INTRODUCTION

Rally Argentina 2010 will be run in compliance with the 2010 version of the International Sporting Code (and its appendices), the General Prescriptions applicable to all FIA Rally Championships, to the FIA-Codasur Championship and to the Argentinean Championship, the IRC Championship Sporting Regulation, the FIA CODASUR Championship Regulations, the Argentinean Sporting Regulations, the Argentinean Rally Championship Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

Modifications, amendments and /or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins (issued by the Organiser or the Stewards).

2.11 Location of overnight Parc Fermé

The Parc Fermé for all days, including the final one, will be located adjacent to the Service Park Area – Av. Arturo U. Illia between Gob. Roca and Gob. Peña streets, Villa Carlos Paz.



3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entry procedure

Anybody wishing to take part in Rally Argentina 2010 must send the duly completed entry form (Including co-driver details) to Rally Argentina Secretariat (address details in Art. 2.4) no later than Monday, March 8, 2010.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by the total entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority.

3.2 Number of entries accepted and classes

3.2.1 Number of entries

The maximum number of entrants accepted in Rally Argentina 2010 is 70. If more than 70 entries are received the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

3.2.2 Classes

The classes will be divided as follows:

IRC

Group N (including S2000, R2 and R3) Group A up to 2000cc Kit cars

CODASUR

Group N (N4, N3, N2) Super 2000 Group A (A6) Super R

CDA

Group N (N4, N3, N2) Super R Integral

3.3 Eligible drivers for IRC

Any driver entering the competition with a car built by a manufacturer registered in the IRC, is eligible to score points subject to complying with the regulations on advertising as specified in Appendix 2.

3.6 Refunds

The organisers may refund up to 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), were unable to start the rally.

4. INSURANCE

4.1 Description of insurance cover

Entry fees include the insurance premium which covers the following from March 19th to the 21st, 2010:

- 1. Civil liability: For third party bodily injuries, death and damages and/or third party property damages caused by the sporting event during the running of the Special and Super Special Stages, with a total maximum limit for all incidents of \$ 5 million (argentine pesos).
- 2. The Organising Committee declines any liability concerning the consequences caused by the violation of laws, rules or ordinances committed by competitors, remaining those consequences under the sole responsibility of those who committed the action.



3. The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates with the identification of ASSISTANCE issued by the organiser, may never be considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

The same is valid for the cars used by competitors during reconnaissance, even bearing a serial number or an event specific sticker.

5. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

5.1 Rally Plates and competition numbers

6. TYRES

6.1 Tyres

The specifications, restrictions and obligations of each Championship must be respected.

7. FUEL

7.1 Fuel

The specifications, restrictions and obligations of each Championship must be respected. Refueling in commercially available gas stations is not allowed, having to use de refueling system provided by the Organizer, in the places indicated in the Road Book.

7.2 Orders

The service must be ordered in advance to the person in charge of it through the Rally Secretariat.

7.3 Distribution during the Rally

There will be a refuelling area adjacent to the Service Park - Avenida Presidente Arturo U. Illia (ex Av. Atlántica) and Gobernador Álvarez (between Gob. Peña and Gob. Ferreira), Villa Carlos Paz - every day.

There will also be remote refuelling points per day as follows:

Day 1 San Agustín

Day 2 Valle Hermoso

The refueling areas will be indicated in the Road Book.

8. RECONNAISSANCE

8.1 Registration procedure

Location: Polideportivo - Avda. Arturo U. Illia y Gobernador Álvarez, Villa Carlos Paz.

Times: From Tuesday, March 16 until Wednesday, March 17, from 10:00 to 18:00hrs.

Prior to commencement of reconnaissance all competitors should register in order to obtain reconnaissance passes. Competitors will not be allowed to access a special stage open for reconnaissance unless these vehicle passes are displayed.



Recce only: If a driver wishes to take part in the reconnaissance only, as preparation for future participations in the event, they must contact Rally Argentina Secretariat for registration. *Entry fee for Reconnaissance only is* \in 1,000.-

8.2 Schedule

See Appendix 4.

8.3 Restrictions

Provision is made for a maximum of two passages through each special stage during reconnaissance for all crews entered.

Throughout reconnaissance, the speed limit will be of 90 Km/h in the special stages, unless the traffic signs, the road book or bulletins indicate a lower speed limit.

Competitors must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic or people living near the stages.

Under no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally in the special stage.

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

9.1 Documents to be presented

The following will be checked at the administrative checks:

- Driver's, co-driver's and entrant's competition license
- Driver's and co-driver's road license
- Authorization from the driver's ASN to take part in Rally Argentina
- Information given on the entry form
- Insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car
- Documents and registration papers for the rally car

10. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

10.1 Schedule

See schedule in Article 1.

10.2 Drivers equipment

Competitors are reminded that according to FIA Regulations Appendix L Chapter III Art. 2 all drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard. The wear of a Head restraint system approved by the FIA is mandatory for all priority drivers and codrivers, in accordance with the regulations of each Championship, and highly recommended for all entered competitors.

10.3 Preparation of engines for engine block sealing

One hole drilled on the engine block to fit a wire, a plate and a seal, at a visible position to be seen when opening the bonnet.



11. FEATURES OF THE RALLY

11.1 Start

There will be no ceremonial start. The rally will start with the running of SSS 1. (See procedure below)

11.2 Identification of officials

The post chiefs will be identified as follows:

11.3 Super Special Stages procedure and running order

- 11.3.1 Procedure for Super Special Stage 1 y 15 (for SSS15 see also finish procedure below) Parque Temático Villa Carlos Paz
- a. SSS1 y 15 will consist of dos consecutive laps around the same circuit. The start and finish point are coincident, while the Stop Control is located at the entrance and exit gate.
- b. Two cars will start the SSS simultaneously.
- c. The Organizers will produce a special starting order for at least the first 30 crews on grounds of TV and spectators interest.
- d. Given that the circuit is made of one continuous road, cars checking in first will start on position A, while the others will start on position B.
- e. Once they have completed SSS, crews must proceed to the parc fermé in Villa Carlos Paz.
- f. If a crew cannot finish the SSS, the car will be removed by the organizer and placed at the Stop Control.
- g. Yellow flags

If the running of this SSS is interrupted, a yellow flag will be displayed to the crews, who must immediately reduce speed and follow marshal's instructions.

g. If a crew cannot start or finish the SSS, a 3 minutes penalty will be applied

11.4 Finish procedure

11.4.1 Finish Ramp Location:

Avenida Presidente Arturo U. Illia, between Medrano and Nahuel Huapi streets. (next to the Service Park)

11.4.2 Procedure

The finish of the rally will be at CH15B, located at Carlos Paz on Sunday March 21, 2010.

After the running of the last Special Stage of the Rally, SSS 15, all crews will proceed directly to CH15A. After Service Park F, crews will enter a holding area were they must follow the instructions of the marshals who will reorder them for the finish ceremony.

Access to the holding area between CH15B and the podium will be limited to officials and to media representatives holding the appropriate pass.

The proceedings will be in accordance with the stated in the 2010 IRC Organization Handbook). After the podium finish, competitors must drive their cars: to Parc Fermé which is located next to the Service Park or to Final Scrutineering in convoy, as appropriate.

The car may be driven by a team representative.



A Parc Fermé pass will be issued to all cars when they enter it. Once results are made final the Stewards will authorize the opening of Parc Fermé. The car may then be removed by the driver or team representative who must produce the Parc Fermé pass.

11.5 Time-card change during the rally

The time cards will be changed, removed or issued, at the following time controls:

New time cards for competitors re-entering in Days 2 will be issued at the start CH of Days 2. (Parc Fermé Out, Carlos Paz)

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes

The first five places of the overall classification and the first three of each class of each championship will be given a trophy. Moreover, a trophy will be given to the three winning manufacturers IRC.

13. PENALTIES

The penalties established in the General Prescriptions and Regulations of each Championship: IRC, CODASUR and Argentinean.

In case of differences regarding the penalties to be applied in the different championships, these will be applied at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

14. FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

14.1. Final Scrutineerings

The final scrutineering will take place in Villa Carlos Paz.

Cars subject to final scrutineering (at Stewards' discretion) must have one representative of the entrant as well as mechanics (in case of dismantling) present at the final check.

14.2 Protest fees

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with the procedure and costs stipulated in the regulations of the corresponding championship.






