Leg classification, as follows: 3 scores, 2 scores, 1 scores awarded to the First, second

and Third classified, of the overall classification of every leg, included the Super Rally participants.

c) In order to receive the bonus for the Leg scores, the car must be in the Park Fermé for the Finish untill the Official Final Classification posting.

12. Gravel cars

Gravel cars are forbidden in the FIA European Regional Cups Rally events.




