3. Entries

3.1 Entry procedure

Those wishing to take part in the 42° Rally del Salento must send the entry form duly completed to the Rally Organiser (address details in Article 2.4) before the closing of entries, Saturday 24 May 2008.

Co-driver details must reach the organiser no later than Wednesday 28 May 2008.

The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by total amount of the entry fee. If the entry form is sent by fax or by e-mail, the original entry form must reach the organiser not later than one week after the date of entries closing, i.e. on Wednesday 28 May 2008.

Foreign drivers must hold an authorisation from their A.S.N. or obtain its stamp on the entry form.

3.2 Number of entrants accepted and classes

- **3.2.1** The maximum number of entrants will be 130 divided into:
 - F.I.A.-priority A drivers
 - F.I.A.-priority B drivers
 - A.S.N.-priority drivers
 - non-priority drivers

3.2.2 The classes of cars will be divided as follows:

Production cars (Group N)

- Class NO up to and including 1.150cc
- Class N1 over 1.150cc up to and including 1.400cc, including R1A cars

- Class **N2** over 1.400cc up to and including 1.600cc, including **R1B** cars
- Class **N3** over 1.600cc up to and including 2.000cc
- Class **N4** over 2.000cc, including **\$2000** cars

Touring cars (Group A) (World Rally Cars are not authorised)

- Class AO up to and including 1.150cc
- Class A5 over 1.150cc up to and including 1.400cc
- Class A6 over 1.400cc up to and including 1.600cc, including S1.600 and R2B cars
- Class A7 over 1.600cc up to and including 2.000cc, including R2C, R3C, R3T and R3D cars

3.2.2.1 Kit cars

Cars homologated as Kit cars, where the capacity is greater than 1.600cc are not accepted.

Cars homologated as Kit cars, where the capacity is between 1.400 and 1.600cc may be accepted if they comply with Article 255-6.2 of Appendix J.

3.2.2.2 Turbodiesel cars

Two-wheel drive cars equipped with a supercharged diesel engine with a nominal cylinder capacity less than 2.000cc are accepted in Groups N and A.

3.2.2.3 S1600 cars

For S1.600 homologated cars, it will be possible to use lapsed "errata" without any penalty.

3.2.2.4 Group R cars

Categories in conformity with Article 260 and 260D of the Appendix J to the 2008 International Sporting Code, divided as follows:

- R1A up to and including 1.400cc
- R1B over 1.400cc up to and including 1.600cc
 R2B over 1.400cc up to and including 1.600cc
 R2C-R3C over 1.600cc up to and including 2.000cc
- R2C- R3C over 1.600cc up to and including 2.000cc
 R3T up to and including 1.600cc, supercharged
- R3D over 2.000cc, supercharged diesel

3.3 Entry fees

- <u>Private entrant</u>: a member of the crew, holding a personal entrant licence, who enter his own car and competes under his/her own name.
- <u>Legal entrant</u>:
 - an A.S.N., a Company, a Team or a Sporting Association holding a legal entrant's licence that enters one or more cars;
 - a person, holding a personal entrant licence and who is not a member of the crew, that enters one car.
- 3.3.3 The Entrant of a Crew "Under 23" whose members (driver and co-driver) are both born after 1 January 1985 will benefit of a 50% reduction on the amount of the entry fee. That reduction will not be applied for the amount mentioned at the following point.

3.3.4 Whether a Competitor does not accept the optional advertising proposed by the Organizer, he will have to pay an amount **increased of 50%** as to the related ones.

3.4 Payment

3.5 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted;
- in the case of the Rally not taking place.

Organiser may refund 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" duly certified by their A.S.N., are unable to start in the Rally.

This must be applied for in writing containing reasons for claim and bank account details.

4. Insurance

- 4.1 The entry fees include the insurance premium to insure civil liability of competitors against all third party risks whilst taking part in the Rally and in the Shakedown.
- 4.2 The indemnity provided under this special insurance is € 6.000.000,00, unique for any incident or accident.
- 4.3 This cover will become effective at the start of the Rally (T.C. 0). It will cease at the end of the event or at the moment of retirement, exclusion or disqualification. In case of retirement, the cease hour will be considered as being the one of the next Time Control closing.
- 4.4 Crews participating in the Shakedown will be insured under the same policy (including all the itineraries concerning the Shakedown, as reported in the Rally Guide, with no limitation of number of passages) with covering from 09.30 to 15.30 on Thursday 5 June 2008.
- 4.5 The Organiser decline liability for any accident caused to competitors and competing cars during the whole duration of the event, even in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism etc. Competitors and crew members will have to suffer all consequences (damages, fines and penalties) created by any accident.
- 4.6 Vehicles carrying Service (Assistenza) and Auxiliary plates and/or any other special plate issued by the Organiser are not covered by the event's insurance policy. These vehicles circulate under the sole responsibility of their owners and the Organiser bears no responsibility for them.

4.7 Vehicles used by the competitors during reconnaissance, even if bearing the event's specific sticker, should be insured by their owners. The Organiser bears no responsibility for such vehicles.

4.8 Accident reporting

If a driver taking part in the Rally is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver concerned must report this to the next radio point as specified in the Road Book and signposted on the route.

4.9 In case of accident in the Rally or in the Shakedown itinerary, the competitor or his representative must notify immediately it to the Clerk of the course.

5. Advertising and Identification

5.1 Advertising restrictions

Tobacco and smokers products advertising, is forbidden.

5.2 Organisers' advertising

Such advertising is compulsory and can not be refused by the competitors.

5.3 Organisers' optional advertising

Competitors who accept the Organisers' optional advertising must reserve the following spaces for it (see E of Appendix 3):

5.4 Identification numbers and plates

The plates of competition numbers, the front official Rally plate with starting number, the rear window plate and the optional advertising must be affixed on the rally car (details can be found in Appendix 3) before it is brought to scrutineering and must be visible through the whole duration of the Rally.

6. Tyres - Wheels

6.1 The inside of the tyre (the space between the rim and the internal part of the tyre) must be filled only with air. In other words, the use of any device allowing the tyres to maintain their performance at an internal pressure equal to or less than the atmospheric pressure is prohibited.

6.2 Tyres marking

The marking of the tyres is compulsory for all competitors for the whole running of the rally, following the rules of 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions.

6.3 Tyres changes

The changes of the tyres is authorised in all Service Parks of the Rally.

6.4 Spare wheels

All cars may carry a maximum of two spare wheels.

7. Fuel supply and fuel dispense

7.1 Fuel supply for cars feeded with petrol

- 7.1.1 Throughout the 42° Rally del Salento (Shakedown and competition), all cars feeded with petrol shall use solely fuel supplied by the Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A., which meets the technical requirements fixed by the F.I.A. and by the C.S.A.I.
- 7.1.2 Two types of fuel are available: Wladogas98Rally08 for vehicles of classes N0 N1 N2 N3 sold at the price of € 2,676/litre, and Wladogas102Rally08 for vehicles of classes N4 A0 A5 A6 A7 sold at the price of € 3,576/litre.
 Competitors with vehicles of classes N0 N1 N2 N3 can also use Wladogas 102Rally08 fuel.

Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. will supply the fuel needed for the technical adjustments of the engine, against payment and upon request.

7.1.3 Each Competitor must fill in the special order form requesting the quantity of fuel needed for the running of the Rally and send it to Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. - Via Pasubio, 30 - 36051 Creazzo (VI) tel. +39.0444.232300 - fax +39.0444.232323 - www.wladoil.com.

The reservations and acknowledgments of receipt of payment must reach Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. no later than Wednesday 28 May 2008 at 18.00.

In case of failure to collect the fuel, Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. will refund the corresponding amount within 15 days following the date of the running of the Rally.

7.2 Fuel dispense

- 7.2.1 The Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. on Thursday, 5 June 2008 from 09.30 to 15.00 will dispense the fuel needed for the Shakedown, the Section 1 (Sectors 1 and 2) and the Sectors 3 and 4 (in 25-litre cans) at the Refuelling Zone of the Service Park Centro Sportivo La Conca *Muro Leccese*Afterwards, for the whole competition the fuel will be dispensed exclusively and directly into the tank of the competition cars inside the Refuelling Zones provided for by the Organisers, as described in the Road Book.
- 7.2.2 In order to optimise refuelling operations, during the pre-rally scrutineering a sticker 6 cm in diameter, green for the competitors using Wladogas98Rally08 and yellow for those using Wladogas102Rally08, shall be affixed on the right upper side of the windscreen of the competition cars.
- 7.2.3 Within the Refuelling Zone, drivers must observe the regulations provided for in the 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions and comply with the instructions given by the Marshals in charge and by the staff involved in the refuelling operations.

7.3 Fuel testing

In case of fuel sampling from the competition cars and subsequent testing, the readings will be compared with those of the fuel samples drawn from the Company SOLDA' Vladimiro S.p.A. tank lorry from which the cars have been refuelled.

7.4 Fuel autonomy

All cars must have a minimum fuel autonomy enabling them to drive at least 151,82 kms, 52,52 kms of which in Special Stages.

7.5 Fuel supply for cars feeded with Diesel oil

All cars feeded with Diesel oil may be refuelled, by the crew, by the entrant or by its representatives, solely inside the Refuelling Zones and/or at the filling stations as described in the Road Book.

8. Reconnaissance

8.1 Running conditions

Rally course and Special Stage reconnaissance will be allowed in compliance with the national Road Regulations and only after receiving the Road Book, the reconnaissance card and slips, the R sticker.

- **8.1.1** The reconnaissance card must be in possession of the drivers during the reconnaissance and must be shown whenever requested by the staff in charge of the controls and by the Police Authorities.
- **8.1.2** The \mathbb{R} sticker must be apposed on the upper left part of the windscreen, driver's side.
- 8.1.3 As these are not to be considered tests but reconnaissance during which the Road Regulations must be observed, reconnaissance cars must have insurance coverage as prescribed by the law. By no means the Organisers shall be held responsible if anything should occur.

8.2 Reconnaissance schedule

Reconnaissance of Special Stages can be performed on the following days:

- Tuesday 3 June 2008 from 9.00 to 19.00: S.S. 12•15, 13•16 and 14•17

- Wednesday 4 June 2008 from 9.00 to 19.00: S.S. 2•5•8, 3•6•9 and 4•7•10

Wednesday 4 June 2008 from 19.00 to 21.00: S.S. 1 and 11

8.3 Restrictions

- **8.3.1** A maximum of **3 runs** is allowed for each Special Stage. By no means the Special Stages shall be driven in the opposite direction of the prescribed one.
- **8.3.2** Performing reconnaissance out of the schedule will be considered a serious infraction subject to penalty at the Stewards discretion.

8.4 Reconnaissance cars

Route reconnaissance may be performed only with production cars complying with the characteristics as per the General Prescriptions applicable to 2008 F.I.A. Rally Championships.

C.S.A.I. and F.A.M.S. licensed drivers shall use cars conforming to the N.S. 11 C.S.A.I. prescriptions.

8.5 Controls

8.5.1 Marshals will provide for the control of the Special Stage course and the competitors will be required to follow their instructions.
Controls will be carried out even before the period scheduled for reconnaissance.

The presence of a driver or co-driver along a Special Stage is considered, in all circumstances and with any means of transport, a reconnaissance.

8.5.2 During reconnaissance crews are required to stop at the start of each Special Stage; Marshals in charge will print the reconnaissance sheet in order to check the passage of cars along the Special Stages.

8.6 Penalties

Any ascertained infringement will be posted on the Official Notice Board and submitted to the Stewards of the meeting during their first meeting for judgement and possible sanction.

Moreover, the Stewards shall also consider enforcing the supplementary penalties prescribed by Article 152 of the International Sporting Code and, according to the degree of the infringement, they shall report the defaulting competitors to F.A.M.S. and to F.I.A. for possible further penalisation.

In all cases, the Organiser must communicate to F.A.M.S. and to C.S.A.I. the names of drivers and/or of co-drivers who have committed an infringement.

9. Administrative checks

9.1 Documents to be presented

- 9.1.1 The following documents will be checked at pre-administrative or at administrative checks:
 - Competitor / entrant licence
 - Driver and co-driver competition licences
 - Driver and co-driver driving licences
 - Driver and co-driver medical certificates of aptitude
 - Authorisation for the drivers by their A.S.N. to take part in the rally, if required
 - Rally car registration papers
 - Information given on the entry form
- **9.1.2** Each crew member must send in advance or hand-in one identity photo.

10. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

10.1 Special regulations

10.1.1 Noise level

The maximum permitted noise level is **98 decibel**. Cars not complying with this rule will not be allowed to start. The noise will be measured with a sonometer placed at a distance of 50 cm. from the exhaust outlet, with an angle of 45 degrees and with the car engine running at 3.800 rpm.

10.1.2 <u>Components sealing - Non-priority drivers</u>

During scrutineering the transmission (fitted and spares) of non-priority drivers' cars will not be sealed, however their turbos (fitted and spares) will be sealed.

For limitation of spare turbochargers see 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions.

10.1.3 <u>Windows</u>

Use of tinted windows is authorised in accordance with Article 253.11 "Windows/nets" of Appendix J of the F.I.A. Sporting Code.

10.1.4 <u>Cutters</u>

All competing cars must be equipped with two belt cutters, easily accessible for the Driver and Co-driver when seated with their harnesses fastened, as prescribed in Article 252.6.1 of Appendix J of the F.I.A. Sporting Code.

11. Features of the Rally

11.1 Start Park

Start Park is not foreseen.

11.2 Starting order - Intervals

- 11.2.1 The start of Section 1 will be given in the reverse order of the competition numbers, i.e. from the highest competition number to the lowest; F.I.A. seeded A and B drivers will start at two minutes intervals, all other drivers at one minute.
- **11.2.2** The starting order of Section 7 will be given with intervals fixed by the Clerk of the course, according with the Stewards, in order to allow the accomplishment of the Ceremonial arrival and of the Prize-giving.

11.3 Special Stages

11.3.1 Starting procedure

The start of all Special Stages will be given by means of starting lights:

- RED: stand still

YELLOW: ready to start (- 5")

- GREEN: GO!

Should the electronic countdown system break down at the start of a Special Stage, start will be handed as provided by the 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions..

11.3.2 Jump Start

Jump starts will be recorded by electronic timing devices placed 80cmtrs. in front of the starting line.

11.3.3 Record of time

For Special Stages, timing will be completed to the tenth of a second.

Should the electronic timing appliances break down at the end of a Special Stage, times will be recorded manually, as provided by the 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions.

11.4 Early check-in at the end of a Day

Following the Italian Administrative Authorities' instructions, early check-in at Time Controls is not allowed.

11.5 Identification of Officials

The Road Officials will be identified by the following distinctive wear:

red tabard: Post Chief
 yellow tabard: Road Marshal
 orange tabard: Safety Marshal

11.6 Violations of traffic laws

For the entire Rally, drivers must comply with the traffic Laws.

Drivers failing to do so will be penalised as follows:

a) 1st infringement: cash penalty of € **500,00**

b) 2nd infringement: 5' penalty c) 3rd infringement: exclusion

11.7 Super Special Stage 1 "La Conca"

11.7.1 Description of the Stage

The Stage, whose itinerary is described in the Road Book, will be run on a specially set-out itinerary made up of:

- an itinerary of Km. 1,19 to be repeated 3 times
- an itinerary of **Km. 1,09** represented by the first part of the above described itinerary

for a total length of Kms. 4,66

Non observance of the course described and of the white track lines will result in a penalty which can go as far as exclusion, at the Stewards of the Meeting's discretion.

11.7.2 Running of the Stage - Record of time:

- each crew will receive their Time card at the pre-start place exactly to the minute, with the entered start time for Sector 2. Then the crew will proceed slowly to the start position, where the Starter will give the START signal for the Stage, if no other competitors are on the course near the start line;
- b. at the end of the scheduled course, the crew shall drive up to the stage fly Finish and reach the next STOP Control;
- c. the time of the Stage will be obtained by recording by means of electronic devices - the starting time taken at the Start line and the transit time taken at the fly Finish line:
- all crews managing to reach an actual timing higher than the best stage time plus 3 minutes shall be assigned a best Stage time, plus 3 minutes;
- all crews not running, for whatsoever reason, the number of laps prescribed shall be assigned a Stage time, as provided above;
- f. all crews running one or more laps than those prescribed shall be assigned a stage time and/or a penalty which will go as far as exclusion, at the Stewards discretion.

11.7.3 Flag signalling in the Stage

- Yellow flags shall be used, according to the provisions indicated in Appendix H of the International Sporting Code.
- Should a yellow flag be displayed, the competitors must reduce their speed.
 Should a crew be penalised by a yellow flag signal, the Clerk of the course will suggest the Stewards that a given time should be assigned.
- In any case, those crews partly or fully responsible for causing the yellow flag signal cannot benefit from that stated in the previous paragraph.

11.7.4 Stage Control Signs

- The standard signs will be displayed at T.C. 1, at the Start and at the Finish of the Special Stage and at the STOP Control.
- No End of Control zone sign after the Special Stage Start and Pre-end of Special Stage sign will be displayed.

11.7.5 Interruption of the Stage:

- should the Stage, for whatever reason, be interrupted, the competitors stopped along the course shall be assigned a best Stage time, plus 3 minutes;
- b. a car which is not able to finish the Stage due to an accident or mechanical failure will be transported by the Organiser to their working area at the Service Park A, following the T.C. 1C Centro Sportivo La Conca *Muro Leccese* without running the Sectors 1, 2, 3 and 4. The crew will be considered to have checked in time at T.C. 1A, 1B and 1C.
- should the Stage be definitively interrupted, 2008 F.I.A. Rally General Prescriptions will be applied.

11.7.6 Reparation and prosecution of the Rally for cars which did not terminate the Stage

All cars unable to finish Stage 1 and transported by the Organisation means to the Service Park described in article 11.7.5b will be admitted to be repaired - inside their working area - during Service A.

11.8 SPECIAL STAGE 11 "La Conca"

11.8.1 Description

The S.S. 11 "La Conca", whose itinerary is described in the Road Book, will be run on a specially set out track course including:

- an itinerary of Km 1,19 to be repeated 3 times
- an itinerary of Km 1.09 represented by the first part of the above described itinerary,

for a total length of Km 4.66.

Non observance of the course described and of the white track lines will result in a penalty which can go as far as exclusion, at the Stewards of the Meeting's discretion.

11.8.2 Running of Stage

- a) Each crew shall be given a Time Card showing the starting time, this time being the Sector 22 starting time, on the pre-start line, at its whole minute. The crew shall then proceed slowly to the Start line, where a Marshal, without other Competitors passing on the track near the start line, shall give the actual Start to allow the crew to run the Stage.
- b) At the end of the course scheduled, the crew shall drive up to the Stage end-post and reach the next STOP Control.
- c) the time of the Stage will be obtained by recording by means of electronic devices - the starting time taken at the Start line and the transit time taken at the fly Finish line.

11.8.3 Flag signalling used during the Stage

Yellow signalling flags shall be used, according to the provisions indicated in Appendix H of the International Sporting Code.

11.8.4 Interruption of the Stage

Should the Stages be definitively interrupted, the FIA Rally 2008 General Prescriptions will apply.

11.8.5 Stage Control Signs

- the standard signs will be displayed at T.C. 11, at the Start of the S.S. and at the STOP Control:
- No End of Control zone sign after the Special Stage Start and Pre-end of Special Stage sign will be displayed.

11.9 Overnight Parc Fermé Section 1 to Section 2 and Day 1 to Day 2

The Parc Fermé will be placed at Lungomare degli Eroi - Otranto

11.10 Finish of the Rally and the final Parc Fermé

Last Time Control of the Rally (T.C. 17D) will be placed at Porta Terra - *Otranto*; the final Parc Fermè will be placed at Lungomare degli Eroi - *Otranto*

11.11 Removal of the cars from the final Parc Fermé

Cars must be removed from the final Parc Fermé, Saturday 7 June 2008, once the results become final and the Stewards authorise it to be opened.

Drivers or their representative must present the receipt, issued by the Organisers, to the Marshal in charge. This receipt will be distributed to the competitors when entering the final Parc Fermé.

Cars must be removed 30 minutes after the official results posting at the latest, after this deadline the Organiser will not look after the cars.

12. Gravel cars

Gravel cars are forbidden in the F.I.A. European Rally Championship Regional Cups events.

- 14.2 Competitors who will be selected for final scrutineering (Stewards' decision) are requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and technicians at the final scrutineering venue.

- Each selected car will be driven to and from the final scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the finish), accompanied by a Scrutineer.
- 14.4 In case of a protest, the car will be checked at the same workshop.





 - drivers seeded by their A.S.N. list 2, not included the 2008 Italian Championship provisional Classification;
 - d) drivers, not included in priority list, with cars \$2000;
 - e) all the other drivers in the following class order: S1600 – N4 - R3C - R3T - A7 - R3D - R2C - R2B - N3 - A6 - A5 -N2 - A0 -N1 - R1B - R1A - N0.

All drivers seeded by their A.S.N. will lose their right of priority should they drive cars of the classes: N0- R1A - R1B - N1 - N2 - A0 - A5- A6. They are excluded by the present disposition the conductors that participate within the class A6 with cars S1600.

Appendix 5

Shakedown

1 Entered competitors and running conditions

- 1.1 All entered competitors are entitled to take part in the Shakedown, under the observance of the timetable scheduled and with no limit in the number of runs.
- 1.2 The participation in the Shakedown is mandatory for all seeded drivers or for all drivers entered in the Italian and/or European Rally Championship.

1 Service Park - Servicing

2 Access times to Service Park for service vehicles

- Thursday 5 June 2008 from 8.00 to 17.00.

Any delay in the time of access will be penalised at the Stewards of the Meeting's discretion.

3 Features

3.1 Competitors will be allotted by the Organisers servicing areas inside the Park.

No later than Friday 30 May 2008 the competitors must inform the Organisers:

- should they need further space in addition to the surface allocated to every competitor according to N.S. 11 C.S.A.I. - Article 12.4;
- of any possible association, with regard to service vehicles, with other competitors.
- 3.2 During all Service Parks, from the entrance of the first competing car till the exit of the last one, the circulation in both direction of any vehicle (Service or Auxiliary) of all entrants is forbidden for any mean.
- **3.3** Further specific regulations as regards the functioning of the Service Park may be specified in the Rally Guide or issued by a Bulletin.
