III DESCRIPTION

Art. 3. Course of the competition

Total distance of the course is about 310 km. There are 8 special stages and their total distance is about 90.3 km.

Reconnaissance is allowed on all special stages according to art. 13.6. Permission to start will not be granted to competitor if competitor or other team member is found on the roads that are in the area where the competition is held before their start time. The forbidden roads are the roads that are marked yellow, grey, black or are unmarked in Finnish roadmaps in area of Mäntsälä, Askola, Pukkila and Myrskylä. A competitor found in breach of this rule will also be reported to his/her ASN for further actions.

Art. 4. Eligible cars

4.1. Only vehicles accepted in Finland for competing may be used in the competition. These vehicles have to be homologated before the date of scrutineering. These cars also have to meet the requirements set at appendix J:

A, N, Super 2000-Rally, F, F2, V1600

4.2. Studded tyres are forbidden.

IV GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

Art. 13. Traffic and service

13.2. Service areas

There is one service park in the event. **Servicing the rally car is allowed only in this area.** Areas where servicing is prohibited, are marked in the road book and route map.

Refuelling is allowed only in areas marked in the road map.

Organiser reserves an area of 8x6 m equivalent. **Only one service car/crew may enter the service area.**

Written applications for joint service and other special requests must be sent to the Clerk of the Course by June 1, 2008. If you apply for a bigger service area, please remember to mention the size of the area in meters. After that date the organiser charges 85 € of any changes. The organiser reserves the right to deny applications.

The organiser oversees all service as well as obeying service prohibitions. During the Rally the organiser may mark any parts of rally cars according to Art 21 of National sporting regulations/Rally.

Service vehicles must be equipped with fire extinguisher and there has to be a tarpaulin or equivalent under the rally car when at service in order to prevent oil and other waste substances from spilling to the ground.

Penalty fees for infringements in the service area are as follow:

13.3 Refuelling areas

Refuelling is allowed only in specific areas which are marked to the road map.

13.6. Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance material will be available to all participants at the Rally Office from Friday, June 13, 2008 at 08.00. When signing the material, all competitors must give information about reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and/or information about accommodation. Competitors must present their competition licenses and driving licenses. Both drivers must be present.

Reconnaissance stickers must be fixed to the windscreen and to the right rear window of the reconnaissance car. These stickers must be on display for the duration of the reconnaissance. The reconnaissance car must be "civil car" (according to Art13.6.2).

Max speed limit is 80 km/h during reconnaissance on all special stages unless traffic signs or signs placed along the road by the organiser indicate otherwise. Reconnaissance must always be made in accordance with the Road Traffic Act. **Driving against the route is forbidden.** The organiser will oversee competitors' speed and driving method during reconnaissance. The Police will inform the organiser about penalties for violating the Road Traffic act.

Competitor must obey any officials of the rally command to halt under pain of exclusion.

13.6.1. Time of reconnaissance

The reconnaissance starts on Friday, June 13, 2008 at 09.00 and closes at 18.00.

Reconnaissance is allowed as per following schedule:

SS 1/5, 3/7 and 4/8	at 9-14
SS 2/6	at 13-18

Each vehicle and competitor is allowed to traverse each special stage only twice. This regulation concerns also the special stages which are driven more than once.

V RUNNING OF THE RALLY

Art. 15. Start

Start time of each competitor will be published on the official notice board according to the programme.

Time cards will be given at TC 0 (Start of the Rally).

The cars will be started on Saturday, June 14, 2008 at 10.01 according to the list of crews eligible to take start from Kerava-city. The cars will be started at one minute intervals as stated in the rally programme.

There will be no Parc Fermé at the start of the rally, but the organiser recommends the Competitors may enter the start area max 20 minutes and min 10 minutes before their given start time.

15.8. Each crew will be given a roadbook and 2 pcs road maps on Friday, June 13 2008, at 08.00 in Rally office.

If a crew does not follow the route during road sections, they will be excluded.

Art. 18. Regrouping

The intervals which may occur between crews will be reduced at regrouping once. Maximum time is 20 minutes and minimum time is 2 minutes for regrouping. Regrouping area is also Parc Fermé area. Regrouping area is right before service area.

Art. 20. Parc Fermé

20.1.3. For classes 7-10 there is no finish Parc Fermé. Any protests concerning a car in these classes must be submitted before the crew in question reaches the finish of the rally.

VI SCRUTINEERING

Art. 21. Scrutineering before the start and during the event

Scrutineering will take place at Keuda-talo, Keskikatu 3 A, Kerava.

Sporting checks and scrutineering according to the following schedule:

Voluntary scrutineering on Friday, June 13, 2008 from 18.00 to 21.00.

Scrutineering on Saturday, June 14, 2008, according to following schedule:

Closing time for scrutineering is 12.00.

Please note! If a competitor's rally car's turbo has to be sealed, sealing wires must be with the car when entering the scrutineering. Also please note that there will be noise control at scrutineering.

21.9 In SM classes (classes 1-3) competitors are allowed to use 8 tyres at the most. Marking of tyres will be defined more detailed at competitors' information kit on art 3.4. This art is part of the Keski-Uusimaa rally regulations.

Art. 26. Prizes

Prizes are utility goods and souvenirs. Number of awardees will be published at the official notice board.

Art. 27. Prize-giving

Prize-giving will take place at Keuda-talo auditorium on Saturday June 14. The prize-giving ceremony will start at 19.00. Presence of all competitors who are to be awarded at the prize-giving ceremony is obligatory. Should any of such competitors be unable to attend the prize-giving ceremony, Clerk of the Course may grant permission not to be personally present at the ceremony.
