Except for the final one, the Parc Fermé for all days will be located adjacent to the Service Park Area, at the Rugby field – Av. Arturo U. Illia between Gob. Garzon and Medrano streets.



## 3. ENTRIES

#### 3.1 Entry procedure

Anybody wishing to take part in Rally Argentina 2008 must send the duly completed entry form

(Including co-driver details) to Rally Argentina Secretariat (address details in Art. 2.4) no later than Thursday, February 21, 2008.

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship should make their entries by using the standard entry form submitted by the FIA.

Competitors registered in the Production Car World Rally Championship should make their entries by using the standard PWRC entry form.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority.

If the entry form is sent by fax or e-mail, the original much reach the Organisers no later than Thursday, February 28, 2008.

#### 3.2 Number of entrants accepted and classes

The maximum number of entrants accepted in Rally Argentina 2008 is 80, divided into 4 groups: Priority 1, Priority 2, Priority 3 and Non-priority. If more than 80 entries are received the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted. The classes will be divided as follows:

#### **Production Cars - Group N (Including Super 2000 cars)**

Cylinder capacity classes:

N1 - up to and including 1400 cc.

N2 - over 1400 cc up to and including 1600 cc.

N3 - over 1600 cc up to and including 2000 cc.

N4 - over 2000 cc

#### **Touring Cars - Group A (including World Rally Cars)**

Cylinder capacity classes:

A5 - up to and including 1400 cc.

A6 - over 1400 cc up to and including 1600 cc

A7 - over 1600 cc up to and including 2000 cc

A8 - over 2000 cc.

#### 3.5 Refunds

The organisers may refund up to 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), were unable to start the rally.

## 4. INSURANCE

#### 4.1 Description of insurance cover

Entry fees include the insurance premium which covers the following:

- Fire: of cars participating, their accessories and spare parts, as well as explosion, malevolence, vandalism, tumult and terrorist acts, while parked in the different parc fermés, according to the vehicle and following an amount scale to be determined.
- Damages: of participant cars that according to the event's regulations are circumstantially at the service, refuelling, regrouping and scrutineering areas.



- Civil liability: For third party bodily injuries, death and damages and/or third party property damages caused by the sporting event during the running of the Special and Super Special Stages, up to an amount of U\$D 200,000 per incident, in force from 27 to 30 March, 2008.
- The Organising Committee declines any liability concerning the consequences caused by the violation of laws, rules or ordinances committed by competitors, remaining those consequences under the sole responsibility of those who committed the action.
- 5. The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates with the identification of ASSISTANCE issued by the organiser, may never be considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

The same is valid for the cars used by competitors during reconnaissance, even bearing a serial number or an event specific sticker.

## 5. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

#### 5.1 Rally Plates and competition numbers

See Appendix 4 below.

#### 5.2 Organisers' advertising

The organisers' advertising will be described in a Bulletin.

Competition numbers, rally plates and advertising must be fixed to the car before scrutineering.

## 6. TYRES

### 6.1 Tyres

All competitors must comply with the requirements of FIA Appendix J and WRC Art 18 and Appendix V.

Competitors are reminded that according to WRC Art 18.1:

Pirelli has been nominated by the FIA as the single tyre supplier to distribute the tyres for the rallies in the Championship. All drivers entering a 4WD car must use the tyres specified by the FIA.

## 7. FUEL

#### 7.1 Order Procedure

#### 7.1.1 FIA fuel

FIA fuel, as provided by the FIA appointed supplier, must be used by all Priority drivers.

No later than 5 weeks prior to the shakedown, competitors must notify their fuel requirements to the supplier, Shell Global Solutions:

#### 7.1.2 Non FIA refuel

Non-priority drivers, not using FIA fuel, may not use their own refuel systems.

As there is no appropriate fuel in roadside pumps all along the route, they must use the fuel provided by the organizers, which must be requested and paid for at administrative checks.

#### 7.2 Distribution during the Rally

There will be a refuelling area adjacent to the Service Park - Avenida Presidente Arturo U. Illia (ex Av. Atlántica) and Gobernador Álvarez (between Gob. Peña and Gob. Ferreira), Villa Carlos Paz - every day.

There will also be remote refuelling points per day as follows:

Day 1: La Cumbre

Day 2: Santa Rosa de Calamuchita

Day 3: La Posta

The refuelling areas will be indicated in the Road Book.

## 8. RECONNAISSANCE

#### 8.1 Registration procedure

Prior to commencement of reconnaissance all competitors should register in order to obtain reconnaissance passes. Competitors will not be allowed to access a special stage open for reconnaissance unless these vehicle passes are displayed.

If a driver wishes to take part in the reconnaissance only, as preparation for future participations in the event, they must contact Rally Argentina Secretariat for registration.

**Entry fee for Reconnaissance only is:** € 1,500.-



#### 8.9 Schedule

See Appendix 2.

#### 8.3 Restrictions

Provision is made for a maximum of two passages through each special stage during reconnaissance for all crews entered.

Throughout reconnaissance, the speed limit will be of 90 Km/h in the special stages, unless the traffic signs, the road book or bulletins indicate a lower speed limit.

Competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages.

Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in the special stage.

#### 8.4 Fitment of speed control checking devices

The collection of speed control checking devices will take place at the Rally HQ. For details, see Article 1.

## 9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

#### 9.1 Documents to be presented

The following will be checked at the administrative checks:

- Driver's and co-driver's competition license
- Driver's and co-driver's road license
- Entrant's license
- Authorization from the driver's ASN to take part in Rally Argentina
- Information given on the entry form
- Insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car
- Documents and registration papers for the rally car

## 10. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

#### 10.1 Schedule

See schedule in Article 1.

#### 10.2 Tinted windows

The use of tinted windows, according to Appendix J, Art 253 Art 11, is authorized.

#### 10.3 Mud flaps

With reference to of Appendix J, Art 252, Art 7.7, Mud Flaps are authorized in Rally Argentina 2008.

#### **10.4 Tracking Units**

The compulsory FIA safety rally tracking systems will be issued from ISC-T office – see time and address in Art 1 above. Competitors will be asked to leave a deposit



by means of a credit card imprint.

These units must be installed before the cars are presented for scrutineering.

Should a competitor retire, they must return the tracking unit and associated cables to ISC-T office in Rally HQ as soon as possible.

The tracking units may have to be removed from the rally cars at the final Parc Fermé, therefore cars should be left unlocked.

#### 10.5 Preparation of engines for engine block sealing

One hole drilled on the engine block to fit a wire, a plate and a seal, at a visible position to be seen when opening the bonnet (except for P1 drivers).

## 11. FEATURES OF THE RALLY

#### 11.1 Ceremonial Start Procedure

The ceremonial start is compulsory for all competing cars and crews and will take place in the city centre of Córdoba on Thursday March 27, 2008 from 20:30hrs.

There will be a starting park previous to the ramp, opened from 19:00hrs. All rally cars must enter this area at least 45minutes before their start time. Late arrival at the start ramp, after a competitor's due time will be penalised as follows:

**Up to 15 minutes** € 500

**Over 15 minutes** Notification to the Stewards

Should a crew in its competing car be unable to participate, WRC Art 13.1 will apply. Crew members must wear approved overalls and be present with the car in the starting park at least 30 minutes before their start time.

No time cards will be issued.

P1 crews will start in the reverse order of the start list for day 1. All other crews will start in the order of the start list for day 1.

All crews will start at 1 minute intervals.

A layout will be published in Rally Guide 2.

#### 11.2 Time-card change during the rally

New time cards for competitors re-entering in Days 2 and/or 3 will be issued at the start TC of Days 2 and/or 3. (Parc Fermé Out, Carlos Paz)

#### 11.3 Starting system for special stages

The start light equipment will be placed on a side of the road, between 2 and 5 metres ahead of the starting line.

A yellow light will illuminate 30 seconds before the start time.

Five (5) red lights, illuminated in sequence, will count down the last 5 seconds before the start.

Competitors must start as soon as all the lights on the panel are extinguished.

Should the above mentioned starting light panel fail to function; the start will be given as specified in Art 19.5 of the FIA General Prescriptions.

Jump starts will be detected by a photocell trap, placed just ahead of the starting line. See Appendix 5 below.

#### 11.4 Early check-in at the end of a day

Early check-in is allowed in TC9C of the first day. Early check-in is allowed in TC18C of the second day.

#### 11.5 Identification of officials

#### 11.6 Super Special Stages

11.6.1 Procedure for Super Special Stage 21 Camping General San Martín TBA in a Bulletin.

#### 11.7 Finish procedure

The finish of the rally will be at TC21C, located at Carlos Paz on Sunday March 30, 2008.

After the running of the last Special Stage of the Rally, SS 21, all crews, with the exception of those classified 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the final classification— see unofficial podium below — will proceed directly to TC21A. After Service Park G, crews will enter a holding area were they must follow the instructions of the marshals who will reorder them for the finish ceremony.

Access to the holding area between TC21C and the podium will be limited to officials and to media representatives holding the appropriate pass.

The proceedings will be in accordance with World Rally Championship Regulations Appendix  ${\bf 1}.$ 



After the podium finish, competitors must drive their cars to Parc Fermé which is located next to the Service Park or to Final Scrutineering in convoy.

The car may be driven by a team representative.

A Parc Fermé pass will be issued to all cars when they enter it. Once results are made final the Stewards will authorize the opening of Parc Fermé. The car may then be removed by the driver or team representative who must produce the Parc Fermé pass.

#### **Unofficial Podium**

For the purposes of live TV, there will be an unofficial podium for the top three crews at the end of SSS21 (the last special stage of the rally).

Marshals will stop competitors classified 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the final classification of the rally on the road section after the Stop control of the stage for a maximum of 15 minutes, so that they can take part in the ceremony and media interviews. The crews concerned will be informed at the Stop control of the stage.

Following the unofficial podium ceremony, the crews concerned will continue to TC21A. This procedure has been taken into account when calculating the time allowed for the road section to TC21A.

## 12. PRIZES

#### 12.1 Prizes

The first five places of the overall classification and the first three of each class will be given a trophy.

#### List of cups

Prizes (1 trophy per crew member) will be awarded according the following list:

**Overall Classification:** 1st to 5th overall

**Manufacturer:** Winning manufacturer

**PWRC Competitors:** 1st to 3rd

Classifications per class: 1st to 3rd

## 13. FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

#### 13.1. Final Checks

The final scrutineering will take place in Villa Carlos Paz.

Cars subject to final scrutineering (at Stewards' discretion) must have one representative of the entrant as well as mechanics (in case of dismantling) present at the final check.



#### 13.2 Protest fees

Protest fee set by the ASN: € 1,000.-

If the protest requires the dismantling and the reassembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit:

a) For a protest involving a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.)

**Sum of:** € 600.-

- b) The expenses incurred by the work and by the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.
- c) If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned to them.

#### **13.3** Appeal fees

13.3.1 National appeal fee (ASN) € 1,500.-

13.3.2 International appeal fee (FIA): € 6,000.-




