- 6.3 Public Liability cover is R10 000 000.00 with an excess of R5 000.00 payable by the Entrant. Cover applies only while on the event as per the MSA policy. Competitors enter and compete at their own risk. The organising club and officials decline liability in any incident / accident caused by or to competitors and their vehicles during the whole event. Entrants and competitors will have no claim against the organisers or landowners arising out of the act or default of or by them, their servants or officials before, during or after the rally.

Servicing of competing cars may only be carried out by service vehicles displaying service decals as well as the number of their competing vehicle on the RIGHT FRONT DOOR of the service vehicle and only in the service parks or service areas designated in the road book. Refer SSR 193.12.

- 14.7 IMPOSSIBLE TIMES: The Clerk of the Course may at his sole discretion adjust any Special Stage time that is deemed to be impossible. The offending crew will be accorded a time 10 seconds per kilometre or part thereof slower than the fastest car in the same class.
- 14.8 Competitors are reminded that **ALL Service Crew Members** must **SIGN** the event register at administrative checks.
- 14.9 Entrants/Competitors/Service crews are reminded to read and implement MSA ENVIRONMENTAL CODE as laid down in the MSA Handbook – pages 150 to 174.
