I. Introduction/Welcome

I.1 Introduction

Rally d'Italia will take place for the sixth time in Sardinia, the second biggest Italian island.

The history of the Rally d'Italia belongs to the same one of the FIA World Rally Championship because Italy has been hosting successfully a round of the Championship since the WRC very beginning in 1973, before in Sanremo and from 2004 in Sardinia.

The Italian round of the FIA World Rally Championship is organized by the Automobile Club of Italy and by the "Commissione Sportiva Automobilistica Italiana" (CSAI, the National Sporting Authority) with the support of ACI Sport SpA.

The 2009 edition is going to take place from the 21st to the 24th May 2009 through the provinces of Olbia-Tempio, Sassari and Nuoro. It's supported by the local communities and institutions that are proud to contribute significantly to promote such a vital event for Sardinia. The competition in fact is beginning to play an important role in the promotion and creation of economic growth thanks to its increasing number of Italian and foreign spectators.

Rally fans will be welcomed and, as every year, attention to detail will be given to make their staying more interesting and pleasant. At the same time, consolidated routine and point of reference of the Italian organization, safety issues will be implemented accurately, for the total safety of competitors and spectators.

1.2 Event Overview

Rally d' Italia Sardegna 2009 is a synthesis of action, technique and picturesque sceneries.

In fact the itinerary was conceived to emphasize the unique beauties of Sardinia and above all the unspoiled environment of the hinterland rich in luxuriant woods belonging to Ente Foreste della Sardegna (Sardinian Department of Forests).

Once again, Olbia is official host city with its Service Park set up in the Porto Cocciani that, with over 80 thousand square meters of working surface covered in asphalt, is considered one of the best and functional locations in the whole WRC able to welcome thousands of Italian and foreign spectators. The city, that has an international airport and one of the most important Mediterranean Port situated within few kilometers from the Service Park, will also host the Rally Headquarter and the Media Centre.

The first appointment will be held in Olbia: the Ceremonial Start will take place in the renewed waterfront of the city on the evening of Thursday 21st May.

Day 1 will start on Friday morning from the Service Park: three special stages will be run in the morning and twiced in the afternoon, in the surrounding territories of Buddusò, Alà dei Sardi and Bitti.

Day 2 will propose two new special stages in the territory of the Goceano among Bultei, Anela and Bono, and once again the traditional Monte Lerno will take place behind Pattada.

Last day, Day 3, the competition will be run on the special stages near Olbia stretching up to the north of Gallura for completing the special stage of Arzachena, dedicated to the television. Porto Cervo and Arzachena, in the luxuriant scenery of the Costa Smeralda, will host the Ceremonial Finish and the prize-giving.

1.3 Not regulatory Power

The rally Guide 1, published in the month of December 2008 has not regulatory power. It is a document produced for all Teams, Competitors and Media representatives to prepare in advance for Italian round of the FIA World Rally Championship. 4.2 Criteria for acceptance of Entries

The maximum number of entrants will be 90.

Priority will be granted as follows:

- Priority 1 (P1) and Priority 2 (P2) entered by a Manufacturer;
- Priority 3 (P3) drivers (FIA JWRC and PWRC drivers);
- Priority 2 (P2) entered by a non Manufacturer;
- Non Priority drivers.

Not accepted Competitors will be informed by the Organizers and will get a refund of their net registration fee (all bank charges will be taken away).

4.2.1 Closing date for Entries

- The entry application form must be filled in and sent together with the entry fee receipt, only by registered letter or courier to the Rally Office by Tuesday 14 April 2009 by 18:00;
- The entry application form and the payment receipt may also be sent by fax (+39 079 5551244) or by e-mail (sport@rallyitaliasardegna.com). In any case, the original application form and fee payment receipt have to reach the Rally Office within seven days (by Tuesday 21 May) after fax or e-mail sending;

5. Service Park

5.1 Information about the Service Park

5.1.1 Location



During the Rally there will be one single Service Park that has a working surface of asphalt and hardcore, located in Olbia Industrial Port.

All Competitors of the Rally d'Italia Sardegna will have at their disposal designed areas as per Appendix VI FIA WRC Regulations 2009.

5.1.2 Access

SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates necessary to access the Service Park are included in the Entry Package, that will be given during the Reconnaissance Sign on. All Request for extra material **must be sent** to the Rally Office within Thursday 7 May 2009 **using the form**.

During the Rally, only cars provided with SERVICE and AUXILIARY plates distributed by the Organizers will be allowed to enter the Service Park. Plates must be fixed inside the car, on the right side of the windscreen (co-driver side).

The Service Park will open on Sunday 17 May 2009 from 12:00 only for the Manufacturers, Manufacturers Team, JWRC and PWRC and on Tuesday 19 May 2009 from 08:00 for all other Competitors.

5.1.3 Allocated Service Areas

After the entry closing date, the area corresponding to each competitor will be drawn on the final layout of the Service Park. Competitors who wish to use a joint area with other competitors must request it to the rally Organizing Committee within Thursday 7 May 2009.

5.2 Service Park Facilities

5.2.1 Facilities available to all Competitors

The following services will be arranged by the Organizer at Service Park (free of charge):

- 24hours general security service in Service Park;
- General lighting;
- Public chemical toilets;
- Water supply (Competitors must provide their own water pipes and collectors);
- Waste collection;
- Exhausted oil collection and drainage from the special containers located in the Service Park;
- Waste water collection and drainage are available. Competitors must hire their collectors at the Rally Office.

5.2.2 Telephone lines

For private telephone lines competitors must apply with the Organizers.

The following services are available:

- Detailed description of the stands for which the space is required;
- Arrival time at the Rally Village (starting from Sunday 17 May at 12:00 until Wednesday 20 May at 24:00);

You have to attach the layout of each stand reporting all the measures, including service encumbrance. Because of the type of surface, it's not possible to use any kind of mechanical soil clamp (rivets, nags, etc.) and the Organizer won't have the possibility to supply counterweights and ballasts. You have to provide the Organizer with all needed technical info no later than Tuesday 16 May 2009.

6 Two Way Radio

Every radio transmitter is subject to licensing. The Ministry will decide if the requested frequencies can be assigned and will issue a license. The Ministry Officials monitor the use of radio transmitters during the Rally. Unlicensed use of a radio transmitter is forbidden and may lead to prohibition of the use of the transmitter, as well as a fine or the confiscation of the equipment.

7.1 Fuel

7.1.1 Refuelling regulation (art. 63 and 64 FIA WRC 2009)

All Priority drivers must use fuel according to FIA and provided by a unique supplier. Non-Priority drivers may use commercial fuel available at the petrol station indicated in the Road Book.

7.2.1 General

Pirelli has been nominated by FIA as the only tyre supplier for the World Rally Championship.

All drivers entering a 4WD car or entered in FIA JWRC and PWRC 2009 must use the Tyres specified by the FIA.

Competitors entering a 2Wd car (non-priority drivers) must use Tyres as per Appendix J.

11.4 Accreditation criteria of FIA WRC Events “Rally by Rally” (International Media)

Editors of publications are asked to conform to the following principles to ensure that media accreditation is restricted to professional journalists and photographers.

1. The FIA considers the “Media” pass to be a working tool to be used only by bona fide members of the press. Publishers, marketing personnel, sub-editors, staff of the publication’s secretariat, etc. cannot be accredited as Media.

2. The FIA only accredits publications:

- a) with a minimum circulation whose size and quality fulfil the criteria of the FIA;
- b) with a format and quality which fulfil the criteria of the FIA;
- c) which are on sale to the public.

Club and internal magazines of companies, trade magazines and newsletters cannot be accredited as Media.

4. Under no circumstances will advertising, public relations agencies or similar companies and organisations be accredited as media, nor will the Organisers issue any accreditation to representatives (press officers or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, engine suppliers, teams, drivers, etc.

5. The FIA WRC Media Delegate may accept requests from teams with seeded drivers for the accreditation of press personnel, with a maximum of one person per team.

6. The FIA will only accredit press from outside the country in which the event is held. National press must apply to the National Press Officer (e.g. German press applying for the Rally Deutschland should apply to the National Press Officer, while press from countries other than Germany should apply to the FIA).

7. FIA Permanent Credential Holders requesting a Substitute and/or an Additional Pass, must apply to the FIA.

8. The central and local offices of the major international press agencies (AP, AFP, Reuters, ANSA, UPI, DPA, LUSA, BELGA, Jiji, KYODO, EFE, Press Association, SAPA, Australian AP, APA, etc.) will always be accredited by the FIA. Accreditation criteria

The FIA will allocate annual permanent Media accreditation to publications intending to publish reports for every FIA World Rally Championship event during the season.

Press passes can also be allocated on a rally-by-rally basis to general news, specialist, business and lifestyle consumer publications that do not intend to publish conventional rally reports but whose coverage is considered to be of promotional benefit to the sport.

Usually, a maximum of two representatives (journalists and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for any one round of the FIA World Rally Championship. Agencies are subject to the same requirements as publications.

All applicants must fulfil the following basic criteria:

Coverage

For a daily newspaper, a substantial amount of coverage for each event is required.

For example, an introductory article in the Thursday edition, follow-up articles in Friday, Saturday and, where applicable, Sunday editions, plus a rally report in the Monday edition.

For a weekly or monthly publication, a substantial amount of coverage for each event is required and a major portion of the overall content should be on the subject of WRC.

Quality

The highest standards of fairness and accuracy are expected as a minimum quality requirement from the press.

Circulation

Accreditation decisions are based on the relative 'media market' in the country of the applicant. As such, the usual minimum circulation for a national weekly or monthly publication is 20,000 copies. For a national daily the minimum circulation is 50,000 copies.

Publications must be on sale to the general public via retail outlets (trade, club or internal company magazines will not be accredited).

Freelance journalists must apply for credentials via their own agencies. The onus is on the freelance applicant to prove the supply of regular stories to at least five publications.

Photo agencies must be able to prove that the pictures have been regularly sold to publications matching the FIA criteria and have been paid for at the normal commercial rate. A publication must be able to prove that the pictures published are the original work of the publication's accredited photographer.



Rally-by-Rally accreditation procedure

For Rally-by-Rally passes, the FIA will only accredit press from outside the country in which the event is held. National publications must apply via the event's national press office. National publications which are accredited on a permanent basis and wish to apply for additional or substitute passes must apply directly to the FIA.

Applicants must submit sample proofs of coverage to the FIA External Relations Department at the latest three weeks prior to the first day of the event (Wednesday, 29 April 2009).

Publications or agencies applying for a Rally-by-Rally photographer accreditation must supply evidence of independent coverage of a minimum of 15 pictures per pass issued at each event they have been accredited for in the previous year's Championship. The number of international press photographer passes will usually not exceed 30 at each event.

Promotional photographers for teams, sponsors, etc. who do not comply with the above criteria may apply for accreditation to ISC (address below).

11.5 FIA WRC photographers' accreditation - Press Accreditation

Publications or agencies applying for a Rally-by-Rally accreditation must supply evidence of independent coverage of a minimum of 15 pictures per pass issued at the same event the previous year.

Publications or agencies which were not accredited the previous year may submit their publications which will be considered individually based on the intended coverage and the promotional benefit to the sport. It must also be shown that:

- i. In the case of an agency, pictures have been regularly sold to publications matching the FIA criteria and have been paid for at the normal commercial rate;
- ii. In the case of a publication, published pictures are the original work of the publication's accredited photographer.

Accreditation decisions are made by the FIA WRC Media Delegate and Photographers' Delegate according to the following procedures:

1. Applications must be received at least three weeks prior to the first day of the relevant event and should be sent by registered post to the following address:

2. Applications which are late, incomplete, or sent by fax may not be considered.

3. Requests must be sent with the accreditation form and a formal application letter written on the publication's letterhead. This letter must be signed by the editor or a senior member of the editorial staff. Requests signed by clerical staff will not be accepted.

This letter must include:

- a) the name(s) of the representative(s) who will be covering the event(s);
- b) the photocopy of the official national press card(s) (where applicable) of the representative(s) who will be covering the event(s);
- c) the job title(s) of the representative(s) (journalist(s) and/or photographer(s));

- d) information on the publication (such as circulation, readership, frequency, etc);
- e) an original copy of the publication;
- f) photocopies or originals of material published following previous FIA World Rally Championship events;
- g) a contact fax number;
- h) a formal undertaking from the editor to publish a report related to the event concerned and an indication as to when this report will be published;
- i) an identity photo in electronic format (*jpeg or *tif) of the representative must be sent to the Accreditation Unit (WRC) to the following email address:

4. The FIA will fax or email the result of the application to the publication. If successful, an agreement will be included for signature by the editor of the publication.

If the representative(s) is (are) unable to attend the event, the FIA External Relations Department must be notified as early as possible before the opening of the accreditation centre.

If a change of representative(s) is to be made, please notify the FIA External Relations Department as early as possible.

5. The representative(s) must produce the signed agreement which is sent with the confirmation when collecting the credential at the event. **NO ACCREDITATION CAN BE COLLECTED WITHOUT THIS DOCUMENT.**

6. The application for a press pass must include written confirmation that the publication/agency or the journalist/photographer to whom the credential has been allocated has not applied or will not apply for additional FIA passes for any other purposes, including journalism for Television and Radio networks.

Deadlines

The deadline for applications is usually three weeks prior to the first day of the relevant event, unless otherwise stated (Rally d'Italia Sardegna, Wednesday 29 April 2009). Late requests may not be examined.

If a decision is disputed an individual application will be referred to the Director of Communications for final approval.

The FIA liaises closely with National Press Offices and National Sporting Authorities to confirm the validity of a given application.

Priority is given to publications intending to publish a report related to the event for which the accreditation is requested.
