

4 - ENTRIES

4.1 Closing date for entries Monday, 19th April at 14:00 h.

4.2 Entry procedure



Anybody wishing to take part in the 34th Rally Islas Canarias "Trofeo El Corte Inglés" must send the entry form duly completed to the rally secretariat.

Details concerning the co-driver may be submitted until the day of the Administrative Checks.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- The entry fees or by a receipt issued by the competitor's National Sporting Authority.
- Photocopies of the competitor and drivers licences as well as photocopies of the drivers' passport or identity card.
- Photocopy of the page of the car homologation form for the entered car where number, group and cylinder are indicated.

For foreign competitors, the entry form must be stamped by the competitors' National Sporting Authority (Art. 17 and 70) or enclose an authorisation letter from their National Sporting Authority giving permission to participate in the 34th Rally Islas Canarias "Trofeo El Corte Inglés"

If the entry form is sent by fax, or e-mail, the original entry form must reach the Organiser at least one week after closing the entries

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and classes

The maximum number of entrants is fixed to 100 cars.

In case is reached the maximum number admitted, the Organisation reserves the right to complete this number from the remaining teams entered, according to the driver results and capacity/condition of the vehicle, to the Organisation's exclusive criteria.

No entry can be guaranteed before de entries closing date. Organisers will inform the crews which entry form, has been not accepted after this date.

Permitted Modifications

The addition of sump or chassis guards is permitted.

Additional headlights are allowed according to Article 254.6.7 and 255.5.8.5 of Appendix J. The use of mud flaps is authorised in accordance with Article 252, 7.7 of Appendix J and Windows/Net (tinted glasses), Article 253.11, Appendix J.

When paying by Swift Bank Transfer, it is essential that you provide details of this payment by fax to the Rally Office to ensure that payment is duly receipted prior to the close of entries.

The Tracker system must be paid directly to the company supplier. **Cheques are not accepted**.



4.6 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- In the case of the rally not taking place
- The organisers may refund the 30% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by its ASN), were unable to start the rally

5 - INSURANCE

Description of the insurance cover:

According to the existing Regulations in Spain the insurance policy arranged by the Organisers covers the guarantees required by the R.F.E.de A.:

- Liability to third parties, in accordance with Spanish Legislation.
- The payment for wich the participant who is held liable for accident or fire caused by the cars taking part in the Rally up to the sum of 1.202.000,00 EUR per competitor and accident.

The insurance cover will come into effect from scrutineering and will cease at the end of the Event or at the moment of retirement, disqualification or exclusion. Vehicles taking part at the shakedown will be also covered by this policy.

In case of an accident the competitor or his representative must notify in writing the Clerk of the Course in as short time as possible and a maximum of 24 hours. He must explain the circumstances under which the accident occurred. Likewise he must mention the names and addresses of any witnesses.

Competitors are reminded that only the damage caused by the Organisers and the entered drivers are covered by the insurance policy taken on by the Organisation. Injury to the drivers themselves or damages to participating cars are not covered by this insurance.

Entrants and competitors are free to take on at their own convenience any individual insurance policy that they deem fit, independently from the liability insurance above mentioned.

In case of an accident, competitors and drivers agree to hold harmless and keep indemnified the event's promoters and Organisers against all claims.



The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, may never be considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.


6 - ADVERTISING

The organiser will provide all competitors with the competition numbers and rally plates. These numbers and plates must be affixed on the car during the whole rally.




According to the recently passed law 28/2005, Spanish Legislation forbids tobacco advertising. However, a moratorium has been approved according to which the advertising and sponsorship of teams participating in motor sports competitions and events on outfits, complements, instruments, equipments, prototypes and/or vehicles, is allowed.

It is also allowed to advertise "alcoholic beverages".



IRC ADVERTISING (OBLIFATORY)



The following areas are exclusively reserved for IRC and competitors are not permitted to advertise on:

- windscreen stripe
- rear window stripe upper part
- bumper stickers, front and rear (*)
- backdrop outside the car side mirrors
- (*) The spaces on the front and rear bumpers of the racing car cannot be used to sport the logo of any tyre manufacturers apart those who have a commercial agreement with SRW



7-TYRES

7.1 During the running of the Rally, only moulded tyres according to the FIA Regulation. The participant who does not comply with this rule will be immediately excluded.

A maximum of 6 tyres will be allowed per vehicle between Service Park. The Organisation will mark these tyres on each Service Park.

It is forbidden to change tyres between the Service Parks, unless it is the spare tyre that the racing car has. This change has to be done by the driver and/or co-driver.

Between the start from the Day 1 & 2 and the Service Park, and from the Service Park and the arrival of the Day 1 & 2, the tyres are free.

At any time during the event, controls can be carried out to verify the conformity of the tyres.

The length of a special stage or the combined distance of special stages between two tyre changes must be between 30 and 60 km

The inside of the tyres (the space between the rim and the inner part of the tyre) must have only air. That is to say, the use of any device that allow tyres to conserve its performance qualities with a similar or lees internal pressure than the atmospheric one, is forbidden.

8- FUFL

8.1 Ordering procedure

The maximum quantity of lead permitted in Spain is 0,15 gr/l.

During the rally, refuelling zone are shown in the Road Book and Service Book.

The maximum number of mechanics authorised for the refuelling procedure must be two (2).

These mechanics are requested to be duly identificated (jacket and accreditations) that will be issued by the RFEdeA. Therefore it is compulsory to wear balaclava and homologated FIA gloves (complete



fire-resistant approved overalls it's recommended), likewise totally covered (it's not authorised to wear shirts, shorts, etc...).

At Service Stations designated by the Organizer, identified in the Road Book, it is only authorized to refuel directly from commercial suppliers in the following conditions:

- The only authorized operation is the refuelling of fuel.
- The refuelling has to be done without any exterior help, with the exception of employees of the service station.

9 - RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Procedure for registration

Reconnaissance must be done with cars according to Art. 22 (2010 FIA Regional Rallies Championships).

Organisers will give a reconnaissance vehicle identification sticker together with Supplementary to all entrants to Monday 26th April 2010, from 18:00 to 20:00 h.

The time card valid for up to 3 passages over each special stage and Road-Book will be given according to Appendix 2.

With these documents, crew is authorised to start reconnaissances on Tuesday 27th April 2010.

Reconnaissances sticker must be affixed during reconnaissances on the top right of the front windscreen.

Special Stages will be supervised by Rally Officials and competitors must follow their instructions. During reconnaissances crews must stop at the start of each stage, which will be duly signposted. Rally Officials will stamp the reconnaissances time card in order to record every run on each special stage.

The presence of drivers and/or co-drivers on a special stage, in any way whatsoever will be considered as reconnaissance.

It is allowed to film the SS during the Reconnaissances.

Schedule:



Reconnaissance for all drivers will take part on Tuesday 27th from 9:00 to 21:00 h. and Wednesday 28th April 2010, from 10:00 to 18:00 h.

The programme according to Appendix 2 must be fully respected by the crews.

Reconnaissances will be limited to a <u>maximum of three</u> (3) times per Special Stage, even if it is run 2 times during the rally, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the Road Traffic Laws in Spain. In no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally on the special stages.

9.2 Specific and/or national restrictions - Speed limit on the SS

The maximum speed during reconnaissances of special stages is fixed at 80km/h except when it exist speed limit signs and through villages or towns (50km/h).

It is **emphasised that reconnaissances is not practice**. All the Road Traffic Laws in Spain must be strictly adhered to and the safety and rights of the other road users must be respected.

Reconnaissance vehicles must be covered by the insurance as required by current legislation. No responsability can be imputable to the Organisers.

9.3 Installation of speed control checking devices / GPS

All drivers are required to carry a GPS tracker unit in their cars. Details of the fitting time and location for these devices are detailed in the Programme.

GPS tracker unit manipulations

Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the reconnaissance car or any device that fails to record a trace due to external interference, will be reported to the stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

10 - ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Administrative control will take place at the secretariat of the Rally at the Edificio Miller (Santa Catalina Park).

10.1 Documents to be presented

• Entrants licence: National for Spanish drivers and International for foreign drivers.



- Driver and co-driver competition licences: National for Spanish drivers and International for foreign drivers. Driver and co-driver must present a driver competition licence
- Driver and co-driver passport or identity card and driving licenses
- ASN authorisation, for all foreign competitors
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Registration document of the rally car

10.2 Timetable

(A detailed timetable will be published)

Wednesday, 28th April 2010 Optional from 18:00 to 21:00 h

Obligatory for all Shakedown participants

Thursday, 29th April 2010 Rest of entries from 15:00 to 18:00 h

Competitors may attend administration control at any of these two days, but must attend documentation control before scrutineering.

Competition numbers and rally plates will be delivered during documentation control to all the entrants.

11 - SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 Scrutineering venue and timetable

The Cars must be presented to the scrutineers with the rally plates, competition numbers, optional advertising will **be affixed** at Santa Catalina Park.

11.3 Windows/Nets

It is allowed to use the silvered or tinted films on the side and rear windows and on the glass sunroof.

11.4 Driver's safety equipment

The control of the Hans, the driver helmets and safety equipment will take place at the entrance of the TC-0 prior to the start of the Rally.

11.5 Installation of Safety Tracking System

All cars must be fitted with a Safety Tracking System.

GPS tracker unit manipulations

Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competing car or any device that fails to record a trace due to external interference, will be reported to the stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

12 - OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 Ceremonial start procedure

The Ceremonial Start is compulsory for all competing cars and will take place on Thursday 29th April at 20:30h at the Santa Catalina Park

The crews must park their cars in Parc Fermé near by the ceremonial start podium during following times from 19:30 to 20:00h. This parking zone will be closed and under vigilance.

The ceremonial start will be carried out in numerical order, starting with the highest number.

The start interval at the Ceremonial start will be minimum 30 seconds for all drivers.

Competitors are required to wear their approved overalls.

If a crew is unable to participate in the ceremonial start due to a justified cause, it will be permitted to start the remainder of the rally on Friday morning at its allocated time provided that has been authorized by the



Stewards and subject to passing the necessary scrutineering checks. The drivers must still attend the ceremonial start in overalls (without car).

To arrive to the Ceremonial start with a delay up to 15 min. will entail a cash penalty of 120 €.

After de Ceremonial Start in Parque de Sta. Catalina, rally cars can be driven to the Service Park in order to park each car in its particular service area or wherever the team decides.

12.2 Starting system of special stages

On the special stages the start will be given by an electronic system of count down. The count down will be discounted second by second and will be clearly visible by the crew from the starting position.

Should the electronic start system fail the start will be given as specified in art. 33 (2010 FIA Regional Rallies Championships).

A pfotocell placed 40 cm in front of the starting line will be used to detect jump starts.

12.3 Permitted early check-in

Crews are authorized to check in advance at TC-9B (finish Day 1).

12.4 Time-card delivery and change during the rally

Friday 30th April – Time-cards can be collected at TC Start (TC-0) at the Service Park 15 minutes before each car's individual starting time.

APPENDIX 5

PROCEDURE FOR THE USE OF YELLOW FLAGS IN SPECIAL STAGES

In case of an incident in a special stage, the Clerk of the Course will be entitled to order the display of yellow flags under the following conditions:

- The flags will be located in the "radio points" indicated in the Road-book.
- The order to display the flags is the exclusive responsibility of the Clerk of the Course.
- Once attended the order, all the flags will be shown in the "radio points" between the start of the special stage and the actual place of the incident.
- The Official will have to be a Marshall, perfectly identified with a yelow jacket with flash, easily visible, and on which the standard symbol of "radio points" must be shown.
- The Clerk of the Course will inform the Stewards of the Meeting of the exact time during the flags have been displayed, the numbers of cars involved with their respective number.
- The drivers who have waved the yellow flags will have to reduce their speed immediately and follow the instructions of the Marshall and the members of the Safety cars they may come across.
- The non-respecting this rule will entail a penalty to the criterium of the Stewards of the Meeting.
- To any crew who has been shown a yellow flag, the disposed in article 36.5 (2010 FIA Regional Rallies Championships).
