4. ENTRIES

4.1 Closing date for entries

Thursday 20 May

4.2 Entry procedure

Competitors who wish to participate in Rally Poland 2010 must submit their entry form before 20 May 2010, duly completed (including Co-driver details) to the permanent secretariat (see Article 2.3)

Entry form must be accompanied by the total entry fee. If the entry application has been sent by e-mail or fax, the original must reach the Organiser no later than one week after the closing date for entries, i.e. on Thursday 27 May 2010.

Foreign drivers must hold an authorization to compete from their ASN or obtain its stamp on the entry form.

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and classes

4.3.1 Number of entrants accepted

The maximum number of entrants will be 70.

If more than 70 entries are received, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries among the non priority drivers will be accepted

4.3.2 Classes

Production Cars (group N), cylinder capacity classes:

Class N1 + R1A up to and including 1400 ccm

Class N2 + R1B over 1400 ccm up to and including 1600 ccm Class N3 over 1600 ccm up to and including 2000 ccm

Class N4 over 2000 ccm

Touring Cars (group A) including S1600 cars, cylinder capacity classes:

Class A5 up to and including 1400 ccm

Class A6 (including S1600) +R2B over 1400 ccm up to and including 1600 ccm Class A7* + R2C, R3C, R3T, R3D over 1600 ccm up to and including 2000 ccm

4.6 Refounds

Entry fee will be refunded In full In following situations:

- 1) To candidates whose entry has not been accepted,
- 2) In the case of the rally not take place.

The Organiser may refund 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who for reason of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN) were unable to start in the rally. With any request for entry fee refound the competitor must send the Organiser a certificate od "force majeure" given by his ASN. This must be applied for in writing giving reason for the claim bank and account details.









5. INSURANCE

5.1 All competitors are covered by the event's insurance cover while on the special stages during the itinerary of the rally.

Crews participating in reconnaissance only are not covered by the event's insurance policy.

Vehicles carrying service, auxiliary, reconnaissance and/or any other equivalent plate issued by the Organiser are not covered by the event's insurance policy. These vehicles are driven under the responsibility of their owners and the Organiser bears no responsibility for them.

Vehicles used by competitors during reconnaissance, even if bearing the events specific sticker, should be insured by their owners. The Organiser bears no responsibility for such vehicles.

It is recommended that crews participating in the rally or reconnaissance only have their own valid personal insurance covering them for injures (personal accident insurance including death and disablement).

5.2 All competitors must present their road car insurance cover at Administrative Check.

The Organiser's insurance cover for the rally will come into affect from the start of the rally and will cease at the end or the moment of retirement or exclusion.

The maximum compensation for public liability is 1 000 000 PLN

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Organiser's advertising

The Organiser's advertising is detailed in Appendix 4 of these regulations.

6.2 Rally plates & competition numbers

As detailed in Appendix 4 of these regulations.

Competitor numbers and rally plates must be affixed to the car for scrutineering and must be visible for the duration of the rally.

6.3 Advertising restriction

Advertising of tobacco, tobacco products, smokers' requisites and alcoholic beverages is forbidden in Poland.

This law applies to competing cars, service cars and other cars, all equipment and clothing.









7. TYRES

All competitors must only use tyres complying with the 2010 FIA European Rally Championship Sporting Regulations – Appendix 4.

8. FUEL

All competitors must use commercial fuel meeting the requirements of Appendix J (Art. 252.9). The maximum lead content permitted in Poland is 0,005 g/l. Competitors may only refuel in the refueling zones or remote refueling zones designated by the Organisers in the road book, except as detailed under Article 45. A car may be pushed out of the zone by the crew, officials and/or the two team members without incurring penalty.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Procedure for registration

9.1.1 Reconnaissance registration will take place at Rally Office according to the rally programme.

Location: Rally HQ, Mikołajki

Date and Time: Tuesday 1st June; 14:00-19:00

A reconnaissance registration form must be completed before commencing reconnaissance. This will be available in Rally Guide 2 and on www.rallypoland.com

- **9.1.2** A reconnaissance record card will be supplied which must be carried in the car for the duration of the reconnaissance and presented to the officials at the start of each stages and the STOP control where it will be signed. Failure to produce this card will result in efusal to continue reconnaissance.
 - Reconnaissance cards must be returned to the Rally Office by 12:00 on Friday 4th June 2010.
- **9.1.3** Competitors will be issued with reconnaissance numbers that must be fixed on the windscreen (front and centre) and on the left and right rear side windows.
- **9.1.4** Should a crew's reconnaissance car be replaced for any reason, the secretariat must be informed of the details of the replacement car.

9.2 Schedule

Reconnaissance will take place on Wednesday 2nd and on Thursday 3rd June according to the schedule in Appendix 2 of this regulations.

9.3 Restrictions

9.3.1 Competitors are permitted a maximum of three passages over each special stage. During reconnaissance of SS 1,2 & 15 each passage means 2 laps.









- **9.3.2** No more than two persons are permitted in the car during each passage through a
 - special stage, these persons being the driver and co-driver. Of the competing crew.
- **9.3.3** The special stages will be open to normal traffic, therefore safety and rights of other
 - road users must be respected. Competitors are reminded that vehicles may be travelling in the opposite direction.
- **9.3.4** Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of rally traffic, unless instructed by an officials of the events or the police. Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish.
- **9.3.5** The maximum speed on special stages during the reconnaissance is 70 kph.
- **9.3.6** The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted.
- 9.3.7 Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the 67th Rally Poland who will be found present on the route of any special stage of the rally between 1stApril 2010 and 7th June 2010 outside the reconnaissance schedule as well as during the rally, will be considered a person performing the forbidden reconnaissance.
- **9.3.8** Each crew will receive the infringement card at the registration for reconnaissance. Each crew which is found not comply with the Traffic Law will be penalized as follow:

First infringement
 Second infringement
 Third infringement
 fine of 2000 PLN
 fine of 3000 PLN
 start refusal

9.4 Participation in reconnaissance only

Any driver not entered in the rally may take part in reconnaissance. The regulations regarding reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety and the Organizers must be informed. In order to be accepted a Reconnaissance Entry Form must be completed and returned to the secretariat by 7th May 2010 and a fee of € 400 must be paid. The Reconnaissance Registration Form is available on the event website: www. rallypoland.com.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 Documents to be presented

At administrative checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

- Driver's and co-driver's competition licence
- Driver's and co-driver's driving licence
- Entrant's licence
- Authorization from the drivers' ASN to take part in the rally
- Information given on the entry form
- Insurance cover (third parties) for the rally
- Rally car registration documents
- Documents and registration papers for the rally

11. SCRUTINEERING - MARKING & SEALING

- **11.1** The scrutinnering, marking & sealing will be carried out in Rally Park Mikolajki on Friday 4th June 2010, 08:00-13:00.
- **11.2** Each crew will report to the scrutineering in its individual time given in the schedule published later in the bulletin.
- **11.3** Documents to be presented on scrutineering:
 - documents and registration papers for the rally car
 - insurance policy for the rally car
 - rally car book
 - scrutineering card

11.4 Other regulations

- **11.4.1** Any crew reporting with a lateness at the scrutineering will be penalized with a fine of 50% of the entry fee.
- **11.4.2** The use of "silver windows" is not permitted on rally cas and recce cars.
- **11.4.3** The noise level of each rally cars must not exceed 98 dB(A) during the whole rally. The measuring of the noise level may be carried out during the pre-rally scrutineering as well as in every moment of the rally.
- **11.4.5** Using of tinted film on the rear and side windows is allowed according to Art. 253.11 of Appendix J and Polish Traffic Law (Prawo o Ruchu Drogowym).

11.5 Safety Tracking Units

All competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the Safety Track ing System. Installation and operating instruction will be available on www.rallypoland.com and in Rally Guide 2.

The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at scrutineering.









12. FEATURES OF THE RALLY

12.1 Start of the rally

12.1.1 Ceremonial start

There will be a pre start holding area located at SS1. This holding area will be open from 17:30 hrs.

Cars are required to be brought to this holding area before 18:00 Crews are required to be with their cars before 18:00

The penalty for late arrival of either competitor or his car will be: 1000 PLN From 18:00 hrs competitors will be directed by marshals to an adjacent ceremonial start ramp.

12.1.2 Rally Start

From this ramp competitors will proceed to TC 1, the official start of the rally. The start order for the Ceremonial Start and SS-1 will be in reverse numeric order (i.e. car no.1 starts last), however, the organisers reserve the right to pair cars according to publicity requirements. The fi nal start order will be published following the 1st Stewards' meeting (Friday 4th June 2010).

12.2 Finish of the rally

The finish of the rally will be on completion of SS-15. The podium ceremony will take place for all competitors thereafter at the Super Special Stage.

On arrival at TC 14 A, the first 16 cars (variable) will be paired and placed in reverse order of the general classification in order to start SS-15.

On completion of SS-15, these competitors will be directed to an adjacent holding area where the crews shall wait with their cars. In reverse classification order they shall then be directed over the finish ramp were the podium procedure will take place as per Appendix IV of WRC Sporting Regulations.

Only the crews can take their cars directly to the parc fermé.

Following the above procedure, SS-15 will be completed for the remaining competitors running in order of arrival at TC 14 A. These remaining competitors shall then follow the same procedure as the first 16 (variable) cars.

12.3 Super Special Stage

SS-1,2 & SS-15 Mikołajki, will be run under Super Special Stage regulations (FIA WRC Art.43). At this super special stage two cars will start at the same time at parallel positions, but on opposite side of the stage. After two laps they will cross the fi nish line. If the running of the SSS is interrupted, this will be signaled to the drivers by yellow flags. When given this signal, the driver must immediately reduce speed and follow the instructions of any marshals or other offi cials. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

12.4 Permitted early check-in

Crews are authorized to check in early without incurring a penalty at TC 1A TC 2A, TC 8B, TC 15A.

15. FINAL CHECKS

15.1 Final Checks – attendance and location

The final check will take place at Rally Park, Mikołajki on Sunday 6th June 2010 at 17:30. Cars subject to final checks (decision by the Stewards and announced to the competitor concerned at the finish TC) must have at least one representative of the entrant as well as mechanics (in case of dismantling) present at the final check.

15.2 Protest fees










Numbering and Advertising











- 2 X front door panels measuring 67 cm long by 17 cm high including a 1 cm white surround. This panel shall comprise a 15 cm X 15 cm competition number box which shall always be the front of the panel. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the bottom window line. No signage, other than the color scheme of the car, shall be placed within 10cm of the panel.
- 1 X rear window panel which shall measure a maximum of 30 cm wide and 10 cm high, reserved for the Organiser and competition number. This panel shall be positioned at the top of the rear window, centre.
- 2 X numbers for each rear side window which shall be min. 18 cm high a stroke width of least min. 2,2 cm. These numbers shall be placed at the top of the rear side windows in conjunction with the drivers name.
- 1 X roof panel being 50 cm wide and 52 cm high, to be placed on the roof with the top towards the front of the car. A matt black competition number, 5 cm wide and 38 cm high.

For the front: one plate fitting into a rectangle 43 cm wide X 21,5 cm high which shall include the competition number.

Driver and Co-Driver Names:

The name of the driver and co-driver must appear with his/her passport nationality national flag on the rear side window of both sides of the car, under the competition number. The surname alone shall be:

- in Helvetica: upper case for the first letter of the name and the remainder in lower case.
- in white on a transparent background.
- Driver: to a height of 10 cm and stroke width of 1,5 cm
- Co-driver: to a high of 5 cm and stroke width of 0,8 cm

The names of the driver and co-driver, with their national flags, must also appear on the front wings of the car.
